12:50	AQU 1st	GENDARMOUR (#4, 10-1) freshened after showing no love for inner dirt, but ran two good ones on the bigger oval last fall. —Marcus Hersh
2:09	KEE 3rd	JACKSON ACTION (#2, 15-1) got far too much hot pace breaking outside in route debut. Still in for more than purchase price; poly possibilities. —Marcus Hersh. STEEL GUITAR (#3, 5-1) is stretched out to a route and dropped in class — moves that should put him in the winner's circle. —Byron King
2:35	OP 2nd	DENALI HOLY BULL (#6, 5-2) exits a quick-paced race against steeper and is a candidate to wire the field; the winner of the race was picking off his third score of the meet. —Mary Rampellini
2:41	KEE 4th	Fascinating pace scenario in this high level allowance, with HOWE GREAT (#3, 12-1) seeming to hold the edge in that regard. But even with a clear lead and slow fractions he could have trouble lasting, which shifts the advantage to the second speed, which may be AIR SUPPORT (#7, 4-1) , who adds blinkers. —Kenny Peck
2:58	AQU 5th	GROUND FORCE (#4, 12-1) claimed by Canani out of non-threatening effort; barn's been going too well to ignore. —Chuck Kuehhas
3:00	SA 1st	The debut by ART OFFICIAL (#6, 7-2) was good, but his second start should be better; he was anchored, missed by only four, and switches to a speed rider that will let him rip. —Brad Free
3:13	KEE 5th	Guessing CARSON'S CROWN (#12, 15-1) been pointed to this race for many weeks; near-bullet 5fs drill over local synthetic. —Marcus Hersh
3:45	KEE 6th	CHECKERED PAST (#10, 4-1) ran a fine third at first asking in an off-the-turf race at FG, and now gets the opportunity to go on the grass at Keeneland. —Byron King
3:58	PIM 7th	Is it pure folly betting against BEN'S CAT (#7, 4-5) in a turf sprint? Maybe. But HEROS REWARD (#3, 6-1) may be the main speed, and he's also a proven turf sprinter. I'll save in exactas with the favorite but HEROS REWARD seems like the right win bet. —Kenny Peck
4:04	AQU 7th	JAMES JINGLE (#4, 12-1) turned in a couple of ok efforts on turf last year as a 2-year-old; recent so-so dirt form ensures price will be high. —Chuck Kuehhas
4:08	OP 5th	ZELLERS (#7, 3-1) draws a much improved post over his last start, when he broke from the 11-hole going a mile. He also should be closer to the pace on the move back to a mile and a sixteenth. —Mary Rampellini
4:17	KEE 7th	FIVE STAR MOMMMA (#5, 10-1) hasn't started this year but is a high-class filly that starts for winning connections. —Byron King. APROPOS (#10, 2-1) is a DRF Best Bet (Steve Klein). B
4:30	SA 4th	Bombs-away potential with BROTHER GREG (#3, 30-1) , a second-time starter with connections known to occasionally pop at a giant price with this kind. —Brad Free. JOELITO (#6, 6-1) Rock Hard Ten colt tries turf for the first time here, the surface which may prove to be his best; running lines are littered with stakes winners. —Chuck Kuehhas
4:39	OP 6th	EARLY EDDIE (#1, 8-1) will have to beat EDDIE'S BAND , a Fair Grounds invader with back class, but like that this one exits a race that has produced four next-out winners since being run March 2nd. —Mary Rampellini

5:14	AQU 9th	SALUTOS AMIGOS (#4, 5-1) was swarmed by Flashback and Goldcents on the backstretch after making the lead in the San Felipe, but this colt is well suited by the turn-back in a competitive renewal of the Bay Shore; his good-figure maiden win came at the expense of Zee Bros, an even-money newcomer from Bob Baffert that came back to win with a 102 Beyer Figure. –Dave Litfin
5:21	TAM 10th	JUST JEBICAH (#5, 30-1) doesn't have the figures of some of these, and he may or may not be best used "underneath" in exotics, but he does have license to take a big step up in his first start off the layoff, if those works are any indication. –Kenny Peck
5:23	KEE 9th	PRIVATE ENSIGN (#3, 6-1) faced some of the best fillies in the country in Florida; in against a deep but lesser field here in the Ashland. –Byron King
5:30	SA 6th	A fresh and rested BATTLE FORCE (#1, 4-1) can upset first start in three months; lightly raced, has faced better, inside draw, finishing kick, should be a decent price. –Brad Free
5:49	AQU 10th	Loved SWAGGER JACK'S (#6, 10-1) last race and think he remains a horse on the rise; will be overlooked here. –Marcus Hersh
5:56	KEE 10th	LOLLIPOP (#3, 4-1) adds blinkers and comes off a decent effort at Fair Grounds in his U. S. debut; figures to offer more value than the 1-for-12 favorite, GOLD MEGILLAH . –Kenny Peck
6:09	OP 9th	STORMY HOLIDAY (#7, 15-1) has a serious closing kick and could get an ideal setup in this \$75,000 Bachelor, which drew a number of front-runners. –Mary Rampellini
6:28	AQU 11th	Not convinced we'll get 5-1 on NORMANDY INVASION (#2, 5-1) in the Wood given the weight from so many public handicappers but he does seem to be the right play against VERRAZANO , who is very talented but perhaps overbet off a very game score in the Tampa Bay Derby. –Kenny Peck
6:30	SA 8th	Improving MAGNIFICENT SHIRL (#7, 4-1) is bred for nine furlongs and can turn the tables on BIRDLOVER (#5, 9-2) , her main rival; 'SHIRL has tactical speed, and can finish. –Brad Free
7:30	SA 10th	GONNA FLY NOW (#12, 4-1) unseen since last spring at Hollywood, a race that produced three next-out winners; goes first time Sadler today. –Chuck Kuehhas

GETTING EXOTIC

AQUEDUCT PICK 4 RACES 8-11

RACE 8: Well-connected **CLOSE HATCHES** has looked good winning first two starts with different running styles, and lands a nice inside post to offer options as she steps up to try a graded stakes, though not a particularly strong one. **PRINCESS OF SYLMAR** the one to beat after posting four straight blowout wins on the stretch out; still feels tough to gauge despite the recent streak, and this will be her toughest test to date. (2)

RACE 9: Interesting Bay Shore offers several ways to go, and I want to spread a little here. Definitely using the pair of turn back's **HON-**

ORABLE DILLON and **THE TRUTH AND K G**, and will also cover **MALEE H** on the main ticket. Last time was a better time to have **CLEARLY NOW**, but he's clearly dangerous, and **DECLAN'S WARRIOR** feels like an improving horse, and will be running late at a square price. (5)

RACE 10: Grade 1 Carter feels a bit like a two horse race between So Cal shipper **SAHARA SKY** and **DISCREET DANCER**, so will take them both, while preferring the latter, and leaning more heavily on him. Get that **DISCREET DANCER** has never raced outside of Gulfstream and will have to ship for the first time, but he's made no mistakes, and may just be better than these. (2)

RACE 11: No telling how good **VERRAZANO** may be, and he's a must use in multi's, but not so sure it's a foregone conclusion. Giving **NORMANDY INVASION** a real chance to win the Wood coming back to Aqueduct after his out of town prep, which was something of a disaster; and will use the likable **VYJACK** somewhere, as he's handled several different scenarios while remaining undefeated, and may be this good. (3)
