Dale Romans has so much depth to his 3-year-olds this spring that he was able to scratch the best of his three runners entered in the Grade 2, \$400,000 Fountain of Youth Stakes on March 3, yet still win

the race while turning back last year's divisional champion.

At the end of a long, long day at Gulfstream Park, Romans stood tallest of all in the winner's circle after the last of 14 races, basking in the glow of the 18-1 upset pulled off moments earlier by his colt Promises Fulfilled. But he was exhausted.

"It's been a long day," Romans said. "I'm going to bed."

Romans more than nine hours earlier had scratched Free Drop Billy from the race, then worked him for next week's Gotham Stakes at Aqueduct. He went with a pair of longshots, Promises Fulfilled and 9-1 Storm Runner, both of whom had to take on the Eclipse Award winner, Good Magic.

Promises Fulfilled, starting from the outside post in the field of nine, benefited from aggressive early handling from jockey Irad Ortiz Jr., and the odd strategy employed by some of his rivals. It added up to Promises Fulfilled being able to make

the top while being able to slow the pace to a manageable rate.

Machismo, who seemed as if he'd be part of the early pace, was not sent, and Storm Runner ran into more traffic down the backstretch than motorists encounter here at rush hour on I-95. Strike Power was allowed to stalk Promises Fulfilled, a move that avoided a pitched early battle and allowed those two to be at the forefront throughout.

Promises Fulfilled (\$38.40) turned back Strike Power's bid in upper stretch and was coming away at the end of the race. He won by 2 1/4 lengths, and it was another 2 1/4 lengths back to third-place Good Magic, who was heavily favored at 3-5 in his first start since winning the Breeders' Cup Juvenile and, with it, the Eclipse Award as champion 2-year-old male.

Machismo was fourth and was followed, in order, by Marconi, Gotta Go, Storm Runner, He Takes Charge, and Peppered.

Promises Fulfilled covered 1 1/16 miles

on the fast main track in 1:44.17.

"This is a big stepping-stone," said Romans, who said Promises Fulfilled would return in the Florida Derby here in four weeks. "When horses like this race-track, you stay on this racetrack."

Promises Fulfilled won twice in three starts last year. He won a maiden race at Churchill Downs first time out Sept. 17, then an allowance race at Keeneland on Oct. 13, before finishing third Nov. 25 in the Kentucky Jockey Club Stakes, a race in which he tried to lug out the whole race.

"He should be undefeated," Romans said. "He popped a splint in that race."

That injury, to the left front leg of Promises Fulfilled, required some time off but no extensive therapy, and certainly not surgery, Romans said. Upon arrival at Gulfstream for the winter, "he started training like a Derby horse," Romans said.

Romans admitted, though, that owner Robert Baron "pushed me to run in a stakes right off the bat, and he was right."

The draw necessitated decisive action, and Ortiz provided it.

"I told the jock to push the pedal and try to open up," Romans said. "And a lot of times when people see what they think is a lot of speed on paper, they take back."

Promises Fulfilled made the lead with a 23.80-second opening quarter, then slowed the pace down. He went the second quarter in 24.59 seconds, and third in 24.21 seconds, to reach the six-furlong mark in 1:12.60.

"He was galloping along easily, with his ears up," Romans said. "When his ears were up on the backside, I knew he'd be tough to get by."

No one could.

Strike Power was trying two turns for the first time after a pair of sprint wins.

"I thought he ran well," said his trainer, Mark Hennig, who said his rider, Luis Saez, chose not to sprint with Promises Fulfilled leaving the gate because he was afraid of getting into a duel.

"Like Luis said, they were dead set on

being there,” Hennig said. “Hopefully he’ll keep moving forward.”

Chad Brown, who trains Good Magic, said his horse “got a good trip there.”

“Had good position early, the latter part of the race he didn’t have it,” Brown said. “My horse got a little tired. He came back blowing pretty good, like he needed the race. Hopefully he got what he needed out of it and will go on to the next step.”

The next step for Promises Fulfilled is the Florida Derby.

Promises Fulfilled, by Shackleford – whom Romans trained to a Preakness win – was purchased as a yearling for just \$37,000. Whatever promises there were for a horse of that price, he’s fulfilling them.

Trainer Shug McGaughey’s 2,000th career victory came, appropriately enough, in a Grade 2 Stakes after his promising 3-year-old filly Fly So High rallied to a convincing three-length decision in the Davona Dale on March 3 at Gulfstream Park. But the celebration was tempered, at least for the time being, after jockey Jose Ortiz dismounted Fly So High on the way back to the winner’s circle, feeling the filly might have been off in her left front.

Fly So High returned to her barn in the horse ambulance. But McGaughey was cautiously optimistic in the prognosis after examining his latest star on the racetrack prior to walking back to the winner’s circle to receive the accolades for his 2,000th win.

“Jose said when he turned around, she felt a little funny so he jumped off her,” said McGaughey. “I thought when she walked on the van she was sound. Patty [Marquis], the state vet, said maybe she was 1 1/2 to 2 [on the lameness scale]. She was a bit pumped up, obviously, and I’m sure when I get back to the barn I’ll be able to tell more.”

As for her performance, Fly So High received rave reviews. Forced out a bit after the start by Take Charge Paula following an alert beginning, Fly So High rated just off and outside the early leaders, was fanned about four to five paths wide rallying into the stretch, readily overtook Heavenhasmynikki to gain control near midstretch, and won going away.

Take Charge Paula ducked out a bit at the start, came wide trying to rally with the winner into the stretch, could not keep pace but continued on willingly to be second-best over a tiring Heavenhasmynikki.

Fly So High is a daughter of Malibu Moon

owned by the Phipps Stable. She covered a mile in 1:38.69 and paid \$4.80 to win.

“I thought her race was good,” said McGaughey. “I thought Jose put her in a good position after she broke well. She’s a big, old long-stride filly. He kept her busy. I told him in the paddock once she gets her feet under her, they’ll have a hard time outsprinting her to the wire.”

As for his 2,000th win, McGaughey said, “I think it’s exciting. Obviously, I’m thrilled with it. There are a tremendous amount of people to thank for it. I’m the guy who gets the credit, but there are a lot of people behind the scenes who deserve the credit.”

The first 10 horses who chased One Go All Go for 1 3/8 miles over the Gulfstream Park turf course on March 3 were never able to get past him in the 23rd running of the Mac Diarmida.

What it took was a sensational rally from the longtime trailer, Sadler's Joy, to finally overhaul One Go All Go, making the public look smart in its prognosis of the Grade 2, \$200,000 turf fixture. Sadler's Joy, a Grade 1 winner making his first start in four months, shot past with about 70 yards to go to win by three-quarters of a length, with One Go All Go, a 12-1 shot under Chris Landeros, another three-quarters of a length ahead of Nessy.

The winner paid \$5.80 as the favorite in the 12-horse field after finishing in 2:12.93 over firm going.

"The plan was to be closer," said Julien Leparoux, who rode Sadler's Joy for owner-breeder Woodslane Farm and trainer Tom Albertrani. "But he broke slow, so I bided my time and let him get his feet under him. When it was time to go, I went around everyone because I didn't want his momentum stopped. It all worked out. He ran a great race."

Sadler's Joy, a 5-year-old horse by Kitten's Joy, rallied to win the Grade 1 Sword Dancer at Saratoga last summer before finishing a late-running fourth in both the Joe Hirsch Turf Classic and the Breeders' Cup Turf, all with Leparoux aboard. From 15 starts, he now has banked nearly \$1.35 million for Rene and Lauren Woolcott of Woodslane.

Age has proven irrelevant in the success story of a 9-year-old gelding named Hogy. Now it seems that distance is no factor either.

Long established as a turf sprinter, Hogy stretched out beautifully over the Gulfstream Park turf when posting a 3 3/4-length victory in the 52nd running of the Grade 3, \$150,000 Canadian Turf at a mile on March 3.

"He's always acted like he wants to go farther," said Mike Maker, who has trained Hogy since claiming him on behalf of owner Michael Hui for \$80,000 last August at Saratoga. "As good as he's trained, we thought we'd give something like this a shot."

Hogy, ridden by Irad Ortiz Jr., sat a good trip in fifth, well behind a pace contested by Conquest Sandman and Blind Ambition. Into the far turn, as the field began to bunch together, Hogy got first run on the others, angling out to open daylight leaving the eighth pole and finishing in 1:35.28 over firm going. He paid \$13 to win.

Galleon Mast, the 5-2 favorite, rallied for second, 1 1/4 lengths before March in third.

Hogy, a Kentucky-bred by Offlee Wild, now has 19 wins and 13 seconds in 50 career starts and earnings of more than \$1.3 million. His career debut was in June 2011, and since then, he has had five different trainers and eight stakes wins, including one-mile stakes wins over synthetics in the Grade 3 Hanshin Cup at Arlington and the Presque Isle Mile, both as a 4-year-old in 2013.

His only two prior attempts around two turns came back-to-back in 2013: the Presque Isle Mile, followed by an eighth-place finish in the off-the-turf Shadwell

Turf Mile at Keeneland, where Silver Max defeated Wise Dan on Polytrack.

“Hogy is Hogy,” said Maker. “He loves his job. I’m grateful to have him in the barn.”

Benefitting from a perfect trip under Irad Ortiz Jr. while reaffirming her class and versatility, Holy Helena quickly reeled in Daring Duchess for a clear-cut victory in the 30th running of the Grade 3, \$150,000 The Very One at Gulfstream on March 3.

“Gorgeous,” is how winning trainer Jimmy Jerkens described the ride Ortiz gave Holy Helena in her 1 3/4-length triumph in the 1 3/16-mile turf race. “Irad has been riding so incredible.”

The training job wasn’t so bad either. Already a winner over dirt and synthetics, Holy Helena now has started her 4-year-old season with two victories in as many tries since moving to turf.

“I think she’s good at all of them,” said Mike Doyle, racing manager for the filly’s owner and breeder, the Stronach Stables of Frank Stronach.

Daring Duchess, the 6-5 favorite in a field of seven fillies and mares, cut out an easy pace when left alone on the lead, but Ortiz always had her in his sights when saving ground and loping along just a few lengths back. Approaching the quarter pole, Ortiz asked Holy Helena for her best, and the filly deftly angled out to prove best down the stretch. She paid \$9.40 as the second choice after finishing in 1:54.67 over firm turf.

Daring Duchess was another 1 1/2 lengths before Palinodie, with Empress of the Nile another three-quarters of a length back in fourth.

Although she won Canada’s premier race last July, the Queen’s Plate, none of the four wins from seven prior starts for Holy Helena had been in a graded event. Her victory was worth \$91,140 and lifted her career bankroll to \$889,133.

Doyle said a variety of spots are open to Holy Helena, an Ontario-bred daughter of Ghostzapper. “I’m sure we can find something,” he said.

Coming off a career-best effort in his 2017 finale, trainer Kathy Ritvo decided Classic Rock needed enough time to properly recuperate from the effort. The decision paid huge dividends after the speedster returned from the 10-week hiatus to register a convincing three-length victory over 90-1 Sweetontheladies in the \$100,000 Gulfstream Park Sprint on March 3.

Classic Rock benefitted from a perfectly judged ride by Luis Saez, who placed the 4-year-old son of Maclean's Music within easy striking position just off the early pace of Rock and Fellers. Classic Rock split horses into the stretch, forged to command approaching the furlong marker, quickly pulled clear and was not threatened thereafter.

Sweetontheladies rallied from near the rear of the field to finish second, a neck in front of Eight Town, who loomed menacingly through midstretch but could not kick on at the end. Favorable Outcome was never a serious factor, finishing a disappointing sixth as the heavy favorite in his first start since a third-place finish in the Grade 1 Malibu.

Classic Rock is owned by Reeves Thoroughbred Racing, who partnered with Ritvo to win the 2013 Breeders' Cup Classic with Mucho Macho Man. The Grade 3 Gulfstream Park Sprint was Ritvo's first graded stakes victory since the Breeders' Cup.

Classic Rock returned \$13.20 for his fifth win in six starts at Gulfstream Park. Final time for 6 1/2 furlongs was 1:18.32 seconds over a fast track.

"Luis rode a perfect race," said Ritvo. "The horse was ready today. We gave him some time after his last race because he ran such a great race. Mr. and Mrs. Reeves allowed me to give him the time, like they always do. They're perfect owners. And he came back and showed us he appreciated it."

Ritvo said she was not surprised Classic Rock was able to rate his abundant speed and win from off the pace.

"He's shown he could rate before," Ritvo said. "He's just a classy, classy horse who loves his job. He'll do whatever you ask him to do. And he loves this racetrack. He loves being here. He doesn't like moving too much."

One or even two stakes victories might not have been sufficient to prove that Thewayiam has been the best 3-year-old turf filly in action this winter at Gulfstream Park.

But after a third straight stakes triumph, taking the 31st running of the Grade 3, \$100,000 Herecomesthebride on March 3, it's time to stop denying the filly her due.

"She has won three stakes already this year," said Jose Ortiz, who never left the inner rail in guiding Thewayiam to a 1 3/4-length score in the Herecomesthebride. "She's a pretty amazing filly."

Favored at 3-2 in the field of eight, Thewayiam was ahead of only one rival with a half-mile left in the 1 1/16-mile Herecomesthebride. But then she began making up ground, and when Ortiz spied an opportunity to shoot her up the rail when front-running My Favorite Gift floated out after turning for home, the issue was quickly settled.

"She has a great turn of foot," Ortiz said.

Trained by Graham Motion for a four-way partnership that includes prominent New York owner Michael Dubb, who helped lead the filly into the winner's circle afterward, Thewayiam is a French-bred who now has won 4 of 5 starts in the U.S. since being imported from her native country last summer. She returned \$5 after finish-

ing in 1:41.41 over a firm course.

Amertume, well-placed from the start under John Velazquez, fought off Brattata for the place spot in a photo, with Princess Warrior rallying belatedly to finish another 1 1/4 lengths behind in fourth.

Thewayiam becomes an obvious candidate to attempt a sweep of the four divisional races at this championship meet by running back in the Sanibel Island on the March 31 Florida Derby undercard. The Herecomesthebride followed the Jan. 6 Ginger Brew and Feb. 3 Sweetest Chant.

When Todd Pletcher looked at the way the Palm Beach Stakes figured to unfold on March 3 at Gulfstream Park, he was concerned Speed Franco would be loose on the lead, and that could work against his trainee, Maraud. Both he and John Velazquez figured the best way to overcome the potential disadvantage was to stay close to Speed Franco and then try to outkick him.

The plan worked, which Pletcher said was because of Velazquez.

"Johnny's pushing all the right buttons," Pletcher said.

Maraud, who had Speed Franco in his sights throughout, overpowered Speed Franco through the lane to win the Grade 3, \$100,000 Palm Beach for 3-year-old grass runners, giving Maraud the first stakes win of his career.

Maraud won by a neck over Speed Franco, who led for the first mile of the 1 1/16-mile race. Therapist, who acted up in the gate prior to the start and had to be reloaded, rallied for third, with Hawkish fourth after making a threatening move on the turn.

Neepawa was fifth in the field of seven, then came Renaissance Frolic and Eye of the Jedi, who trailed throughout after being hopelessly left at the break.

Maraud (\$7) covered 1 1/16 miles on the firm course in 1:41.01, and he ran the final five-sixteenths of a mile in less than 29 seconds.

"We got the trip we talked about. We thought the 1 horse," Pletcher said, referring to Speed Franco, "could get loose. We wanted to make sure he didn't get away.

He's a quick horse, and on this course, with an uncontested lead, he might not come back."

Velazquez had won the previous race in front-running fashion on Team of Teams, so he was cognizant of the course profile.

Maraud, a colt by Blame owned by Treadway Racing Stable, has won three times in five starts. He was coming off a victory in a first-level allowance here on Jan. 13. Pletcher said he could race again at Gulfstream or await Keeneland.

This could be an interesting spring for Midnight Bisou, the winner of the Grade 3 Santa Ysabel Stakes at Santa Anita on March 3.

The race lost much of its appeal on the morning of the race when the undefeated Dream Tree was scratched by trainer Bob Baffert, who opted not to start his filly on a wet-fast race-track.

Regardless of the competition, Midnight Bisou (\$2.60) handled the assignment.

Ridden by Mike Smith, Midnight Bisou closed from third in a field of five to win by 2 1/4 lengths over 8-1 Thirteen Squared. Midnight Bisou rallied three wide on the turn to take the lead in early stretch.

"I thought she had them," trainer Bill Spawr said. "When you press on her and ask her, she kicks it."

Midnight Bisou was timed in 1:41.10. Smith hardly used his whip, tapping Midnight Bisou in a back-handed motion a few times in the final sixteenth.

Thirteen Squared, fourth behind Dream Tree in the Grade 2 Las Virgenes Stakes on Feb. 4, finished second, eight lengths in front of Spring Lily. Sweetsonofthenile and One Fast Broad completed the order of finish.

Midnight Bisou, by Midnight Lute, has won 2 of 4 starts and earned \$210,000 for Allen Racing and Bloom Racing. She was second by a nose to Dream Tree in her first two starts and only races as a 2-year-old – a maiden race here last October and the minor Desi Arnaz Stakes at Del Mar in November.

In her 3-year-old debut, Midnight Bisou won for the first time in her career in the Grade 2 Santa Ynez Stakes at seven furlongs on Jan. 7.
