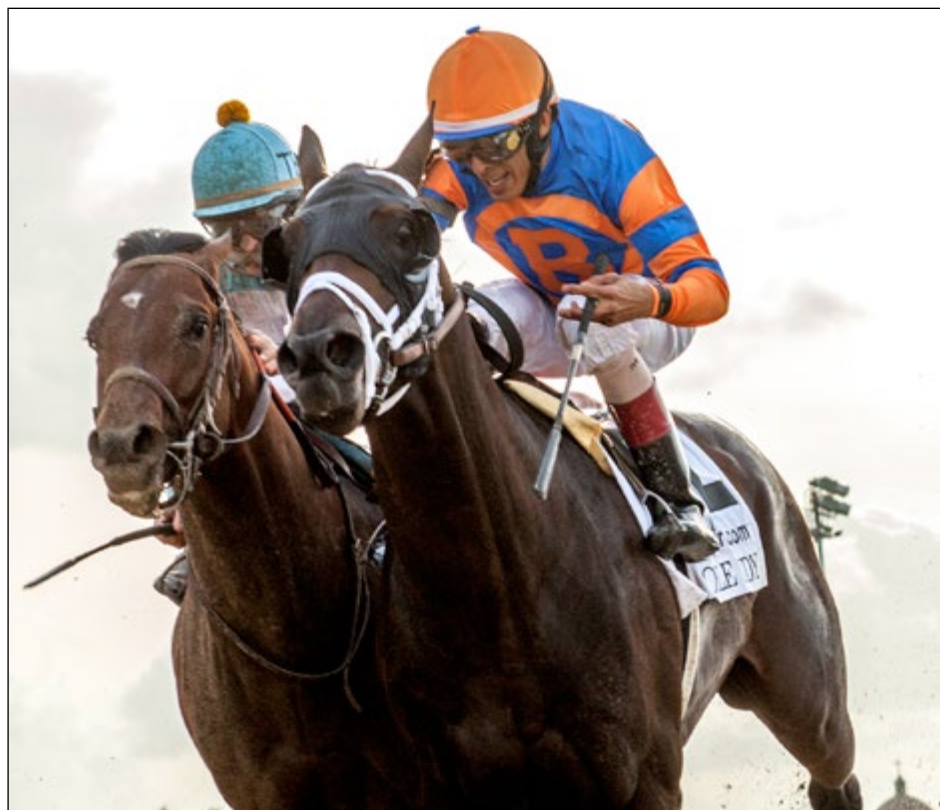

A colt who's still figuring it out, a jockey who has it all figured out, and a trainer who has the best record at maximizing value of 3-year-olds in the spring joined forces on Mar. 24 at Fair Grounds to win the Grade 2, \$1 million Louisiana Derby, as Noble Indy, under John Velazquez, added to the lengthy scroll of Derby preps trainer Todd Pletcher has knocked off over the years.

Noble Indy, wearing blinkers after suffering his first defeat when finishing third last month in the Risen Star, battled back bravely after being passed at midstretch to deny a storybook victory by Lone Sailor, whose co-owner, local sports magnate Tom Benson, died several days earlier.

Velazquez was able to get Noble Indy to re-rally when Lone Sailor dropped down near him, the end of an eventful journey that called on all of Velazquez's skill to get an overeager Noble Indy to last the 1 1/8 miles.

And as for Pletcher, while his record in the Kentucky Derby is often picked apart, the fact is he has won the race twice – including last year with Velazquez on Always Dreaming. He moves the chess pieces better than anyone this time of year, as is obvious by the long list of horses who might not be top-shelf Derby contenders come the first Saturday in May but who get to the race by having won lucrative preps.

Noble Indy continued a sensational spring for his breeder and co-owner, WinStar Farm, which already this season has annexed the Holy Bull with Audible and the Tampa Bay Derby with Quip, and which co-owns the exciting prospect Justify, headed next to the Arkansas Derby.

Noble Indy, the 5-2 favorite, was making only the fourth start of his career, and he's "a work in progress," Pletcher said by phone from Florida after the race.

"I liked that he improved from the Risen Star, had better temperament in the paddock and post parade," Pletcher said. "He's come a long way, but there's room for improvement."

Noble Indy, starting from post 2 in the 10-horse field, let the longshot Marmello dash off to the lead through fractions of 22.97 seconds for the opening quarter and 46.64 seconds for the half. But Velazquez said while Noble Indy was "much better" than in the Risen Star, he was still "too keen on the backstretch," forcing Velazquez to try and reach a compromise between taking too big a hold and letting Noble Indy have his way.

Noble Indy seized the lead three furlongs out, but then Lone Sailor launched a bid that carried him to the front a furlong out, and My Boy Jack made a wide, late run

from last. Those three were right across the track in deep stretch, but Velazquez said Noble Indy surged anew along the rail when Lone Sailor came closer to him in the final sixteenth.

Noble Indy won by a neck over Lone Sailor, with My Boy Jack another half-length back in third.

"He never noticed that horse until he started coming next to me," said Velazquez, who added that Noble Indy is "very talented, very green."

Noble Indy completed 1 1/8 miles on the fast main track in 1:50.28. The colt, a son of Take Charge Indy, has three wins in four starts since beginning his career Dec. 3 with a maiden win at Gulfstream.

In addition to the first prize of \$600,000, Noble Indy earned 100 points in the system used by Churchill Downs to determine the field for the May 5 Kentucky Derby, guaranteeing him a spot in the field.

The 40 points earned by Lone Sailor also should get him in, and the result thrilled

his trainer, Tom Amoss, a New Orleans native who attended the funeral service for Benson, the owner of the NFL Saints and NBA Pelicans.

Good Samaritan rallied from last and rolled to an easy win in the Grade 2, \$400,000 New Orleans Handicap while making his 4-year-old debut Mar. 24 at Fair Grounds.

The race was marred by an injury to The Player, who was pulled up on the far turn by jockey Calvin Borel. The Player, the 4-5 favorite after impressively winning the Mineshaft Handicap on Feb. 17, led around the first turn and down the backstretch but was overtaken by the half-mile pole, lost his position on the far turn, and was taken out of the race past the three-eighths pole.

The Player was fitted with a Kinsey splint on his right front leg, loaded into the equine ambulance, and transported back to the Fair Grounds barn of trainer Buff Bradley, where he was diagnosed, Bradley said, with fractures to both sesamoids in the foreleg.

Good Samaritan, the 6-5 favorite, never shows speed and ran true to form while starting for the first time since a runner-up finish Nov. 24 in the Grade 1 Clark Handicap. Under Joel Rosario, he trailed into the homestretch through splits of 23.88 seconds, 48.18, and 1:11.85, but as the field straightened for home, Good Samaritan had caught the three horses still in the race. Good Samaritan struck the front at the eighth pole and quickly pulled clear, beating Hollywood Handsome to the wire by about three lengths, getting his 1 1/8 miles on a fast track in 1:49.87.

"He was happy where he was," Rosario said. "He just loves to run, and he finished really well the last quarter of a mile."

Scuba was third, and Han Sense finished fourth.

Good Samaritan won the Grade 2 Jim Dandy last summer at Saratoga when switched to dirt after a series of tough-luck grass races, but he failed to improve off that performance in the Travers Stakes and the Jockey Club Gold Cup before coming within a half-length of winning the Clark. Good Samaritan got a winter break, and trainer Bill Mott circled the New Orleans Handicap as a starting point for his 2018 campaign.

A son of Harlan's Holiday and the Pulpit mare Pull Dancer, Good Samaritan has a record of 4-3-1 from 11 starts, and the best may be yet to come from a later-maturing colt who seems equally capable on turf and dirt.

Walden didn't rule out a return to grass at some point but said the goal is to make Good Samaritan a Grade 1 winner on dirt.

Tom Amoss has made some memorable claims during a long, successful training career. Chocolate Martini will rank right up there with the best of them after posting a 13-1 upset in the Grade 2, \$400,000 Fair Grounds Oaks on Mar. 24 two starts after Amoss and Double Doors Racing claimed her for \$25,000.

Mitchell Murrill rode Chocolate Martini to the biggest win of his career, just holding on over Eskimo Kisses.

Chocolate Martini had only Eskimo Kisses, who was a distant last, behind her around the clubhouse turn and down the backstretch, but that was the right place to be. Classy Act, the even-money favorite under Javier Castellano, broke a beat slow, just as she had last month in the Rachel Alexandra Stakes, and just like in that race, she quickly went to the lead and set a strong pace — too strong.

The half-mile went in a taxing 46.28 seconds, and when Classy Act tripped the timer in 1:11.02 for six furlongs, the pursuers were coming to her. Chocolate Martini launched her outside bid at about the five-sixteenths pole, and as Classy Act tired and drifted out at the furlong marker, Chocolate Martini collared her just before the sixteenth pole. She got the best of Wonder Gadot down to the inside and hit the line just before Eskimo Kisses, who was finishing fastest, could reach her.

“The race set up kind of how I planned, with a blistering pace up front,” Murrill said. “I just held her together and waited to punch the button.”

Chocolate Martini was timed in 1:44.44 for the 1 1/16 miles. Wonder Gadot finished third, as she had in the Rachel Alexandra Stakes last month, while Classy Act faded to fourth, just ahead of Just a Julie.

The Fair Grounds Oaks is a major qualifying race for the Kentucky Oaks, offering a total of 170 points distributed 100-40-20-10 to the first four finishers. Chocolate Martini obviously is in, and her connections plan on running.

Chocolate Martini is by Broken Vow out of Nicksappealinglady, by Successful Appeal, and she resided in the barn of Bret Calhoun, Classy Act’s trainer, when

Amoss and Double Doors claimed her Feb. 2. Chocolate Martini narrowly won a first-level allowance race while entered under a \$50,000 claiming option on Feb. 18, and Amoss elected to pass on another race at that class level last week at Fair Grounds in favor of the local Oaks.

“She came to me in great shape,” Amoss said. “We didn’t really do anything different than the other guys, but we caught her coming into her maturity level at just the right time.”

And now that \$25,000 claim is bound for the Kentucky Oaks.

Synchrony’s time off last year certainly allowed him to grow up, mature, and come back a better horse, but it was his versatility that carried him to victory Mar. 23 at Fair Grounds in the Grade 2, \$300,000 Muniz Memorial Handicap for older turf runners.

Unlike in the Fair Grounds Handicap, which he won last time out in his 2018 debut by rallying from well back, the course profile in recent weeks at Fair Grounds convinced trainer Mike Stidham and jockey Joe Bravo that Synchrony needed to be closer to have his best chance.

Synchrony was a willing partner in the scheme, and he closed best to beat longshots Arklow (11-1) and Zulu Alpha (91-1).

“We didn’t want to be far back, the way the course has been speed-favoring,” Stidham said. “He’s so adaptable. That’s the beauty of him. He’s a sweetheart of a horse.”

Synchrony, who started from the rail in the 11-horse field, saved ground early as Zulu Alpha set the pace, closely monitored by Mr. Misunderstood and Forge.

“He was so willing,” Bravo said. “We sat right in the pocket comfortably and

watched it unfold.”

Bravo tipped him out midway on the far turn and took him to the center of the course for the stretch drive.

Synchrony, the 3-1 favorite, beat Arklow by 1 3/4 lengths, with Zula Alpha holding on for third, another three-quarters of a length back.

Synchrony completed about 1 1/8 miles on firm turf in 1:49.59.

Stidham trains Synchrony for his owner and breeder, the Pin Oak Stable of Josephine Abercrombie, who flew in for the race from Lexington, in company with a number of friends, including trainer Chris Speckert.

Now age 5, Synchrony, by Tapit, has won five times in 12 starts. The Muniz was only his second start since returning from a layoff of more than eight months. Stidham said he didn't have any serious issues, just was given enough time to get right, even getting additional time off when he initially did not train satisfactorily.

When he was put back in training anew, “He came back like a different horse,” Stidham said.

The rankings among California's turf marathon division have become clear in the recent months. Itsinthepost is slightly better than Hayabusa One.

The two veterans were a nose apart in the Grade 2 San Marcos Stakes at 1 1/4 miles on Feb. 3. On Mar. 24, the margin was slightly more definitive in the Grade 2 San Luis Rey Stakes. Itsinthepost prevailed by three-quarters of a length in the \$201,380 race at 1 1/2 miles on turf.

Itsinthepost (\$4.20 to win) raced closer to the pace than Hayabusa One and held off his rival in the final strides after leading by two lengths with a furlong remaining.

Winning jockey Tyler Baze expected a threat from Hayabusa One and jockey Victor Espinoza in the final half-mile and adjusted his tactics accordingly.

“I waited longer to push the button,” Baze said. “I waited for Victor to come up to me.”

Both riders had their mounts well positioned in the first six furlongs. The race was run on the oval portion of the turf course and did not start on the hillside, which is customary for races at that distance.

Recent rain led track officials to move the race to the oval. The turf course was rated good from the rain.

Aquaphobia, an 11-1 outsider, led for much of the first 1 1/4 miles and was challenged by Colonist and Itsinthepost entering the stretch. At that point, Baze had Itsinthepost where he hoped to be. Baze said he intended to keep Itsinthepost near the front and racing on the outside after talking strategy with trainer Jeff Mullins.

“He doesn't give instructions, but with this horse he said see if you can get a stalking trip on the outside,” Baze said of their pre-race conversation.

Espinoza had Hayabusa One in sixth place early, and then fifth through the first mile.

“I had a good trip,” Espinoza said. “I saved ground the first two turns. At the half-mile pole, I wanted to find my way through them. I followed the favorite. He's a good horse.”

Espinoza thought Hayabusa One could catch Itsinthepost — until the leader pulled away in early stretch.

“When Tyler let him run, he opened up two or three lengths and we couldn't keep up with that,” Espinoza said.

When the margin began to diminish in the last furlong, Baze moved Itsinthepost slightly out to allow the 6-year-old French-bred gelding to better see his rival.

“I wanted him to feel the horse,” Baze said. “There aren't many that have the will to win and he's one of those horses.”

Responsibleforlove, the lone mare in the field, finished third at 17-1, closing from seventh. Colonist faded to finish fourth, followed by Rye, Aquaphobia, Play Hard to Get, Oscar Dominguez, and Saltini.

Itsinthepost was timed in 2:27.73.

Itsinthepost, owned by Jed Cohen's Red Baron's Farm, has won 9 of 33 starts and earned \$1,095,712.

Itsinthepost has won six Grade 2 stakes since the start of 2017, the best span of his career.

Selcourt ran her winning streak to three with a commanding win in the Grade 2 Santa Monica Stakes for female sprinters at Santa Anita on Mar. 24.

Allowed to set a moderate early pace, Selcourt (\$7.40 to win) was never threatened in the stretch, winning by 4 1/2 lengths under jockey Tyler Baze.

"She's getting better and better," Baze said. "She broke like a shot. She ran around there very relaxed."

The \$200,000 Santa Monica drew a field of five. Selcourt led by a length over 4-5 favorite Paradise Woods through an opening quarter-mile in 22.85 seconds. Paradise Woods, a two-time Grade 1 winner last year, moved closer on the turn, but could not sustain the threat.

Selcourt led by 4 1/2 lengths with a furlong remaining and finished seven furlongs in 1:21.

"She got soft splits early and came home fast," trainer John Sadler said.

Marley's Freedom closed from fourth to finish second at 8-1, her first graded stakes placing in her third such race.

"We're happy," trainer Bob Hess Jr. said. "We beat some nice fillies."

Skye Diamonds, who was fourth in the Breeders' Cup Filly and Mare Sprint at Del Mar last November, finished third, beaten 5 3/4 lengths.

Skye Diamonds was third on the turn, faded to fourth in early stretch and passed Paradise Woods in the final furlong to reclaim third at the finish.

Selcourt, by Tiz Wonderful, has won 4 of 6 starts and earned \$283,920 for a partnership that includes breeder Keith Abrahams along with Sandra Lazaruk and Medallion Racing.

The Santa Monica was the most prestigious win of Selcourt's career and her third stakes win. The current winning streak includes the minor Kalookan Queen Stakes in January and the Grade 3 Las Flores Stakes on Feb. 18.

Runaway Ghost picked up 50 Kentucky Derby qualifying points on Mar. 25 when the New Mexico-based colt won the state's richest Thoroughbred race: the Grade 3, \$800,000 Sunland Derby.

Runaway Ghost darted to a 2 3/4-length win over Dream Baby Dream. Runaway Ghost went off as the favorite in the field of 12.

"I'd say he's the No. 1 Thoroughbred I've ever had," said Joe Peacock, who bred and owns Runaway Ghost.

Runaway Ghost (\$9.80) broke well from post 11 and settled in fourth under Tracy Hebert as All Out Blitz ran the opening half-mile in 45.80 seconds and six furlongs in 1:10.27, pushed along by New York Central (there was no time available for the opening quarter). Runaway Ghost advanced three wide on the final turn, hit the quarter pole in front, and comfortably held off the stretch bid of Dream Baby Dream.

Runaway Ghost covered the 1 1/8 miles on a fast track in 1:49.20.

"We knew with an outside draw we could get the horse to relax better and it worked out," winning trainer Todd Fincher said. "We had a long run to the first turn. We figured we might be a little wide, but that would be better than a horse laying on us, forcing our hand.

"He was actually a little farther back in the early stages than I thought."

Runaway Ghost had won two stakes prior to the Sunland Derby, both on the front end. He accounted for the \$55,000 Golden Nugget in November at Golden Gate when based in California, then captured the \$106,000 Riley Allison in his New Mexico debut Jan. 28 at Sunland.

Runaway Ghost is a Kentucky-bred son of Ghostzapper. His dam, Rose's Desert, was a multiple stakes winner in New Mexico.

Dream Baby Dream earned 20 Kentucky Derby points for his runner-up finish in the Sunland Derby. Peace earned 10 points after winning a photo for third over fourth-place finisher Seven Trumpets, who picked up 5.

Fincher said plans are to be determined for Runaway Ghost, who was made a late nominee to the Triple Crown.

"We'll see how he comes back from this race," Fincher said. "We all want to go to

the Derby, but we'll put the horse first and let him tell us what we want to do."

Mine That Bird in 2009 parlayed a fourth-place finish in the Sunland Derby into a 50-1 upset in the Kentucky Derby.

Runaway Ghost earned \$400,000 for his win in the Sunland Derby, improving his record to four wins from seven starts and earnings of \$563,510.

checked home a tiring third while Impact Player was never a serious factor as the 8-5 favorite.

Madison's Luna covered six furlongs over a fast track in 1:10.45 and returned \$11 to win.

"He left me a little surprised in his maiden win at Tampa and I was maybe a little surprised how he did it today," Bauer said. "It was a pretty honest pace and you always get excited when they come to the quarter pole in that manner, and I was really excited when Julien cut him loose

and he put a few on them and then maintained it. He carries his head up to the right and when he picks up speed it gets higher, but Julien said it's just a Tapit thing."

Bauer said the Pat Day Mile would be next for Madison's Luna.

"I think he'll stretch out, you saw how he can relax behind horses," Bauer said. "That's the race I've kind of been pointing for with him all along."
