On Feb. 18, Justify made his first start. On June 9, he made his sixth. The number of days that encompasses is 111. In other words, won, won, won.

He won the Kentucky Derby. He won the Preakness. And on June 10, before an appreciative crowd at Belmont Park, Justify led every step of the 150th Belmont Stakes, becoming the 13th horse to sweep the Triple Crown, the second this decade,

the second to do so while undefeated, but the first to do so without ever having raced at age 2.

Justify now will have his name on a list that includes Sir Barton, Gallant Fox, Omaha, War Admiral, Whirlaway, Count Fleet, Assault, Citation, Secretariat, Seattle Slew, Affirmed, and **American Pharoah**. After a drought of 37 years between Affirmed in 1978 and American Pharoah in 2015, the Triple Crown has now been won twice just three years apart.

What American Pharoah and Justify have in common is that both are trained by Bob Baffert, who became the second person – following Sunny Jim Fitzsimmons more than 80 years ago – to train two Triple Crown winners.

Baffert months ago had telegraphed the unique talent he believed Justify possessed. On the morning of his first start, at Santa Anita, he said, "I've got big plans for that colt."

Less than four months later, Justify was draped in carnations in the winner's circle at Belmont Park, having won the Triple Crown, a remarkable achievement for a horse who, with his late start, had to play catch-up. But talent trumped experience.

"I wanted to see that horse's name up there," Baffert said. "He's been brilliant from Day 1."

Baffert said he thought Justify could emulate American Pharoah because "he was showing me all the signs."

"He's a superior horse," said Baffert, adding that winning a second Triple Crown "feels pretty good."

Justify was ridden by Mike Smith, a Hall of Fame jockey who won the Triple Crown for the first time and, at age 52, became the oldest jockey to sweep the series.

"He's so gifted. He's sent from heaven," said Smith, a devoutly religious person who always begins his post-race interviews by citing his faith.

"To win six races in this time, he's an

unbelievable horse," Smith said.

Both Baffert and Smith were emotional after the race, Baffert even more so. He said he "had a lot of help from upstairs," a reference not only to his late parents but also to his close friend Brad McKinzie, an executive at Los Alamitos who died last year and whose namesake colt Baffert thought earlier this year might be his best Triple Crown hope.

But after the colt McKinzie went to the sidelines in late March, Justify continued his rapid ascent, winning the Santa Anita Derby in his third start and then all three Triple Crown races.

"He's just a magnificent animal," said Baffert, who called Justify "one of those all-time great horses."

Justify (\$3.60 to win) was favored, as he has been in all his starts.

He exuded confidence before the race, never becoming rattled by the unfamiliar paddock nor the crush of people watching his every move.

There were few instructions from Baffert.

"The gas tank's full. Don't use it all at once," Baffert told Smith.

Justify started from the rail, with nine rivals lined up to his outside. Because of his draw, he was the first loaded into the gate, and Smith was intent on leaving alertly for a race that starts in front of the grandstand and encompasses one lap around Belmont Park's main track.

"The whole time, he was so professional," Smith said. "The crowd was screaming."

Smith said Justify left the gate "like he was going 440 yards at Ruidoso."

"He broke better today than the other two," Smith said, referring to the Derby and Preakness, "which was very important. Then he got into that rhythm of his. I kept a leg on each side and my mind in the middle."

Justify went fast for the opening quarter, 23.37 seconds, but then Smith got him to go in a more sensible manner for the next

half-mile, and they reached six furlongs in 1:13.21.

Baffert's other runner, the longshot Restoring Hope, had been in closest attendance early while being kept wide, with Bravazo also forwardly placed. As the field went around the far turn, Justify inched away from his rivals, and then they came closer. Smith was playing with them, and Justify was a willing partner.

"He listens to you," Smith said.

Justify got the mile in 1:38.09, then threw another 24-second-and-change quarter to enter the quarter pole in 2:02.90. Restoring Hope and Bravazo were done.

Justify entered the lane with a two-length lead, with Vino Rosso closest, but he was beginning to weaken after gaining ground on the far turn. It was the European import Gronkowski who then loomed the biggest threat. Last early, Gronkowski closed sharply on the far turn while saving ground under Jose Ortiz, then switched out in upper stretch to try to run down Justify.

"Man, he dug back in," Smith said.

There was no catching him. Justify maintained a safe margin to the wire and crossed the finish 1 3/4 lengths in front of Gronkowski, who was 1 3/4 lengths in front of third-place Hofburg. Vino Rosso was fourth.

Justify completed the 1 1/2 miles on the fast main track in 2:28.18. His Beyer Speed Figure for the race was 101.

Smith understood the magnitude of the moment. He brought Justify back toward the winner's circle but then took him up the stretch, past the furlong pole – much as Victor Espinoza did with American Pharoah in 2015 – for a curtain call so the fans could show their appreciation.

They knew they had witnessed something special. No horse has ever been on such an accelerated schedule to win the Triple Crown. But Justify – a big, strong colt – had the physical build and mental fortitude to handle it all.

"He's never had a break, like a Quarter Horse running every week, trials and finals," said Baffert, who long ago began his training career with Quarter Horses.

Justify, a colt by the late Scat Daddy, races for a partnership that includes the WinStar Farm of Kenny Troutt, China Horse Club, Starlight Racing, and Head of Plains Partners. It was WinStar president and chief executive Elliott Walden who decided last fall to send Justify to Baffert.

Baffert knew what he had early on and never saw anything to make him change his mind. After his third start, he started calling Justify a "superior horse," a phrase

he had used for American Pharoah and Arrogate – another recent star – farther into their careers.

The morning after the Preakness, Baffert took a reporter into Justify's stall to admire the colt's physical presence and then remarked, "You'll never see another horse like this."

And then the day before the Belmont, Baffert said, "This is the best he's been. If he's great, he'll win the Triple Crown."

"He's just a magnificent animal," Baffert said after the Belmont.

In less than four months, all that has proven to be justified.

Bee Jersey jumped into the deep end of the pool and made quite the splash, holding off multiple graded stakes winner Mind Your Biscuits to take the Grade 1, \$1.2 million Metropolitan Handicap by a nose at balmy Belmont Park on June 9.

Able to make the lead through a relatively soft first quarter under Ricardo Santana Jr., Bee Jersey had just enough to hold and earn his first Grade 1 victory. A son of Jersey Town, owned and bred by Charles Fipke, Bee Jersey won for the fourth time in as many starts this year and fifth in six starts since he was returned last summer to the U.S. from Dubai and transferred to Hall of Fame trainer Steve Asmussen.

"It's a great race to win, great source of pride for the Fipke breeding program and the quality of horses it's churning out, he's another example of that and we're just fortunate to have him," said Asmussen, who won this prestigious race for the first time.

Bee Jersey had won two allowance races and the Grade 3 Steve Sexton Mile entering the Met Mile. But the manner in which he won those three races – by a combined 19 1/4 lengths – made him the favorite in an 11-horse field that had won 30 stakes and earned nearly \$12 million.

Part of the reason for that was the fact that, on paper, Bee Jersey looked like the



lone speed in the race. He got to the front in 23.08 seconds, and maintained a one-length lead through a half-mile in 45.71 and six furlongs in 1:09.28. Bolt d'Oro, One Liner, and Limousine Liberal were among the ones chasing him early, but Bolt d'Oro and One Liner were done by the quarter pole.

Turning for home, it became evident that Mind Your Biscuits, the \$3.1 million-earning New York-bred, was revving up for a stretch run under Joel Rosario.

Mind Your Biscuits kept charging at Bee Jersey through the lane but Bee Jersey held on at the wire by a desperate nose.

Bee Jersey covered the mile in 1:33.13 and returned \$8.50 as the 3-1 favorite.

"My horse is a fighter, he showed it today," Santana said. "He was waiting for the horses, I know [Mind Your Biscuits] was the horse I had to beat. When [Bee Jersey] felt him he took off again and gave the second kick to pass the wire first."

Referencing the close photo, Asmusen said, "I thought he won, but I'm never happy 'til they put the number up."

Mind Your Biscuits, the 122-pound highweight making his first start since winning the Dubai Golden Shaheen at Meydan on March 31, was second by 5 1/4 lengths over Limousine Liberal. Discreet Lover, the longest shot on the board at 79-1, finished fourth. He was vanned off after jockey Manny Franco dismounted galloping him back. Franco said he felt the horse was sore.

Ransom the Moon was fifth, followed by McCracken, Good Samaritan, Awesome Slew, One Liner, Warrior's Club, and the 3-year-old Bolt d'Oro.

The Met Mile was a "Win and You're In" race for the Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile in November at Churchill Downs. Asmussen said that race will be a goal and he will sit down in the near future to map out a plan to get there.

Spring Quality is an older horse with few starts, Edgar Prado is an older jockey with a whole lot of starts, and Graham Motion is a middle-aged trainer with a knack for winning the Manhattan Stakes.

The three formed a winning combination on June 9 at Belmont Park, with Spring Quality up at the wire to capture the \$1 million Manhattan.

A year after 27-1 shot Ascend upset the Manhattan with Motion guiding his path, Spring Quality pulled a 18-1 surprise. Passed by a fast-moving Sadler's Joy on the far turn, Prado left his cozy spot along the inside to follow that live horse into the homestretch. Sadler's Joy pounced on three leaders in the final furlong while four wide, but there came Spring Quality even farther out on the course to win by a neck.

It was an amazingly bunched finish, with a neck or a head separating each of the first nine finishers home, and five lengths covering the entire 13-horse field at the wire. Last home, though not beaten far, was 9-5 favorite Beach Patrol, who tracked the pace but had no stretch punch.

"I was in a good spot, but when I tried to get into position at the three-eighths pole he just wasn't in the bridle," said Beach Patrol's jockey, Joel Rosario.

Second choice Robert Bruce was stuck in traffic much of the trip but lacked the gears to hit his spots and checked in sixth. Behind Sadler's Joy came Hi Happy, who ran a brave race from a tricky spot inside and just behind pacesetter Hello Don Julio. Manitoulin was an admirable fourth, Fashion Business a surprising fifth at 43-1.

Six-year-old Spring Quality raced once in 2014, then not at all until 2016. He didn't make his turf debut until last October, when he started in his first graded stakes, and the Manhattan, his first try in a Grade 1, was just the 10th start of his career.

Prado's 10th start came sometime in 1986, his first year as an American jockey. He has ridden more than 38,600 races and won more than 7,000 of them. Prado, who was born in Peru, is 50 now, plying his trade on the Maryland circuit, his opportunities in major races down to a trickle. But Motion has continued giving Prado chances when most trainers look elsewhere. Prado's most recent Grade 1 wins came on the Motion-trained Miss Temple City.

"Graham has been great," Prado said. "He's one of the guys that has stuck with me. I can't say enough good things about him."

George Strawbridge undoubtedly also has complimentary words. He bred and owns Spring Quality, a son of Quality Road

and the Deputy Minister mare Spring Star whose career, until last year, lacked anything approaching star quality.

But midway through last season Motion began seeing signs from this gelding, a towering chestnut who wouldn't look out of place jumping fences in three-mile races. He won the Grade 3 Red Smith last fall at Aqueduct, and Motion earlier this week said he was surprised Spring Quality had finished second to Robert Bruce on May 5 in the Fort Marcy Stakes here.

That start got Spring Quality a race over the Belmont turf, but he drew very poorly in post 13 for the Manhattan and didn't look like a winner until midway through the homestretch,

"The post wasn't good, but they ran away from him early and I was able to save ground on the first turn and part of the second turn," Prado said.

Prado had two horses behind him as the leaders set even splits of 24.08 seconds, 48.54, and 1:12.01. Going into the far turn, the horse that looked like a winner was Sadler's Joy, who was always into the bridle and responded to a tactical change meant to get him into the race earlier. With Beach Patrol and Robert Bruce spinning their wheels, Sadler's Joy hit the front at about the eighth pole but could not quite close the deal, and as Javier Castellano worked hard to get his mount to the front, the danger came from behind.

Prado said Spring Quality didn't really start rolling until the quarter pole but by midstretch he was flying.

"I knew he was trying hard, but I didn't know if he'd get there," Prado said.

Spring Quality's legs might be six years old, but they are still fresh, still willing, and with a final surge he pushed past Sadler's Joy and on to million-dollar success.

"How about two years in a row winning this race with a longshot? It's pretty crazy," said Motion.

Spring Quality ran 1 1/4 miles in 1:58.58 and paid \$38 to win.

The champ is back.

Abel Tasman, the champion 3-year-old filly of 2017 who disappointed in her 4-year-old debut, made amends in a big way on June 9, cruising to a 7 1/2-length victory in the Grade 1, \$750,000 Ogden Phipps Stakes at Belmont Park.

Ivy Bell finished second, 1 3/4 lengths ahead of stablemate Unbridled Mo. Pacific Wind, Unchained Melody, and Berned completed the order of finish.

Abel Tasman, trained by Bob Baffert for the China Horse Club, won for the seventh time in 13 starts. She increased her earnings to \$2,412,385.

"It's good to see these great mares back," Baffert said. "She was champion; you want to see these champions run well."

Abel Tasman did not run well in the Grade 1 La Troienne at Churchill Downs on May 4. But it turned out that she needed that race more than Baffert had expected and finished fourth.

"I knew she needed that race at Churchill Downs. I was sort of disappointed she didn't run well," Baffert said. "You could tell the light turned on when she got back to California and trained aggressive again. She couldn't have looked any better."

As is her nature, Abel Tasman, ridden by Mike Smith, broke slowly and was fourth out of the gate. Smith put her in the clear, and she dragged him to the lead after an opening quarter in 23.58 seconds.

Abel Tasman cruised through a half-mile in 46.36 and six furlongs in 1:10.05. She put away a quarter-pole challenge from Pacific Wind and galloped home an easy winner.

Abel Tasman, who won the Grade 1 Acorn as a 3-year-old here on Belmont Stakes Day, covered the 1 1/16 miles in 1:40.36 and returned \$4 as the even-money favorite.

"She does that every time — she gets away slow, and then she makes that big middle move," Smith said. "Sometimes it's better to let her do it if they're going slow. If they're going fast and she does it, that's when I've gotten myself in trouble, and that's happened before. But they were going easy enough, so I was okay."

Smith added that he feels Abel Tasman "really loves this surface, she loves Belmont Park. Last year, she was just incredible over this track."

The Phipps is a Win and You're In race

for the Breeders' Cup Distaff at Churchill Downs in November. Baffert said that race is the year-end goal for Abel Tasman. How she gets there remains to be seen, but it wouldn't be surprising to see her back in New York for the Personal Ensign at Saratoga in August and/or the Beldame at Belmont in the fall.

The beat goes on for Monomoy Girl, who continued to run up the score on her march to the 3-year-old filly title by scoring her fourth straight victory, and third straight in a Grade 1, with an easy two-length victory on June 9 in the \$671,000 Acorn Stakes at Belmont Park.

Monomoy Girl (\$3.20) had a gorgeous trip in the one-turn mile under Florent Geroux. She sat third as Moonshine Memories and Talk Veuve to Me dueled for the early lead for the first five furlongs, ranged up outside Talk Veuve to Me when Moonshine Memories began to wilt near the quarter pole, grabbed command in upper stretch, and never was in danger thereafter.

She won by two lengths over Talk Veuve to Me, who won the early battle with Moonshine Memories but could not stave off Monomoy Girl. Gio Game was another 4 1/4 lengths back in third, then came Moonshine Memories, Caledonia Road, and Starcloud in a field that was reduced to six following the morning scratch of Spectator.

Monomoy Girl completed one mile on the fast main track in 1:34.10.

"I think she's a miler. She's bred to be a miler, she has the speed to be a miler," said her trainer, Brad Cox, who said Monomoy Girl had trained sharply since her victory five weeks ago in the Kentucky Oaks.

"What we saw today was what she had been showing me the last three weeks," Cox said. "She's a really nice filly. She lets you know when she's ready to run."

Cox said Geroux rode a perfect race.

"Good spot, pushed the button at the right time," Cox said.

The disappointment in the race was the second choice, Caledonia Road. She was last year's champion 2-year-old filly following her victory in the Breeders' Cup Juve-

nile Fillies, but was dull in the Acorn, her second start following a lengthy layoff necessitated by ankle surgery.

Monomoy Girl, a daughter of Tapizar, has won seven times in eight starts. Cox trains her for Michael Dubb, Monomoy Stables, the Elkstone Group, and Bethlehem Stables.

The duo teamed to win the Grade 1, \$700,000 Just a Game Stakes on June 9 at Belmont Park, the mare's second graded stakes victory in as many starts in this country.

"She's a little quirky, as you can see, like behind the gate," Brown said of A Raving Beauty, who forced Ortiz to dismount behind the gate while protesting the load. "And she can be a little headstrong - in both races, [she was]. And Irad used those good hands of his to really settle her down."

Lull, who had been fractious in the paddock and warming up, bounced away quickest from the gate, and was quickly joined by a keen La Coronel on her flank. Meanwhile, Ortiz kept A Raving Beauty, who had broken from the post directly to La Coronel's inside, clear on the outside, and encouraged her to bide her time, about 3 1/2 lengths behind the leading duo, through a half in 46.37 seconds.

"I thought [Ortiz] made a really important decision early, when La Coronel decided to move down the backside, to sort of stay behind her and get [A Raving Beauty] just to relax and maybe drop the bit a little bit," Brown said. "She responded and really switched off nicely."

Lull had disposed of La Coronel approaching the quarter pole, but A Raving Beauty was revving up three wide to chal-

lenge. With Lull grimly holding on toward the inside and Proctor's Ledge attempting to rally between horses, A Raving Beauty poked her head in front in deep stretch and edged away to win by three-quarters of a length. The mare finished the mile in 1:32.14 on a course rated firm. She was less than three-fifths off the course mark of 1:31.63 established by Elusive Quality 20 years ago.

Proctor's Ledge edged Lull by half a length for second. Less than a length separated the third- through seventh-place finishers, as Lull edged the favored Off Limits - also trained by Brown - by a neck, followed by On Leave, Dream Dancing, and Cambodia. La Coronel faded to last, another 5 1/2 lengths back.

A Raving Beauty and Ortiz were three-length winners in the Grade 3 Beaugay Stakes on May 12, also on the Belmont course.

The 5-year-old daughter of Mastercraftsman was Group 3-placed in her native Germany and Group 1-placed in Italy for trainers Andreas Wohler and Andreas Suborics.

Trainer Chad Brown always felt Fourstar Crook was capable of winning a major

graded stakes in the distaff turf division. He may not have thought it was going to come at the expense of Sistercharlie.

On June 8, Fourstar Crook, a hard-trying, overachieving 6-year-old New York-bred mare, got a better trip than did her more highly regarded stablemate Sistercharlie and held her off to win the Grade 2, \$600,000 New York Stakes by a head at Belmont Park. It was 1 1/4 lengths to Daddys Lil Darling in third.

"Tale of two trips," Brown said. "Fourstar Crook's a very nice filly and a deserving winner of a race of this caliber. Sistercharlie had a nightmare trip."

Indeed, she did. In a race where there was a run-off pacesetter, Sistercharlie got squeezed at the start and was last, 28 1/2 lengths back, after the opening half-mile. As she tried to make a move into contention under John Velazquez around the three-eighths pole, Sistercharlie got shuffled back to last again. Meanwhile, Fourstar Crook had a relatively unimpeded trip under Irad Ortiz Jr., while just in front of Sistercharlie.

Fourstar Crook, 26 1/2 lengths back after a half, rallied wide in the stretch, and came out a path or two, which forced Velazquez to dive Sistercharlie to the inside of Fourstar Crook and she just ran out of ground.

"I didn't break good enough to get a position where I wanted to be," Velazquez said. "I was supposed to be in front of the horse who won and I was behind her. She made a huge run, it's hard to come from where she was and make up all that ground."

Fourstar Crook had finished second to Sistercharlie in the Grade 1 Jenny Wiley at 1 1/16 miles at Keeneland.

Fourstar Crook, owned by Michael Dubb, Michael Caruso, and Gary Aisquith, covered the 1 1/4 miles in 1:59.21 and returned \$10.80 as the second choice.

A couple of centuries and change ago, most of New York cheered when the British monarchy was booted back across the Atlantic. It was a different story June 8 at Belmont Park when Call To Mind, carrying the purple and scarlet silks of Elizabeth II, queen of England, rushed under the finish line a one-length winner of the Grade 2, \$400,000 Belmont Gold Cup.

Either a bunch of the railbirds yelling on the apron were closet royalists, or they had been part of the betting brigade that made Call To Mind the 9-5 favorite. He paid \$5.60 to win, defeating one other English horse, a steed from France, and five Americans

Wearing Her Majesty's silks was a native Venezuelan, Javier Castellano, who placed Call To Mind just behind pace-setting Postulation, attacked the leader with more than three furlongs still remaining, but was aboard a mount who had no trouble seeing out the Gold Cup's two-mile trip.

That was just as trainer William Haggas said earlier this week, calling two miles on fast ground – which Belmont definitely had Friday – the ideal race for this horse.

"He's a Group 2 horse," said the queen's racing manager, John Warren. "There aren't always Group 2's at home. In the program, it was the perfect race."

Call To Mind hadn't actually raced two miles until the Belmont Gold Cup, but last fall he'd been second to a good horse named Ice Breeze going 1 7/8 miles, and his solid third at York last out in the 1 3/4-mile Yorkshire Cup, won by another good stayer called Stradivarius, had convinced Haggas his colt would get the trip.

Call To Mind is by Galileo out of Memory, by Danehill Dancer, and he has won three times from nine starts. Four is a young age for a horse to be staying this far, and Call To Mind, while a Grade 2 type now, might eventually make his way to the highest level.

He was plenty good enough for the Gold Cup. Postulation, whose eventual fade to last was far, far below his best form, made an easy lead under Florent Geroux, pulled perhaps slightly too strongly through the early portions, went a mile in 1:40.49, and folded up like a cheap suit when Call To Mind jumped on him into the final turn. Three closers – Canessar, who would wind up second by a neck, Prince of Arran, who got third by three-quarters of a length over Rocketry – all tried to run at the winner but Call To Mind was of no mind to waver.

Winning time over firm turf was 3:16.78. That was a course record, which doesn't mean a whole lot given the few races run at the distance.

Bob Baffert calls Hoppertunity the "forgotten horse," but the 7-year-old veteran still hasn't forgotten how to win the big ones, as he did once again June 9 at Belmont Park when rallying to a 2 1/4-length victory over the 9-5 favorite War Story in the Brooklyn Invitational.

The Grade 2 Brooklyn was the ninth win in 32 career starts for Hoppertunity, a multiple Grade 1 winner of nearly \$4.7

million, who is now perfect in two starts at 1 1/2 miles and in two starts at Belmont Park. Hoppertunity won the Grade 1 Jockey Club Gold Cup at 1 1/4 miles here in 2016.

With regular rider Flavien Prat aboard, Hoppertunity settled about six lengths off a modest early pace while saving ground for more than a mile. Hoppertunity advanced to closer contention approaching the stretch, then angled out behind the drifting Hard Study while continuing his bid near midstretch before wearing down War Story to win going away.

War Story was well-placed in close attendance of the lead, gained control on the second turn, angled down to the rail while continuing on willingly through the long stretch, but was no match for the winner. It was another three parts of a length farther back to Hard Study, who ducked out while bidding for command nearing midstretch then faltered late.

Hoppertunity, a son of Any Given Saturday, won the 1 1/2-mile Grade 3 Tokyo City at Santa Anita to launch his 2018 campaign on April 8. He was never a serious factor when cutting back to 1 1/16 miles and ultimately finishing fourth over a sloppy track at Churchill Downs last month in the Grade 2 Alysheba.

Owned by the partnership of Karl Watson, Mike Pegram, and Paul Weitman, Hoppertunity paid \$9.10 to win.

"I just ran him at Churchill Downs to get him ready for this race," said Baffert. "He's been a real favorite in the barn forever. He's 7 years old, but he's very healthy and doing well. We take our time with him, manage him the right way, and if he gets a little off kilter, we back off him. He's like a forgotten horse even though he's earned millions. The stallion farms aren't knocking at the door wanting to buy him. We're just having fun with him, and it's good to win a big one with him on a big day like this."

Baffert said he could bring Hoppertunity back to Belmont for the Grade 1 Suburban at 1 1/4 miles on July 6.

Disco Partner's favorite dance is The Jaipur.

His flying finish fell a neck and one horse short of victory in 2016, but for the second year in a row Disco Partner's people got a taste of Saturday afternoon fever when Disco Partner won the Grade 2 Jaipur Invitational on the Belmont Stakes undercard.

Disco Partner and jockey Irad Ortiz Jr. rallied up the rail for a half-length win in 2017, but this year they came over the top, tagging Conquest Tsunami in the final half-furlong and going on to a one-length victory.

Disco Partner has become almost impossible to top in contests over the Belmont dance floor: He has won four in a row on the Belmont turf and for his career has eight wins and two seconds from 12 local starts.

Disco Partner might be a 6-year-old, but barring bad luck this was far from his last dance. Disco Partner excels in six-furlong races such as the Jaipur, but trainer Christophe Clement, who also was thrilled with pace-setter Pure Sensation's third-place finish, believes the horse is quick enough for the 5 1/2-furlong Breeders' Cup Turf Sprint at Churchill this year. That race already is circled on the calendar with the interim schedule yet to be determined.

The Jaipur is North America's richest turf sprint outside the Breeders' Cup and was an obvious goal for Disco Partner's first half of 2018.

Disco Partner is a hold-up horse in turf sprints, but Clement in prerace talk emphasized that Disco Partner need not drop to the tail of the field.

"The only thing I told Irad was if he breaks well it's kind of foolish to always go all the way back to last," Clement said.

Done, and done. Disco Partner had been eighth early in the 2017 Jaipur but this time he raced from fifth around the far turn as Pure Sensation, making a surprisingly clear early lead on a blazing fast course, went a quarter-mile in 22.16 and a half in 44.03. Conquest Tsunami pressed the pace, got on terms with Pure Sensation as the field kicked through the homestretch, and briefly held a lead.

"I was a little excited for a minute," jockey Victor Espinoza said. "But it seemed like the wire was never going to come."

Something else was coming – Disco Part-

ner. Unleashed after straightening for the finish, Disco Partner cut down three horses in front of him, took aim on the leader and whizzed past to the roar of a crowd that had bet him down to heavy favoritism. Disco Partner ran his final furlong in not much more than 11 seconds and stopped the timer in 1:06.74. He paid \$5.10 to win.

Conquest Tsunami was second by a head over a staying-on Pure Sensation. Holding Gold rallied late and was another head back in fourth, followed home by Pocket Change, Stormy Liberal, Blind Ambition, and Frisky Magician.

Still Having Fun contributed to a big weekend for Mid-Atlantic-based horses at Belmont Park when he ran down Engage in deep stretch to win the Grade 2, \$400,000 Woody Stephens Stakes by 1 1/4 lengths on June 9.

On June 8 at Belmont, Laurel-based horseman Cal Lynch won the \$150,000 Tremont Stakes for 2-year-olds with Our Braintrust, and Luis Carvajal Jr., who has horses at Parx Racing and Monmouth Park, won the Grade 2, \$250,000 True North with Imperial Hint.

Still Having Fun is based at Laurel Park with trainer Tim Keefe, who bought him for \$12,000 at the 2016 Fasig-Tipton Mid-Atlantic fall yearling sale in Timonium, Md., on behalf of Jim Scott's Terp Racing. Gary Barber and Adam Wachtel bought into Still Having Fun after he won his career debut at Laurel last November.

Keefe stretched out Still Having Fun around two turns in the Private Terms and Federico Tesio stakes at Laurel, but when the horse lost those races, he cut Still Having Fun back to seven furlongs in the Chick Lang at Pimlico three weeks ago. Still Having Fun finished second to the brilliant Mitole that day over a sloppy track.

"He ran behind a great horse of Steve Asmussen's, just a lights-out horse," Keefe said. "I felt like a winner running second in that race, so that kind of bought us a ticket to run in here. Gary and Adam are both numbers guys. They said his numbers fit, so let's take a shot."

The Woody Stephens was Keefe's first graded stakes win and the 499th victory of his career.

Promises Fulfilled set a fast pace of 21.46 and 43.68 seconds while being pushed by

5-2 favorite World of Trouble. That pair was still leading after six furlongs in 1:08.43 but had little answer when Engage, who had raced in sixth early, came calling.

It soon became evident that Still Having Fun was moving fastest, and he swept to the lead in the final sixteenth under jockey Joel Rosario.

Still Having Fun paid \$28 to win and completed the course in 1:21.45. He has won 4 for 8 starts, having previously won the seven-furlong Frank Whitely Jr. and the Miracle Wood stakes going a one-turn mile at Laurel.

After a disappointing run over a sloppy main track at Churchill Downs on Kentucky Derby Day, Imperial Hint bounced back with a top effort to win the Grade 2 True North at Belmont on June 8.

Jockey Javier Castellano told trainer Luis Carvajal Jr. in the morning that he would like to ease Imperial Hint off the pace in the True North, and Carvajal agreed. The plan worked to perfection as Imperial Hint settled in fourth position early, and then was taken outside the front-runners nearing the stretch.

Recruiting Ready set the early pace in the 6 1/2-furlong race under Mike Smith while being stalked by Bobby Abu Dhabi and Westwood through an opening quarter in 21.85 seconds. On the far turn, jockey John Velazquez pulled up Westwood, who went lame in his left front leg.

Nearing the stretch after a half-mile in 44.52, Imperial Hint engaged Bobby Abu Dhabi from the outside as Recruiting Ready dropped back. At that point, Whitmore was advancing nicely from the back of the six-horse field while in hand. Always Sunshine, who was carried wide by Westwood on the turn and had to alter course inside of him, also was still in contention.

Imperial Hint began to get the best of Bobby Abu Dhabi in midstretch as Whitmore rallied up on the outside. Imperial Hint held on to win by a neck while both he and Whitmore drifted out late.

The win was reminiscent of Imperial Hint's victory in the Grade 3 Smile Sprint last summer when Castellano took him off the early pace and then went on to win by



4 3/4 lengths.

“Usually I feel the horse is always on the lead, and I think at the sixteenth pole he always has to tough it out,” Castellano said. “I wanted him off the pace today. It was our plan. We sat right off those two horses on the lead and then let him finish.”

Imperial Hint paid \$5.40 to win as the favorite. He was timed in 1:15.02.

It was 1 1/2 lengths back from Whitmore to Bobby Abu Dhabi in third. Always Sunshine finished fourth.

The victory was the third graded win of Imperial Hint’s career and first in a Grade 2. He is now 10 for 16 for Carvajal and owner Raymond Mamone. The victory boosted Imperial Hint’s earnings to \$1,017,655.

Paved, owned by a partnership including Eclipse Thoroughbred Partners and Ciaglia Racing, has won 3 of 6 and earned \$242,640.

Fatale Bere, the 6-5 favorite, finished last of six, with an alibi. Her saddle slipped forward early in the race; she was difficult to control by jockey Alonso Quinonez. It was a throwout race for Fatale Bere, a two-time stakes winner including the Providencia last out.

Lewis Bay joined the millionaires' club with a victory June 8 at Belmont Park in the Grade 3, \$240,000 Bed o' Roses, but the club trainer Chad Brown still wants her to join is that of a Grade 1 winner, and the focal point will return to that for the rest of the year.

Lewis Bay, 5, has raced with the best in her division since her 2-year-old year, and though she's finished in the money in such prestigious races as the Kentucky Oaks and Mother Goose, a Grade 1 win has been elusive. She just missed in the Grade 1 Madison earlier this year at Keeneland, and to move her along toward major goals this summer, the Bed o' Roses served its purpose.

With Irad Ortiz Jr. aboard, Lewis Bay broke sharply and took up a position just outside of Divine Miss Grey after the favorite, American Gal, broke poorly in the

seven-furlong race. Lewis Bay surged to the front coming into the lane and cruised home 5 1/2 lengths best over Highway Star.

Cairenn was 1 1/4 lengths farther back in third, then came Divine Miss Grey and American Gal, who finished last of five as the odds-on favorite. Chalon, Ivy Bell, and Union Strike were scratched.

"She broke bad, and that was it," said Jose Ortiz, who rode American Gal. "She wasn't herself today. Any other time behind horses, she would have gotten rank. After the quarter pole, I knew she wasn't going anywhere."

Lewis Bay (\$8.20) covered seven furlongs on the fast main track in 1:21.11. The win was her sixth in 15 career starts, and she now owns three wins and two seconds in five starts at Belmont Park. She earned \$137,500 to bring her career bankroll to more than \$1.1 million.

In her previous race, Lewis Bay was third in the Grade 1 Humana Distaff at Churchill Downs five weeks ago.

"She came out of the race with a quarter crack in her right front foot," said Brown. "It was a legitimate injury, took a while to get it together."

Brown said farrier Ian McKinlay "did a fabulous job," and that after two recent works at Belmont Park, Lewis Bay was set to go.

This was the fifth race for Lewis Bay since she returned from a layoff of more than a year last December. Brown said she was off that long owing to a series of unfortunate events.

"She had a minor injury, went to the farm, and then had other issues at the farm. Got hurt in the paddock, got sick," Brown said. "It was one thing after another."

She will remain around one turn. Brown said the Grade 2 Honorable Miss at Saratoga likely was next, with the main goal the Grade 1 Ballerina at Saratoga.

Things didn't go as planned after La Sardane was imported to the U.S. from France last summer, but they're starting to click now, and on June 8 at Belmont Park she won the Grade 3, \$200,000 Intercontinental Stakes by a neck.

La Sardane, purchased by Team Valor International about a year ago after she finished second in the Prix de la Grotte, beat subsequent Group 1 French Oaks winner Senga in the Prix Sandringham after the Team Valor purchase. She was sent to California with the Del Mar Oaks as a goal, but cannon-bone bruising took her out of consideration for that race, accord-

ing to Team Valor president Barry Irwin.

La Sardane was sent to a farm for rest last fall but instead of being turned out in a field, Irwin said, she was confined to a much smaller area and took a long time to come around after returning to the track.

"It took so long to get that weight off," Irwin said. "She was as big as a house."

La Sardane got a five-wide trip at Keeneland in April making her North American debut and first start for trainer Neil Drysdale and was no factor in an allowance race, but she had every right to be tired and returned with a sharp Churchill Downs allowance win around two turns.

Turning back to seven furlongs in the Intercontinental, La Sardane, tracking the fastest pace she'd ever encountered with a sweet outside stalking trip under Flavien Prat, had no chance to pull too hard, as she has been inclined to do at times. As the Bob Baffert-trained Faypien set comfortable splits of 22.87 and 45.43 over a firm course, La Sardane raced in fourth around the far turn and into the homestretch. At the quarter pole Prat called on his mount and La Sardane responded, getting on even terms with Faypien at the furlong grounds and pushing past for a narrow victory. Faypien had something left, too, and Prat had to give La Sardane a couple of solid smacks with the crop just before the wire to make certain the filly knew her work wasn't quite done.

Faypien, who was 9-1, finished a nose in front of 20-1 pace-presser Heavenly Score, a sign the race flow favored front-runners. La Sardane, who paid \$10.80 to win, was timed in 1:20.04 as the front-runners really picked up the pace in the stretch.

"She was quite calm going to the gate today," said Drysdale, who during Kentucky Derby week at Churchill won the Edgewood Stakes with the 3-year-old turf filly Toinette. "The last two races have helped her a lot."

Irwin said Drysdale's wife, the bloodstock agent Shawn Dugan, had recommended La Sardane for purchase last year. The filly has a relatively obscure pedigree — she is by the Kingmambo sire Kingsalsa and out of Foresta, by Forestier — and had come out of provincial French tracks for a little-known trainer to show her wares last year.

"She's a physical monster with no pedigree at all — a total freak," Irwin said. "I don't like buying those kind. I used to, but with no pedigree they can be difficult to resell. But she's so incredible looking, I figured what the hell."

La Signare galloped alone on an easy lead in the Grade 3 Wonder Again Stakes at Belmont Park on June 7, but it was only a matter of time when the heavily favored Significant Form was going to confront her.

Brian Lynch, the trainer of La Signare, had a pretty good feeling how his filly would respond.

"I just had a gut feeling she wouldn't be short when it came time to ask her for run," Lynch said. "It was just a matter of whether she was good enough."

La Signare was indeed good enough, turning aside Significant Form both at the top of the stretch and again in midstretch of the inner turf course to win the \$200,000 Wonder Again for 3-year-old fillies by a length. Significant Form, the 4-5 favorite, held second by a neck over stablemate Mighty Scarlett, who was third by a neck over Daddy Is a Legend.

Altea finished fifth and was followed by Andina Del Sur, Camila Princess, Armoricaine, and Spinning Top. Animosity scratched.

The win was the second in four career starts for La Signare, a French-bred daughter of Siyouni owned by Sol Kumin's Madaket Stables, Tim and Anna Cambron, and Bradley Thoroughbreds. She was coming off a narrow loss to Toinette in a Keeneland allowance. Toinette came out of that race to win the Grade 3 Edgewood Stakes at Churchill Downs.

La Signare came from off the pace that day. With nearly two months between races, La Signare was fresh and wanted to be forward in the Wonder Again.

Under Joel Rosario, La Signare got away with a posted first quarter of 26.36 seconds, a half-mile in 50.95 and six furlongs in 1:14.54 with Significant Form chasing in second.

"I'm a big believer pace makes the race, and if there's no pace in the race, leave her where she's comfortable," Lynch said. "Evidently, that's where she was comfortable."

Significant Form, under Irad Ortiz Jr., made a run at La Signare at the quarter pole, but La Signare repelled that one. Significant Form tried her again at the eighth pole, but La Signare kicked away to win by a length.

La Signare covered the 1 1/8 miles in 1:48.84 and returned \$14.60 to win.

The top three finishers from the Wonder Again get automatic invites to the Grade 1, \$1 million Belmont Oaks Invitational on



July 7. Lynch said that is one reason why he ran La Signare in this race instead of an entry-level allowance.

“The only way we could get there was to go into this race and try to get an invitation,” Lynch said.

Handicap over the Churchill Downs turf.

Rallying from well off the pace under Corey Lanerie, Lovely Bernadette reeled in Celestial Insight in the final yards to win the 1 1/16-mile turf race as the 119-pound highweight in a field of 10 fillies and mares. The winner paid \$7.60 as the second choice after finishing in 1:42.36 over a firm course.

"I was pretty far back early," Lanerie said. "At the three-eighths pole, I didn't know if we'd get there, but the filly really picked it up for me when it counted."

Lovely Bernadette was up by a neck over Celestial Insight, a 7-1 shot who was 1 1/2 lengths before Inchargeofme. Sully's Dream, who set most of the pace, was another half-length back in fourth, while Res Ipsa, the 2-1 favorite, could do no better than fifth.

Lovely Bernadette is unbeaten in three starts over the Churchill turf, having won not only her grass debut last June in an allowance but also the Grade 2 Mrs. Revere in November in her final start at 3. The 4-year-old Kentucky-bred daughter of Wilburn is owned by James M. Miller.

The Mint Julep was the 16th start for Lovely Bernadette but the first in the care of trainer Bernie Flint.

"We got her right after her last start," said Flint, referring to an 11th-place finish in the Grade 1 Jenny Wiley on April 14 at Keeneland. "I liked her a lot in this spot; she'd been training so well."

Draft Pick, a slow-developing Candy Ride colt up in class following a maiden win in the sixth start of his career, upset the Grade 3 Affirmed Stakes for Eurton and owner Lee Searing on June 10 at Santa

Anita, while favorite Solomini struggled home third at 3-10.

Eurton has a bevy of 3-year-olds poised for summer. "The track has got to be a little slow, but 49 didn't hurt," Eurton said, referring to the 49.13 opening half, in which Draft Pick was three wide in third, just off the leaders. He rallied to the lead into the lane, and opened up late.

Searing, whose horse races under the name CRK Stable, credited Eurton. "He really took his time with him," Searing said, adding about Draft Pick: "He's a fighter; he wants to take you on."

Axelrod, the longest shot in the field, pressed the slow pace and finished second. Solomini, heavily favored off graded stakes-placed form this year and 10th in the Kentucky Derby, sputtered.

Solomini trailed the slow pace, uncorked a wide move on the far turn and into the lane, then raced greenly, lugged in and weakened.

He finished three-quarters of a length behind the runner-up. Afleet Ascent and King Cause finished fourth and fifth. The sprinter Run Away saved ground in fourth and backed up. He finished last of seven.
