Sharp Azteca proved he could run just as well from off the pace as he has when he's on it as he rallied from third to dominate the Grade 1, \$750,000 Cigar Mile at Aqueduct on Dec. 2.

Under Javier Castellano, Sharp Azteca was 2 1/2 lengths off the early pace in third, confronted the pace-setting tandem of

Seymourini and Americanize approaching the top of the stretch, and then ran away from those two and the rest to win the Cigar Mile by 5 1/4 lengths. Mind Your Biscuits, who last December beat Sharp Azteca in the Grade 1 Malibu at Santa Anita, was second by 2 3/4 lengths over the late-running Practical Joke.

Americanize finished fourth and was followed, in order, by Tom's Ready, Just Call Kenny, Vulcan's Forge, Beasley, Seymourini, and Summer Revolution.

It was the eighth win from 16 career starts for Sharp Azteca, but his first in a Grade 1 stakes. In addition to a second-place finish in the Malibu, Sharp Azteca had also run second in the Grade 1 Metropolitan Handicap at Belmont Park in May and second in the Grade 1 Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile four weeks ago at Del Mar.

He won the Cigar, carrying topweight of 125 pounds, spotting 3 to 12 pounds to the field.

"I picked him out, it means a lot," said winning trainer Jorge Navarro. "When the horse was a 3-year-old I mentioned that he was one of the top 3-year-olds, and an old trainer came up to me and said 'Are you kidding? Do you know what you're talking about?' Here it is."

This year, as a 4-year-old, Sharp Azteca won the Grade 2 Gulfstream Park Handicap, the Grade 2 Kelso, and the Grade 3 Monmouth Cup. He also finished third in the Group 2 Godolphin Mile in March.

When he won, Sharp Azteca typically did so on the front end. In the BC Dirt Mile, he set the pace only to be caught by Battle of Midway.

Navarro said he was confident that Sharp Azteca could rate until Friday when he watched videos of the horse attempting to do just that.

"He kept throwing his head up every time we tried to rate him," Navarro said.

Javier Castellano, who flew to south Florida last week at the request of owner

Ivan Rodriguez to work the horse, said he thought the horse would rate. But when the gates opened, Sharp Azteca broke on top.

Still, Castellano was able to reel him in and let Seymourini and Americanize duke it through a quarter in 22.78 seconds and a half-mile in 45.97. When Castellano asked Sharp Azteca to go after those two, the colt responded. He caught the leaders by the quarter pole and was never really threatened in the stretch.

"He switched off quick and he relaxed behind those horses very, very impressive," Castellano said. "Only good horses can do that."

Sharp Azteca ran a mile in 1:35.17 and returned \$5.50 as the 8-5 favorite.

"I wasn't expecting this big of a performance," Navarro said. "You know what? He ran his eyeballs out. What else can I ask?"

In January, Navarro may ask Sharp Azteca to try to run 1 1/8 miles in the \$16 million Pegasus World Cup at Gulf-

stream Park on Jan. 27.

"After this performance why not," Navarro said. "We are going to see how he comes out of this first."

Mind Your Biscuits, third in the Breeders' Cup Sprint, ran a very credible second going a mile, which may be a tad beyond his best distance.

"I think he showed everybody he could go a mile," trainer Chad Summers said. "I have all the respect in the world for Jorge Navarro and Sharp Azteca. ... I thought it was a two-horse race, it was, he got the jump on us and he beat us today."

Practical Joke, last after a half-mile, rallied to finish third, beaten eight lengths in what is his final career start. He retired with a record of 5-2-3 from 12 starts and earnings of \$1,179,800.

"I thought he ran a real solid race," trainer Chad Brown said. "It was hard to make up ground today on this track. That said, the winner was very impressive and I don't think it would have mattered how

the track was playing, it looked like nobody was going to beat him today.”

Wonder Gadot had enough of an excuse when sixth in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies for her connections to give her another chance on the dirt.

On Dec. 2, Wonder Gadot made the most of that second chance, sitting close to a soft early pace then finishing with a flourish to win the Grade 2, \$250,000 Demoiselle Stakes by 3 3/4 lengths at Aqueduct. Maurer Power, stuck behind horses around the turn, finished okay to be second, by three lengths over Layla Noor. Daisy, Held Accountable, Indy Union, Stakes On a Plane and Vindictive Ways completed the order of finish.

Wonder Gadot now has 3 wins from 5 starts with her wins coming on the turf, synthetic, and now dirt.

In the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies, Wonder Gadot got off a bit slow and was in 11th position early. She tried to rally in the stretch and finished sixth, though she steadied late and possibly could have been fourth.

Both trainer Mark Casse and Velazquez, who was riding Wonder Gadot for the first time, wanted to make sure the filly got into the Demoiselle early.

Daisy from her inside post, won the race into the first turn, but Wonder Gadot was within three-quarters of a length of her through an opening quarter in 24.47 seconds, a half-mile in 50.28, and six furlongs in 1:16.24.

Wonder Gadot drew on even terms approaching the quarter pole and a patient Velazquez waited until the three-sixteenths pole to ask Wonder Gadot to run. When she did, Wonder Gadot lengthened her stride and pulled away.

Wonder Gadot, a daughter of Medaglia d'Oro wned by Gary Barber, covered the 1 1/8 miles in 1:53.91 and returned \$5.20 as the favorite.

"She broke good, they went slow enough, I was comfortable where I was, no dirt in her face," Velazquez said. "After that, it was pretty easy. I just wait and wait with her, and when I asked her at the quarter pole she just started running, her stride getting

longer and faster. It's a good feeling when you plan something and it works out."

The victory earned Wonder Gadot 10 qualifying points toward the Kentucky Oaks in May. She will likely return to south Florida where Casse bases during the winter and be put on a path to the Oaks.

The horses had barely cooled out from the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf on Nov. 3 at Del Mar and trainer Jonathan Thomas began thinking about running Catholic Boy, a close fourth in that race, in the Grade 2 Remsen Stakes at Aqueduct on Dec. 2.

Thomas knew the 1 1/8-mile distance of the Remsen would suit Catholic Boy. It was just a matter of whether he would handle the dirt as well as he had the turf.

That question was answered emphatically in the affirmative in the Remsen as Catholic Boy launched a three-wide rally on the far turn and cruised down the lane to a 4 3/4-length victory in the \$250,000 Remsen Stakes. Avery Island, who had won the Grade 2 Nashua by the same margin four weeks ago, finished second by 1 3/4 lengths over Vouch.

It was 4 3/4 lengths back to Alkhaatam in fourth. He was followed, in order, by Tap Rap Strike, Biblical, Millionaire Runner, Triple Dog Dare, V. I. P. Code, and Bandito.

Thomas, a former assistant to trainers Todd Pletcher and Christophe Clement, had seen Catholic Boy train well on dirt in the mornings. He was quite gratified to see that translate to the afternoon.

"It definitely defied expectations," Thomas said.

Thomas said the primary reason Catholic Boy began his career on turf was because that surface offered longer-distance races. In July, he won a 7 1/2-furlong maiden race at Gulfstream, which was run around two turns, and then shipped to Saratoga to win the Grade 3, 1 1/16-mile With Anticipation. Thomas was leery of the one-mile distance of the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf, where Catholic Boy was beaten 1 1/2 lengths, but galloped out ahead of the field.

"He galloped out so well in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf we were like, we got to run this horse as far as we can go," Thomas said.

Under Manny Franco, Catholic Boy was fifth early on in the Remsen but only two

lengths off the pace. Longshots Millionaire Runner and Bandito dueled through a half-mile in 48.97 seconds. Vouch sat third, just off the top two.

Millionaire Runner, a 166-1 shot, put away Bandito, but Vouch and Catholic Boy were on the march. Vouch had a short lead coming to the quarter pole, but Catholic Boy quickly overtook him in upper stretch and drew clear.

Catholic Boy, a son of More Than Ready owned by Robert La Penta, covered the 1 1/8 miles in 1:52.50.

In four weeks, Majestic Heat went from being a bust in graded stakes on turf to a multiple stakes winner on dirt.

After finishing a quiet sixth in the Grade 2 Goldikova Stakes on turf at Del Mar on Nov. 4, Majestic Heat won her dirt track debut in the Betty Grable Stakes for California-bred fillies and mares at seven furlongs at Del Mar on Nov. 12.

Majestic Heat won the first graded stakes of her career in the Grade 2 Bayakoa Stakes for fillies and mares at 1 1/16 miles on Dec. 3 at Los Alamitos.

"I didn't think she ran at all in the grass race at Del Mar," trainer Richard Mandella said. "I thought, I'll throw her in (the dirt race) and see what happens."

The change in surface was a success.

Ridden by Mike Smith, Majestic Heat (\$8 to win) closed from sixth in a field of eight in the \$201,035 Bayakoa to win by a convincing 2 1/2 lengths over Champagne Room, the champion 2-year-old filly of 2016.

Mandella said he saw similar rallies from Majestic Heat in main track workouts in the past, but that the enthusiasm did not translate into results in major turf stakes.

“In the afternoon, she went along as a horse with no speed,” he said.

A beaten favorite in the Pumpkin Pie Stakes here four weeks ago, Indulgent rebounded at a big price Dec. 2, holding off Highway Star in the stretch to win the Grade 3, \$200,000 Go for Wand Handicap by one length at Aqueduct.

Highway Star, who won this race last year, was second by a half-length over Verve's Tale. Going for Broke, Lucy N Ethel, Flora Dora, and Jamyson N' Ginger, the 8-5 favorite, completed the order of finish.

It was the fourth win from 12 career starts for Indulgent, but it was her first stakes victory in her seventh attempt at such a race. As a half-sister to the multiple Grade 1 winner Frosted, the graded stakes win makes Indulgent that much more valuable as a potential broodmare prospect. Indulgent is a homebred of Sheikh Mohammed al Maktoum's Godolphin Racing operation.

“That was big,” trainer Kiaran McLaughlin said from South Florida. “We've tried win a couple of overnight stakes because

she was graded stakes-placed before. She has to want a mile with her pedigree.”

Indulgent had only tried a mile once before and she finished last in the Grade 2 Ruffian over a sloppy Belmont main tack in May. In her most recent start, she finished second to Lucy N Ethel in the Pumpkin Pie Stakes as the 6-5 favorite, but was stuck down toward the inside in that race.

“Last time she was a little intimidated and the rail was heavy that day and when I asked her she didn't take off,” Saez said. “Today, the outside post, that was perfect for her.”

McLaughlin said that he instructed Saez to keep Indulgent outside and in the clear, whether she was second or fifth early on. Indulgent set up shop in second, stalking Lucy N Ethel through a half-mile in 46.82 seconds and six furlongs in 1:11.43.

Turning for home, Indulgent took over from Lucy N Ethel and though Highway Star looked poised to make a run at her in the stretch, she flattened out in the last sixteenth. Highway Star was the 123-pound highweight and carried seven more pounds than Indulgent.

Angel Arroyo, the rider of Highway Star, said he thought at the three-eighths pole he was going to win the race. In the end, Arroyo, believes the cross-country trip to Southern California for the Breeders' Cup Filly and Mare Sprint where she finished 11th took its toll.

“I think that's why we lost the race,” Arroyo said.

Despite the loss, Highway Star, a New York-bred daughter of Girolamo, surpassed the \$1 million mark in career earnings (\$1,009,000).

Indulgent, a 4-year-old daughter of Bernardini, covered the mile in 1:37.75 and returned \$27.40 to win.

Jimmy Bell, president of Godolphin USA, said Indulgent's future will be determined at a later date.

“I don't know if this is her last race, but this is her most important race,” Bell said.
