Hi Happy confirmed his status as a top older turf marathon runner with a half-

length victory over the Grade 1 winner Sadler's Joy in the Grade 1, \$700,000 Man o' War Stakes at Belmont Park on May 12.

The win was the second straight graded stakes success for Hi Happy, a 6-year-old Argentine-bred who had won the Grade 2 Pan American at Gulfstream six weeks earlier. Hi Happy, a son of Pure Prize trained by Todd Pletcher, improved his record to 8 for 13 and pushed his career earnings to \$1,092,961.

"He's a horse that came to us in great condition, remains that way, and he's just finding his prime now being a South American-bred," Pletcher said. "He's been a joy to train."

Hi Happy, ridden by Luis Saez, got the same trip in the Man o' War that he did in the Pan Am. He stalked the pacesetter One Go All Go, took over from that one in deep stretch, and was able to keep Sadler's Joy at bay.

Hi Happy covered the 1 3/8 miles over

a good inner turf course in 2:14.79 and returned \$5.90 as the 9-5 favorite.

"It's the trip we expected to get; he broke alertly and crept his way up there," Pletcher said. "Once the other horse cleared him, we got in the position we wanted, got into a comfortable."

Said Saez: "He runs pretty hard all the time. He's getting better and better."

Pletcher said Hi Happy would be considered for the Grade 1 Manhattan on June 9.

Sadler's Joy, who won last year's Sword Dancer, came with his usual late run under Julien Leparoux but was second-best.

"He had a good trip, I don't think there was anything we could fault, we were second-best," trainer Tom Albertrani said. "We'll keep going along and try to get him in the next one."

Sadler's Joy finished a half-length in front of One Go All Go. He was followed by Call Provision, Catcho En Die, Postulation, Bigger Picture, and Wake Forest.

Coming to the top of the Belmont Park stretch, when Kyle Frey guided Blended Citizen outside and into the clear after sitting behind three horses, the 26-year-old jockey, riding his first ever race at Belmont Park, was quite confident.

"Once he got outside, I knew it was over," Frey said. "I should have just thrown my stick over the inside rail."

Well, it wasn't quite that easy, but Blended Citizen, after receiving three left-handed taps of Frey's whip in upper stretch, ran down Core Beliefs to win the Grade 3, \$350,000 Peter Pan Stakes on May 12 and will not be pointed to the Grade 1, \$1.5 million Belmont Stakes on June 9.

Core Beliefs, the 2-1 favorite who was part of what was a four-horse pace battle early, finished 1 1/2 lengths behind the winner and four lengths clear of third-place Just Whistle. High North, Zing Zang, and Gotta Go completed the order of finish.

The win was the first on dirt for Blended Citizen, who was supplemented to the Peter Pan after he failed to draw into the field from the also eligible list for the Kentucky Derby.

Jack Sinsterson, an assistant to trainer

Doug O'Neill, said the Peter Pan-Belmont was the original plan for Blended Citizen. The Derby only became an option when so many horses ahead of him on the points list dropped out.

"If there is a track in America that would suit this horse it would be Belmont because he's a such a big horse with a big stride, I think that played to his favor today," Sinsterson said.

A contested pace also played in Blended Citizen's favor. Core Beliefs, Just Whistle, High North and Gotta Go were heads apart, four across the track through an opening half-mile in 47.07 seconds. Frey had Blended Citizen right behind them.

Gotta Go was the first to falter and Frey followed the other three until the top of the stretch, when he swung Blended Citizen into the clear. Core Beliefs, under Tyler Baze, put away Just Whistle and High North, but Blended Citizen, with Frey just shaking the right rein at him, glided on past over a wet track labeled good following afternoon showers.

Blended Citizen, a 3-year-old son of Proud Citizen owned by Greg Hall and Sayjay Racing, covered the 1 1/8 miles in 1:49.75. He returned \$11.40 to win.

Blended Citizen won the Jeff Ruby Steaks over Turfway Park's synthetic surface and then finished fifth in the Blue Grass. Frey said the effort in the Blue Grass was better than it may look on paper.

"It wasn't for his style of running," Frey said. "For him to make up as much ground as he did that day, it just goes to show how phenomenal a horse he is, in my opinion."

Frey believes the 1 1/2 miles of the Belmont "Is just what he wants. I was super upset he didn't get in the Derby because I knew a mile and a quarter would even be just fine."

Blended Citizen will remain at Belmont Park to train up to the Belmont Stakes. His connections will wait to see if Kentucky Derby winner Justify wins the Preakness and comes to New York with a chance at the Triple Crown.

"Justify's such a good horse, we'd love for him to win the Preakness and come to Belmont with the potential for a Triple Crown winner," Sinsterson said. "Bob Baffert (the trainer of Justify) is the best out there doing things like that but we'll be liking our chances because he seemed to handle Belmont Park well."

Tonalist, in 2014, is the last horse to win the Peter Pan and Belmont Stakes. The last two winners of the Peter Pan, Timeline and Unified, did not run in the Belmont.

Blended Citizen is likely the only Peter

Pan runner to come back in the Belmont. Trainer Peter Eurton said he was proud of Core Beliefs's performance, but he is not Triple Crown nominated and it would cost his owners a \$50,000 supplemental fee to be eligible to run.

Just when it seems the number of graded stakes-winning turf horses in the barn of trainer Chad Brown cannot possibly grow any larger, a newcomer to his stable shines yet again. The latest occurrence took place on May 12 in the Grade 3, \$200,000 Beaugay Stakes at Belmont when German-bred A Raving Beauty scored stylishly in her United States bow.

Brown also trained the runner-up, favored Inflexibility, who outkicked third-place finisher Lido by a neck.

The Beaugay, at 1 1/16 miles on the turf, was still just a one-mare affair once the field turned into the stretch. It was at the point that A Raving Beauty, who had stalked Team of Teams through splits of 25.62 seconds, 49.87, and 1:12.97, was given the green light by jockey Irad Ortiz Jr.

Although Team of Teams seemed to be moving comfortably on the lead, she could not contain A Raving Beauty once that one was cut loose. A Raving Beauty seemed to break the spirit of her front-running rival as she flew past Team of Teams in the stretch, drawing away to win by three lengths.

“She’s been training extremely well, and was a lot more forwardly placed than I anticipated,” said Brown. “I thought Irad did a really good job to cover up. He had a choice there at the first eighth to maybe put her outside the other speed horse to see if he could settle her that way, or cover up, but I think if he chose to put her outside she might have run off, so I think he really won the race by choosing to cover up.”

A 5-year-old daughter of Mastercrafts-

man owned by Michael Dubb, Madaket Stables, and Bethlehem Stables, she completed 1 1/16 miles on a rain-softened course rated as “good” in 1:41.64.

Team of Teams yielded in the final furlong to finish fourth, and was followed across the wire by Tricky Escape, My Impression, and Broken Bridle.

The Beaugay was the biggest victory of A Raving Beauty’s career, though she came to the U.S. with some quality overseas credentials. A well-traveled mare, who raced 10 times in Germany, France, and Italy last year, she closed out her 2017 campaign in Europe with a runner-up finish in the Group 1 Premio Lydia Tesio in Italy on Oct. 29 and had not raced after that start until the Beaugay.

Kirby’s Penny, a filly owner Kent Spellman had to buy twice, made those investments pay off in a big way when she scored a 1 1/2-length victory in the Grade 3, \$200,000 Vagrancy Handicap at Belmont Park.

Spellman initially purchased Kirby’s Penny for \$70,000 as a yearling. He lost her in a claiming race for \$20,000 on April 7, 2017, then had Ward claim her back 10 days later for \$40,000. In the Vagrancy, Kirby’s Penny earned \$120,000.

“Those guys,” trainer Wesley Ward said of owner Julian Thomas and trainer John Ortiz who had claimed Kirby’s Penny “made a nice profit with a win and a claim, but it all turned for Mr. Spellman, who had put all the money to buy her initially, so that was nice.”

Since the reclaim, Kirby’s Penny had three wins and two seconds. She was making her stakes debut in the Vagrancy in a modest field of six fillies and mares.

Under John Velazquez, Kirby’s Penny pressed the early pace of Sounds Delicious and Chalon, then eased back to let those two duke it out through a half-mile run in 45.12 seconds.

Velazquez guided Kirby’s Penny three to four wide turning for home and she was able to overtake Chalon, who had made the lead in midstretch. Chalon finished second by 3 1/4 lengths over Holiday Disguise, the 7-5 favorite.

Kirby’s Penny, a 5-year-old daughter of **Macho Uno**, covered the 6 1/2 furlongs in 1:16.42 and returned \$16.20 to win.

For Velazquez, it was his fifth victory in the Vagrancy. One of them came in 2004 aboard Bear Fan – bred, owned, and trained by Ward – who owns the track record for 6 1/2 furlongs (1:14.46, shared with Super Shape).

“I never gave Johnny instructions in all these years even when he broke the track record on Bear Fan for me in this race,” Ward said.

Ward said he would likely give Kirby’s Penny a break and point her to the sprint stakes at Saratoga including the Grade 1 Ballerina on Aug. 25.

Cipriano Contreras was a longtime assistant to Chicago-based trainer Mike Reavis before he went out on his own, setting up shop at Indiana Grand in 2016 – emphasis on longtime.

“Thirty years, this is my home right here,” Contreras said, standing in the Arlington winner’s circle a few minutes after Matrooh had won the Grade 3, \$100,000 Hanshin Cup on May 12, rallying from last under Santo Sanjur.

Contreras runs a sharp claiming outfit, and two races ago he and Raul Bahena’s Crystal Racing Enterprises took Matrooh for \$25,000 out of an Oaklawn claimer. He won an allowance race there first off the claim, and in the Hanshin Cup gave Contreras his first graded stakes win with his first such starter.

“He’s a got a lot of back class to him,” Contreras said. “We were hoping to get him

back to his old form, but you never know ‘til it happens.”

Eight-year-old Matrooh has traveled a long and winding road. He began his career in England in 2013, didn’t race at all in 2014, and came to the U.S. the following year, joining Chad Brown’s stable. By the fall of 2015 Matrooh had gotten good enough that he won the Grade 3 Bold Ruler and finished a close third in the Grade 1 Cigar Mile.

Then came another layoff of more than one year, and in five 2017 starts for another new trainer, Dan Peitz, Matrooh never came close to his best form. But Matrooh woke up at Oaklawn this winter just before Contreras claimed him, and Matrooh on in the Hanshin Cup, he appeared to relish his first start over a synthetic surface.

Sanjur, who moved his tack from Arlington to Indiana Grand this year, let Matrooh lope along last of nine as Goneghost, hounded by Harmac, Crewman, and Master Merion, set splits of 23.95 and 46.54 seconds for this one-turn mile. Matrooh began closing the gap around the far turn, and as Goneghost shook off his pace rivals, Sanjur had his mount rolling down the middle of the track. Matrooh collared Goneghost in the final half-furlong and pushed out to a 2 1/2-length win. He stopped the timer in 1:36.43 and paid \$19.60 to win.

Goneghost finished five lengths in front of Western Elegance, who stumbled at the start, raced wide around the turn, and finished decently to beat 2-1 favorite Master Merion by a neck. Then came Great Wide Open, Ghost Hunter, Christian C, Harmac, and last year’s winner, Crewman.

Matrooh, a gelding, is by **Distorted Humor** and out of the Personal Flag mare, Rockcide. His second dam is Belle’s Good Cide, who produced Kentucky Derby and Preakness winner Funny Cide.

A patient and tactical ride by Flavien Prat gave Kanthaka his second seven-furlong graded stakes win of the year in the Grade 3 Lazaro Barrera Stakes for 3-year-olds at Santa Anita on May 12.

Breaking from the rail, Prat kept Kanthaka on the inside to early stretch, waiting behind pacesetters McKale and King Cause. When a gap emerged between the two runners before the eighth pole, Prat urged Kanthaka to the front.

Kanthaka (\$4.40 to win) won the \$100,345 Barrera by three-quarters of a length over 9-1 Beautiful Shot, who closed from fifth. Kanthaka was timed in 1:23.25.

"I made my move when I wanted," Prat said. "Once he got to the lead, he looked around a bit."

Prat had Kanthaka within two lengths of the front in the first half-mile and did not urge his mount until running room developed.

"That was a good effort by the horse and a good effort by Prat," trainer Jerry Hollendorfer said. "He took a chance that he would get through."

Zulfikhar, a 5-1 chance, finished third, followed by McKale, King Cause and Bocephus.

McKale, who had his stakes debut and third start in the Barrera, broke a stride slowly, but had a narrow lead after an opening quarter-mile in 23.05 seconds. McKale was beaten two lengths by Kanthaka.

Kanthaka won the Grade 2 San Vicente Stakes at seven furlongs on Feb. 10 in his stakes debut for the West Point Thoroughbreds partnership.

Kanthaka, by **Jimmy Creed**, has won 3 of 6 starts and earned \$263,663. He won a maiden race at seven furlongs on Dec. 26 in his second start.
