Funtastic came into the \$300,000 United Nations at Monmouth Park on June 30 off a second-level optional-claiming victory and as the least regarded of Chad Brown's four horses in 1 3/8-mile turf race. Accordingly, he was sent off at 23-1 as the longest chance in the nine-horse field.

He vanned back to Belmont Park a Grade 1 winner.

Antonio Gallardo sent Funtastic right to the lead from post 1 and then slowed the tempo as best he could. One Go All Go raced in second position early, with jockey Chris Landeros keeping him about a length behind.

Following a half-mile in 48.89 and six furlongs in 1:13.52, One Go All Go dropped back and Funtastic increased his lead on the far turn. He came into the final furlong with a sizeable advantage and then held his 2-1 favored stablemate Money Multiplier safe by a half-length.

Funtastic paid \$48 and was timed in 2:12.36. He covered his final quarter-mile

in a good 23.21 seconds.

Brown's other two starters in the race, 5-1 Silverwave and 5-2 Kurilov, finished fifth and eighth.

Bigger Picture, last year's U.N. winner for trainer Mike Maker, rallied from last position to get up for third, a half-length ahead of fellow late-runner Vittori Kin. It was a head farther back to Silverwave, who raced three wide early and then made an early move to second position nearing the far turn.

The United Nations is the first Grade 1 win of Gallardo's career, and his third winner on the card. Brown gave him the United Nations trophy to keep.

"I have Grade 2 and Grade 3 [wins], but I have something in my heart that I never have won a Grade 1," Gallardo said.

"I told my mom before the race, 'Mom, I have something in my head that I never win a Grade 1, and my ma said, 'Don't worry you will do it today.' "

Owned by Three Chimneys Farm,

Funtastic came into the race with a 3-for-8 record. In his only prior stakes start, he finished second by a neck in the \$150,000 Gio Ponti Stakes at Aqueduct last November.

Brown said that Goncalo Torrealba, the chairman of Three Chimneys Farm, had great confidence in Funtastic.

"Mr. Torrealba really deserves most of the credit here," Brown said. "He was sure this horse could stay a distance of ground, a mile and three-eighths, a mile and a half.

"We were thinking about running him in the Manhattan, and I said, 'Let me run him in one of those long allowance races first, and if it's good, maybe the U.N. is a race for this horse.'"

Funtastic led throughout to win a 1 1/2-mile turf optional-claiming race under Joel Rosario at Belmont Park a month ago.

"I knew this was a tough race for him," Brown said. "But Rosario came back after the allowance race and said he had a lot left.

He was not bottomed out by any means.”

Brown said he would consult with Torrealba and his racing manager Doug Cauthen, but that “it wouldn’t be out of line to look at the Arlington Million or the Sword Dancer next.”

The favored Long On Value caught Lady Alexandra in the final strides to take the Grade 1, \$251,000 Highlander Stakes on June 30 at Woodbine, giving trainer Brad Cox his second straight win in the six-furlong turf sprint.

Long On Value raced in sixth through the turn under Florent Geroux, as long-shots Corinthia Knight and Axtell dueled through quick fractions.

Lady Alexandra opened up a clear lead in the stretch, as Long On Value sought room between rivals towards the outside. After finding a clear path, Long On Value kicked in strongly in the final furlong to prevail by a neck in 1:07.13.

Holding Gold rallied from a trailing ninth for third, and Abbaa checked in fourth. Belvoir Bay, Imprimis, Axtell, Ikerin Road, and Corinthia Knight completed the order of finish.

“It was a great trip,” Geroux said. “I was able to save ground on the turn, and when he was ready to make his run, I just tipped him out and he was able to run the filly down. Six furlongs is right up his alley. I think he ran great. A turf course like Woodbine has a very long stretch. I think it suits him even better.”

Long On Value (\$6.70 to win), a 7-year-old by Value Plus, races for Madaket Stables,

Ten Strike Racing, and Steve Laymon.

The Highlander is a Breeders’ Cup Win and You’re In event for the Breeders’ Cup Turf Sprint, but Long On Value is not BC eligible and would have to be supplemented.

Cox won last year’s Highlander with Green Mask, who started only one more time before being retired due to injury.

The betting public regarded the Mother Goose Stakes as a one-horse race rather than a two-horse race, and the money hit the mark as 2-5 favorite Midnight Bisou strolled to an easy win over second choice Road to Victory on June 30 at Belmont.

The Grade 2, \$250,000 Mother Goose went with only four runners after Mo Smart, Gio Game, and Coach Rocks were scratched, and on paper it looked like a two-horse race between Midnight Bisou and Road to Victory. Midnight Bisou, winner of the Grade 1 Santa Anita Oaks and third in the Kentucky Oaks, was the more accomplished filly, but Road to Victory had won all three of her starts and handed divisional leader Monomoy Girl her only loss in eight starts when she wore her down in the Golden Rod Stakes last fall.

And indeed, the Mother Goose did turn into a showdown between Midnight Bisou and Road to Victory – for about a half-furlong.

Midnight Bisou broke on top under Mike Smith before Road to Victory and Manny Franco came around her to take the lead while setting splits of 23.79 and 46.87 in the 1 1/16-mile race. Midnight Bisou had raced from well off the pace in her last two starts but she was handy for Smith this time, cruising along while always keeping the pacesetter in sight.

Midnight Bisou rolled up toward the lead past the three-furlong pole on the turn and Road to Victory braced for the challenge, digging in and fighting back, but before the three-sixteenths pole it was over. Midnight Bisou glided away from Road to Victory, crossing the line six lengths in front as Road to Victory had work to get second by 1 1/4 lengths over My Miss Lilly. Indy

Union was last of the quartet.

Off a six-furlong fraction of 1:10.87 and a mile in 1:34.66, Midnight Bisou was timed in 1:41.02 for 1 1/16 miles over a fast track. She paid \$2.90 to win.

“Today she got to show who she was,” said Smith, who has ridden Midnight Bisou in her last four starts. “She’s just getting better this filly. She’s going to keep getting better through the year, too.”

Midnight Bisou is owned by Bloom Racing Stable, Madaket Stables, and Allen Racing. Madaket purchased a minority share in the filly earlier this week. Midnight Bisou was making her first start for trainer Steve Asmussen, into whose barn she was transferred following the Kentucky Oaks. Midnight Bisou had been trained by California-based Bill Spawr but with her connections desirous of an East Coast summer campaign the decision was made to switch trainers.

Midnight Bisou would be a logical participant in the major 3-year-old filly races at Saratoga, the Coaching Club American Oaks and the Alabama. Midnight Bisou, bred by Woodford Thoroughbreds in Kentucky, is by Midnight Lute and out of the Real Quiet mare, Diva Delight, a three-time stakes winner.

Stormy Embrace ran the race of her life on June 30 at Gulfstream Park to dominate the seven-furlong, \$250,000 Princess Rooney by 6 3/4 lengths over fellow long-shot Rich Mommy. My Miss Tapit and Curlin’s Approval finished third and fourth as the 8-5 co-favorites in the Grade 2 fixture.

The victory by Stormy Embrace earned her an expenses-paid berth in the Breeders’ Cup Filly & Mare Sprint at Churchill.

With Wilmer Garcia in from Monmouth for the ride, Stormy Embrace broke alertly to hold a narrow advantage over Ms Locust Point after modest splits of 22.79 and 45.25 seconds for the opening half-mile. She disposed of her early competition to open a comfortable lead into the stretch before increasing her advantage to the wire.

Rich Mommy rallied mildly to easily best the others, finishing 2 1/4 lengths in front of a tiring My Miss Tapit. Curlin’s Approval steadied in traffic approaching the far turn and was never a serious factor.

Stormy Embrace, a 4-year-old home-bred daughter of Circular Quay owned by Matalona Thoroughbreds and trained by Kathleen O’Connell, finished in 1:21.81 and

returned \$33.40 to win.

“She loves the Gulfstream track, and the best thing about her is she’s so versatile,” said O’Connell.

O’Connell said Stormy Embrace was training forwardly for the race, although she never expected the kind of performance her filly produced.

“This was like a super effort,” she said. “As for the Breeders’ Cup, she’s a very, very nice filly, and she deserves it.”

Although trainer Steve Asmussen missed out on watching Midnight Bisou win the Mother Goose Stakes in person on June 30 at Belmont Park, he didn't miss out on stakes-winning celebrations altogether. With assistant Scott Blasi sent to New York to oversee Midnight Bisou, Asmussen remained at Churchill Downs for closing day on June 30 and got a firsthand look at a front-running, two-length victory from Sir Truebadour in the Grade 3, \$100,000 Bashford Manor.

In winning the Bashford Manor, the first graded stakes race for 2-year-olds this year, Sir Truebadour illustrated the ability to throw down fast fractions and last. He lasted in slow time, however.

Weakened from setting fractions of 21.35 seconds and 45.63 in the six-furlong race under Ricardo Santana Jr., Sir Truebadour was a tired horse in the stretch, especially in the final furlong. He covered his final eighth of a mile in 14.33 seconds, stopping the clock in 1:12.77.

"Thank God he held on," said Asmussen.

The win gave him his fifth victory in the Bashford Manor, all since 2004. The spring meet's leading trainer for a record-extending 19th time with 30 wins, he previously won the race with Lunarpal (2004), Kodiak Kowboy (2007), Kantharos (2010), and Cinco Charlie (2014).

The win seemed to hold significance for Asmussen given Sir Truebadour's pedigree. A [More Than Ready](#) colt out of the King of Kings mare Kivi, he is a full brother to Regally Ready, a millionaire whom Asmussen trained to win the Breeders' Cup Turf Sprint in 2011.

"Can't really say enough about what Regally did for us," Asmussen said.

Purchased for \$300,000 at the Fasig-Tipton sale last summer at Saratoga, Sir Truebadour has won two of three starts and \$93,360 for Carrol Castille's Whispering Oaks Farm. He paid \$5 as the public choice.

Longshots lit up the toteboard behind the winner, with Mr Chocolate Chip in second at 103-1, Overanalyzer third at 99-1, and Cat Addition, another Asmussen trainee, running fourth at 16-1.

Dream Awhile returned from an eight-week freshening in sharp form and scored her first graded stakes win in the \$100,000 Eatontown at Monmouth Park on June 30.

The Grade 3 Eatontown was Dream Awhile's first race since she finished third in the Grade 2 Distaff Turf Mile at Churchill Downs on Kentucky Derby Day. She was unhurried early in the 1 1/16-mile turf race for fillies and mares as Gianna's Dream set a leisurely pace on an open lead.

Dream Awhile moved closer on the backstretch, then forged to the front outside Gianna's Dream nearing the stretch. The daughter of War Front opened a clear lead, then held 10-1 Special Event safe by three-quarters of a length under jockey Irad Ortiz Jr.

"I just let her do her thing," Ortiz said. "I had the best horse in the race, so even though they went slow early and tried to back it up, I was able to drop in and get her to relax. She really responded when I asked her."

Elysea's World, who rallied four wide into the stretch, finished willingly to be third, two lengths behind Special Event, who closed well. Dream Awhile and Elysea's World are trained by Chad Brown.

Dream Awhile paid \$3 to win in the five-horse field. She was timed in a good 1:41.59 following tepid fractions of 25.14 seconds, 49.73, and 1:12.62.

"With a horse loose on the lead like that, it was troublesome to me, especially since my filly didn't get away too good from the gate," Brown said. "I thought Irad used good judgment on the backside, knowing there was a slow pace and getting her involved when he did."

The Eatontown was Dream Awhile's second win from five starts since being imported from France. She won the Tropical Park Oaks at Gulfstream Park in December. She is owned by Joe Allen.

After three straight runner-up finishes, Wonder Gadot got back to the winner's circle on June 30 at Woodbine, defeating males to win the 159th running of the Queen's Plate under jockey John Velazquez.

Adding blinkers for the first time in her career, Wonder Gadot was in range early along the outside, as stablemate Telekinesis set the pace in the 1 1/4-mile Tapeta race. Telekinesis was pressured by Chiefswood Stable runners Neepawa and Rose's Vision, through opening fractions of 23.12 seconds for the opening quarter and 46.82 seconds for the opening half-mile.

Wonder Gadot made a four-wide move on the turn, and got to the front with authority, drawing away to win by 4 3/4 lengths in 2:02.26. Aheadbyacentury rallied for second, while Cooler Mike finished third in the field of 16 Canadian-bred 3-year-olds.

Wonder Gadot paid \$6.40 to win.

"She was going well the whole way," said Velazquez, who recorded his first Queen's Plate win. "We broke well, got a good position. By the three-eighths pole there were two horses in front of her and I got to them pretty easily. When I asked her down the lane she responded really well. I was very happy."

Velazquez said he believed adding blinkers played a part in the victory.

"She had been fighting every race and every battle," he said. "She was coming second and third but running her eyeballs out. I think the blinkers got her to pay more attention and do her job."

Trainer Mark Casse won his second Queen's Plate, as did owner Gary Barber. Casse and Barber combined to win the 2014

Queen's Plate with another filly, Lexie Lou.

Wonder Gadot had finished second last out in the Kentucky Oaks at Churchill Downs. Casse described the Queen's Plate victory as special.

"Her Kentucky Oaks, it was disappointing to lose," he said. "She's just been so unlucky, but she is so tough. She reminds me a lot of Lexie Lou, even though she weighs 200 pounds more than Lexie did. Lexie just thrived on running. There's horses that will just run and run and run, and luckily this is one of them."

Luis Contreras felt he could have been closer on Aheadbyacentury without a bit of trouble as he made his move.

"I had a great trip," he said. "My horse broke okay and I saved a bit of ground. At the half-mile, I was ready to make my move and the horse in front of me started to drop back and bothered me a little. I moved outside and let him re-break and he was fine. The winner was very impressive, but it would have been very close if nothing had happened on the backstretch."

Bred by Anderson Farms, Wonder Gadot became the ninth filly since 1956 to win the Queen's Plate.
