The sequel rarely is as good as the original, but in the case of the rematch between Catholic Boy and Analyze It, the Belmont Derby was every bit as entertaining as the Pennine Ridge Stakes.

Particularly if you were in the camp of Catholic Boy.

For the second time in five weeks, Catholic Boy was passed in the stretch by Analyze It, only to come back and beat him. On July 7, in the Grade 1, \$1.2 million

Belmont Derby at Belmont Park, the margin was a head. Five weeks ago, in the Grade 3 Pennine Ridge, the margin was a neck.

The result left both Jonathan Thomas, trainer of Catholic Boy, and Chad Brown, trainer of Analyze It, in shock.

"I didn't expect him to fight back this time," said Thomas, who won his first Grade 1 as a trainer. "I thought we were going to finish a really good second. Somehow, he got it done."

Brown thought Analyze It, under Jose Ortiz, got a great trip, stalking Catholic Boy and Javier Castellano from second before making the lead in midstretch.

"The horse that won earned it," Brown said. "He came back and beat him. I don't have any excuse."

Brown said he believes Analyze It idles a bit when he makes the lead but he didn't want to take away from Catholic Boy "because at least he fought back when most

horses wouldn't," Brown said. "I thought the winner ran great. So did our horse. He just wasn't good enough."

The victory was the first Grade 1 for Catholic Boy, who won for the fourth time in five tries on turf. He also won the Grade 2 Remsen on dirt last fall.

Catholic Boy tried to qualify for the Kentucky Derby but was taken off the trail when he bled while finishing fourth in the Florida Derby.

In the Pennine Ridge, Catholic Boy showed more early foot than he did previously, but battled back on the outside after Analyze It opened a length on him.

In the Belmont Derby, Catholic Boy took the lead because "nobody wanted to take the lead, so I took it," said Castellano. Catholic Boy led by 1 1/2 lengths after six furlongs in 1:13.38 and a mile in 1:36.75.

Analyze It made his move, but Catholic Boy battled back along the inside and won the bob.

"Analyze It has light feet," Castellano

said. "He's more quick, and my horse he takes a little while to come back. But he's such a brave steady horse. He finished really well"

Ortiz said when Analyze It went by Catholic Boy, he thought he was going to win.

"When I passed him today, I thought I was going to open up on him," Ortiz said. "But he came back again. It takes a good horse to do that. I made sure he stayed on the inside and didn't go to the outside, but he kept fighting."

Catholic Boy, a son of [More Than Ready](#) owned by Robert LaPenta, Madaket Stables, Siena Farm, and Twin Creeks Racing, covered the 1 1/4 miles in 1:59.28 and returned \$12.20 to win as the co third-choice.

Analyze It, the 2-1 favorite, finished second by 1 3/4 lengths over Hunting Horn, who was followed, in order, by Channel Cat, Kingstar, Maraud, Hawkish, My Boy Jack, and Encumbered.

Running back just six days after her last race and having to travel to a different continent had no impact on Athena, who rallied from third-last to win the Grade 1, \$1 million Belmont Oaks at Belmont Park on July 7.

Content to race about six to seven lengths

off the lead for about a mile of the 1 1/4-mile race, Ryan Moore tipped Athena five to six paths wide turning for home, and she motored past the field to win the Oaks by 2 1/2 lengths.

The consistent Thewayiam rallied along the rail to get second by a neck over the European-based Chipolata, who nosed out 3-1 favorite Significant Form for third.

Mighty Scarlett was fifth, followed by Fatale Bere, Capla Temptress, Paved, Toinette, and La Signare.

Athena, an Irish-bred daughter of Camelot owned by Coolmore and trained by Aidan O'Brien, won for just the second time in 11 career starts. On June 21, she ran fourth in the Group 2 Ribblesdale at Royal Ascot, and on June 30, she finished third in the Group 1 Pretty Polly Stakes at The Curragh in Ireland.

"I don't think it was a surprise really because she traveled here well and [jockey Donnacha O'Brien] wasn't hard on her last week when she ran at The Curragh," said T.J. Comerford, assistant to Aidan O'Brien. "She didn't get knocked about. It's six days later, but a mile and a quarter on hard ground is probably her trip, and she probably can go farther as well."

La Signare, under Joel Rosario, set the pace until midstretch, where Thewayiam and Significant Form made first run at her. But it was Athena, rallying in the 6 path, who took the lead at the midstretch marker and drew away impressively.

Athena covered the 1 1/4 miles in 1:58.71 and paid \$22.80 to win.

Moore, who was riding at Belmont Park for the first time, said his filly won comfortably.

"She jumped well, but I didn't want to push her into a spot to make her uncomfortable," Moore said. "She found very good rhythm, and she always felt like she would pick up very smoothly and very comfortably. She put them away very easily."

Athena will return to Ireland.

Trainer Rick Violette instructed jockey Irad Ortiz Jr. prior to the \$700,000 Suburban at Belmont Park on July 7 to be aggressive with Diversify right from the start. The meet's leading rider followed the plan to perfection, guiding Diversify to a wire-to-wire, eye-catching, 6 1/2-length victory over 34-1 outsider The Lieutenant in the Grade 2, 1 1/4-mile fixture for older horses.

Diversify, the lone New York-bred in the field, was hustled along from his outside post by Ortiz to wrest control after the opening furlong. Pressed early on by both War Story and the 53-1 Zanotti, Diversify set a rapid pace, posting a 46.18-second opening half-mile split. He ultimately disposed of Zanotti nearing the three-eighths pole, settled into the stretch with a commanding advantage, and was never seriously threatened thereafter.

The Lieutenant rallied near the inside to be second-best, two lengths in front of Discreet Lover. Hoppertunity and Tapwrit, the 3-1 co-choices, finished a disappointing fourth and fifth, respectively, while never menacing the winner at any point.

Diversify, winner of the Grade 1 Jockey Club Gold Cup here last fall, paid \$14 to win after covering the distance in 1:59.84.

"When I saw 46 for the half-mile, I thought I'd be ill," said Violette, who trains Diversify for owners Ralph and Lauren Evans. "I told Irad to be aggressive. We really thought Dr. Dorr would be the horse to press us. When Irad realized it was Zanotti and War Story, he just kind of stepped on the gas and [Diversify] took off and did it pretty comfortably."

Violette said he believed the Suburban was even a better effort for Diversify than his Grade 1 win in the Gold Cup.

"This was his best race yet," Violette said. "He had everything his own way in the Gold Cup. He took pressure and had much better horses behind him today."

Limousine Liberal finally proved he could win a race outside his native Kentucky while in the process earning himself an automatic berth in the Breeders' Cup Sprint, which will be run this year in Kentucky at Churchill Downs, after wearing down Whitmore in the final strides to post a neck victory in the \$350,000 Belmont

Sprint Championship on July 7.

Limousine Liberal had registered all eight previous victories at Churchill Downs, Ellis Park, or over his home base at Keeneland. His best efforts outside of Kentucky prior to the Belmont Sprint included a third-place finish here at Belmont Park in the Grade 1 Metropolitan Handicap, a third-place effort last summer at Saratoga in the Grade 1 Vanderbilt, and a second behind Runhappy as a 3-year-old in the Grade 1 King's Bishop.

Limousine Liberal raced within easy striking distance from the outset of the seven-furlong Belmont Sprint, several lengths off a swift early pace set by Shaft of Light. Limousine Liberal was knocked about between horses after Whitmore bulled his way inside the leaders at the top of the stretch but was able to recover in time to ultimately wear that rival down at the end under strong handling from jockey Jose Ortiz.

Whitmore saved ground while close up down the backstretch then forced his way up inside the leaders, knocking Shaft of Light off stride and setting off a chain reaction at the top of the stretch. He eventually eased out to overtake Eye Luv Lulu near midstretch but could not withstand the winner at the end.

Eye Luv Lulu opened a clear lead after avoiding all the trouble in early stretch, but faltered late, finishing third, another 1 3/4 lengths behind Whitmore. Lewisfield, Favorable Outcome, and Shaft of Light, who got knocked severely off stride by Whitmore at the head of the lane.

After a claim of foul by the rider of Shaft of Light and a steward's inquiry, the original result was allowed to stand.

Limousine Liberal completed the distance in 1:21.53 over a fast track and paid \$5.70 to win.

Marley's Freedom won the most prestigious race of her career in the Grade 2 Great Lady M. Stakes for female sprinters at Los Alamitos on July 7, showing jockey Drayden Van Dyke the sort of performance he has come to expect from the rapidly improving 4-year-old.

Marley's Freedom (\$2.40) closed from last in the field of five to win the \$200,000 Great Lady M. by 1 1/2 lengths over 5-2 Skye Diamonds. The margin was somewhat deceptive. Marley's Freedom was in control of the race through the final furlong, finishing 6 1/2 furlongs in 1:15.

"She's really cool," Van Dyke said. "She has a turn of foot for a big filly like she is. She does what you want her to do."

Marley's Freedom, the winner of the Grade 3 Desert Stormer Stakes at Santa Anita under Van Dyke on May 27, was a standout in the Great Lady M. She trailed pacesetter Phantom Proto by two lengths through an opening quarter-mile in 22.09 seconds and by 1 1/2 lengths through a half-mile in 45.42. With a wide rally, Marley's Freedom was in front with more than a furlong remaining.

Skye Diamonds, who won the 2017 Great Lady M. Stakes, finished three lengths clear of 12-1 Phantom Proton, who was followed by Best of Me and Turkish Tabby.

The Great Lady M. Stakes was the best result for Skye Diamonds in four starts this year. She was sixth in the Grade 1 Humana Distaff at Churchill Downs on May 5 on a wet-fast track and third earlier this year in two stakes at Santa Anita.

Marley's Freedom, trained by Bob Baffert, has won 5 of 11 starts and earned \$353,435. The Desert Stormer and Great Lady M. Stakes are her only stakes wins.

Owners Ron and Barbara Perry said in the winner's circle that Marley's Freedom will be considered for the Grade 1 Ballerina Stakes, a \$500,000 race for fillies and mares at seven furlongs at Saratoga on Aug. 25. The Perrys race as Cicero Farms.

Even as Firenze Fire chased owner Ron Lombardi's dream of getting a horse into the Kentucky Derby, trainer Jason Servis always knew this colt's forte was in races run around one turn.

On July 7, Firenze Fire again backed up that belief with a dominant nine-length victory in the Grade 3, \$350,000 Dwyer Stakes, a one-turn-mile race at Belmont Park.

"We've been waiting to do this," Servis said from Parx in Pennsylvania. "We had Derby fever, got it out of our system. It was

a blast, but this is what he wants to do.”

At age 2, Firenze Fire won three times around one turn, including the Grade 1 Champagne at Belmont last fall, when he defeated Good Magic, who would go on to win the Breeders’ Cup Juvenile and be crowned 2-year-old male champion.

Firenze Fire won the Withers, a one-turn mile at Aqueduct in January, before finishing fourth in the Grade 3 Gotham, a one-turn race at Aqueduct in March, during a busy winter when he was trying to accumulate points to qualify for the Derby.

Firenze Fire finished 11th, 23 1/2 lengths behind Justify, in the Kentucky Derby before getting a freshening.

Firenze Fire came back with a visually impressive and fast race. Under Irad Ortiz Jr., Firenze Fire sat fifth, about 3 1/2 lengths behind Noble Indy and Mendelssohn, who were heads apart after a half-mile in 45.98 seconds.

Mendelssohn, under Ryan Moore, took the lead at the five-sixteenths pole, but Ortiz had Firenze Fire rallying four wide.

Firenze Fire took command at the three-sixteenths pole and roared home in a final quarter of 23.93 seconds to win in 1:33.74.

Seven Trumpets rallied to get second by a half-length over Mendelssohn. He was followed by Rugbyman, Seahenge, Fixed-income Larry, and Noble Indy.

Firenze Fire, a son of Poseidon’s Warrior who won for the fifth time in 11 starts, was the 5-2 second choice.

Mendelssohn was sent off the 3-2 favorite based on a reputation built mostly off an 18 1/2-length win in the United Arab Emirates Derby in March. He was making his first start since finishing last in the Kentucky Derby.

Though he broke well and was involved early, Mendelssohn was no match for Firenze Fire. Moore said he thought the horse got tired but had a useful race.

“He ran a nice race for his first run in two months,” Moore said. “I expect him to come forward from this race today.”

This year’s upper echelon of 3-year-old fillies got a little more crowded July 7 when Red Ruby validated her victory in the Grade 2 Black-Eyed Susan with a powerful 13-length victory in the Grade 3, \$300,000 Delaware Oaks. The victory was Red Ruby’s fourth in her last five starts and earned her a chance to take on the elite of the division in her next start.

Monomy Girl, who has won three consecutive Grade 1’s, is the pro tem leader of a highly talented division. The upper tier also includes impressive Mother Goose winner Midnight Bisou. Queen’s Plate winner Wonder Gadot and Road to Victory, runner-up to Monomy Gal in the Acorn, also deserve to be in the conversation, as does Red Ruby.

Trained by Kellyn Gorder and owned by her breeders, Sandra Sexton and Brandi Nicholson, Red Ruby is now 4 for 6 and has scored open-length wins in three of her four starts this year. In addition to the Delaware Oaks and 4 3/4-length Black-Eyed Susan victory, she won the Martha Washington at Oaklawn Park by 2 1/2 lengths.

Gorder plans to point Red Ruby for the Grade 1, \$600,000 Alabama, which will be run at 1 1/4 miles at Saratoga on Aug. 18.

“The Alabama has been our target, and the farther she goes the better,” Gorder said.

Red Ruby broke running from the outside stall in the eight-horse Delaware Oaks and raced wide on the clubhouse turn while taking up a stalking position behind front-running 70-1 longshot Prospective Lady.

Paco Lopez sat still on Red Ruby until the far turn and then sent her to the lead. She

quickly took control of the race and opened up, coming wide into the stretch, and then extending her lead while drifting out to the center of the track.

Coach Rocks, who kept Red Ruby in her sights early, finished well but was no match for the winner and had to settle for second, eight lengths clear of Mo Shopping in third. Red Ruby paid \$3.20 to win.

The final time of the race was 1:42.41, following splits of 23.61 seconds, 47.26, and 1:11.02. Red Ruby covered her final sixteenth, while not being asked hard by Lopez in 5.93 seconds after a mile in 1:36.48.

Remembering Rita came into the 2018 Prairie Meadows meet a 4-year-old maiden, but on July 6 he came away with a win in the track's biggest race, the Grade 3, \$300,000 Prairie Meadows Cornhusker.

Trainer Doug Anderson, training the second graded stakes winner of a career that began in 1991, fitted Remembering Rita with a set of blinkers for the first time May 25, and making his Prairie Meadows debut Remembering Rita finally won a race, romping by more than 11 lengths. When Remembering Rita came back June 13 to capture a first-level allowance by a similar margin, Anderson and owner Jeral Keith Adams started dreaming.

"We thought what the heck, we got to take a shot at \$300,000 on our home track," Anderson said.

Shot fired, target hit – with help from the Cornhusker race flow.

Krewe Chief stumbled so hard just after the start that he unseated jockey Chris Landeros, and none of the other seven horses left in the race seemed interested in doing much more than galloping. Dalmore went to the front and after a slow opening quarter in 24.24 seconds he crawled down the backstretch, going a half-mile in 48.98.

Perched just to his outside were Remembering Rita and jockey Alex Birzer. Birzer might have wondered if he'd be able to

overtake Dalmore, but if he had a sense of the fractions he couldn't have been afraid of anything coming from behind.

Six furlongs went in 1:12.65 as the horses finally started actually racing past the three-furlong marker. Turning for home, Kent Desormeaux on Dalmore floated Birzer and Remembering Rita way out into the center of the track. Dalmore, in from California, was the more experienced and accomplished horse, but this was Remembering Rita's race. He pushed past Dalmore in the final half-furlong and was drawing away very late to score by 1 1/2 lengths, lighting the tote board at a mutuel of \$41.60 to win.

"The race just set up perfect for us," Birzer said. "All I did was guide him around there."

Remembering Rita got his last eighth-mile in 12.11 and was timed in 1:49.36 for 1 1/8 miles on a fast track. Dalmore held on for second by three-quarters of a length over favored McCraken, who had virtually no chance to catch the winner after racing about six lengths off the pace down the backstretch.

Remembering Rita is a 4-year-old colt by Spring at Last out of Deep South by Unbridled Song, and his record is now 11-3-1-4. Anderson claimed the horse Nov. 5, 2016, at Churchill Downs, paying \$50,000 for a third-time-starting maiden who promptly required a layoff and didn't start again for a year. It took a good long while, but Remembering Rita eventually gave his trainer a night he won't forget.

Trainer Lynn Ashby, who trains both Thoroughbreds and Arabians at the Middletown Training Center in Delaware, sent out Tricky Escape to win the Grade 3, \$200,000 Robert G. Dick Memorial at Delaware Park on July 7. The win was the third graded score for 5-year-old Tricky Escape.

Tricky Escape benefited from a heads-up ride by Chris DeCarlo, who worked his way to the rail from post 7 during the first seven furlongs of the Dick Memorial, a 1 3/8-mile turf race for fillies and mares. DeCarlo split horses in upper stretch and Tricky Escape quickly drew off to win by 1 1/2 lengths.

DeCarlo has been aboard for all of Tricky Escape's stakes wins. She won the Grade 3 Violet at Monmouth Park last August and then concluded her 4-year-old season with a victory in the Grade 3 Cardinal at Churchill Downs. In 2017, Tricky Escape finished fourth, beaten 1 1/2 lengths, in the Dick Memorial.

Broken Bridle set the early pace on an open lead. Following a 23.89-second opening quarter, she was able to slow the tempo down through a 49.04 half-mile and six furlongs in 1:14.23.

Turning for home, Esquisse bid inside Broken Bridle, while Palinodie and Creative Thinking stayed to her outside. Tricky Escape broke the race open with a good turn of foot, and pulled away. She paid \$10.40 in the nine-horse field and completed the course in 2:12.82.

Giovanna Blues finished with a late bid outside horses to get up for second, a length ahead of Palinodie. It was another half-length back to Broken Bridle in fourth. Creative Thinking finished a head farther back in fifth. Esquisse finished sixth, a half-length behind Creative Thinking.

Ashby, a breast cancer survivor, trains Tricky Escape for Jon Marshall.

Ashby now has seven wins at the Delaware meet, four with Arabians and three with Thoroughbreds.

Tricky Escape, a daughter of Hat Trick, is 5 for 17 with earnings of \$454,480. Ashby removed blinkers from Tricky Escape's equipment for the Dick Memorial.

Trainer Jason Servis showed off his hot hand when sending out Vision Perfect to a hard-fought victory in the Grade 3, \$200,000 Parx Dash on July 7 at Parx Racing.

Vision Perfect was put to an all-out drive by Frankie Pennington when edging past a stubborn Pool Winner to prevail by a long nose. Pure Sensation, the 9-10 favorite and the two-time defending winner in the Parx Dash, was another 1 3/4 lengths back in third in a field of 10 older horses.

Vision Perfect, a 6-year-old Kentucky-bred horse by Pollard's Vision, paid \$9.20 to win as second choice after finishing in 57.18 seconds over firm ground.

Pool Winner, an 11-1 shot under Edwin Rivera, led most of the trip, with Pennington cleverly pinning Pure Sensation and jockey Kendrick Carmouche on the rail as the field exited the turn. From there, it was a two-horse duel, with Vision Perfect narrowly getting up.

Claimed by the Mr. Amore Stable for \$80,000 in June 2017, Vision Perfect has won six of 29 starts and earned \$612,784. The Parx Dash was his fourth stakes win and his first in a graded event, following the Awad at Belmont Park at 2, the Woodhaven at Aqueduct at 3 – both for his previous trainer, David Donk – and the Silks Run at Gulfstream Park in March. Prior to the Parx Dash, he was sixth as the favorite in the Grade 3 Turf Sprint on the Kentucky Oaks undercard at Churchill Downs.

Servis, who was on hand from his Monmouth Park base, has been winning at an uncanny clip at Monmouth and Belmont, combining for a 35-for-67 record (52 percent) at those two tracks this year going into the Parx Dash.

The eye-catching win by She's a Julie on July 5 at Prairie Meadows in the Iowa Oaks was a long time in coming.

"We've been waiting for it for a year and a half," said Steve Asmussen, who trains She's a Julie for Carrol Castille's Whispering Oaks Farm.

She's a Julie worked like a monster last year, Asmussen said, and won her career debut as a 2-year-old in May 2017 by more than five lengths. She came unglued when a rainstorm hit Churchill Downs as she was in the paddock before the Debuted Stakes, threw in a clunker there, didn't race again until last winter at Fair Grounds, and only in her last couple of starts has really put everything together.

In the Iowa Oaks, she rated kindly in second under Ricardo Santana Jr., sitting a couple of lengths off a fast pace, attacked the leader before the quarter pole, and had the race won at the furlong grounds. Geared down late, she won by 5 1/2 lengths, ran 1 1/16 miles in a snappy 1:43.18, and got a career-best 94 Beyer Speed Figure.

"I was impressed with the way she went fast," Asmussen said. "She was rolling and she looked comfortable. It was so steady. She didn't decelerate."

This was the first stakes win for She's a Julie, who is stabled at Churchill, and the race had been her connections' goal for some time, so nobody in her camp has yet mapped out a specific plan for the rest of the summer. But things could get interesting.

"I'm excited about what might be next," said Asmussen.

Dixie Serenade was so far back turning for home in the Grade 3, \$150,000 Victory Ride Stakes at Belmont Park on July 8 that trainer Ed Coletti Jr. couldn't find her.

But as Dixie Serenade gobbled up ground along the inside in the final sixteenth of a mile, Coletti spotted her making a late charge under Mychel Sanchez.

"I didn't know that was her coming up the rail until the last couple of jumps because I lost her in the mix," Coletti said. "I was like, 'What the hell?'"

More like, "Hell yeah!"

Coletti picked up Dixie Serenade as she nailed Classy Act in the final jump to win the Victory Ride by a neck at odds of 47-1. It was a half-length farther back to Sower in third.

Separation of powers, in her first start

since last year's Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies, did well to finish fourth after stumbling at the break. Mia Mischief, the 6-5 favorite, was fifth, followed by Spectator, Take Charge Paula, and Norma's Charm.

It was the fourth win from 11 starts for Dixie Serenade, a Pennsylvania-bred daughter of Uptowncharlybrown owned by Uptowncharlybrown Stud, an offshoot of the breeders Fantasy Lane Stable.

Dixie Serenade, the second-longest shot in the eight-horse field, paid \$97.50 to win. She ran 6 1/2 furlongs in 1:16.57.

In the early running, Dixie Serenade was last, 10 3/4 lengths off the pace, while Mia Mischief, the 123-pound highweight under Ricardo Santana Jr., and Classy Act, carrying 117 pounds under Brian Hernandez, slugged it out through a quarter of 22.25 seconds and a half-mile in 44.63.

Sower, under Irad Ortiz Jr., looked to be getting a dream trip from third and appeared as though she was going to go by the top pair in midstretch and win her fourth consecutive race. But Sower and Mia Mischief couldn't get by Classy Act, who ran a brave race only to be nipped late by Dixie Serenade.

Sanchez saved ground down the backside on Dixie Serenade, moved into the 2 path in upper stretch, and then dove back to the rail for the final furlong.

"The way she runs, you got to drop in, save some ground, and hopefully everything opens up, and everything opened up today," Sanchez said. "They went fast in the beginning — that helped us."

Coletti said he would most likely point Dixie Serenade to the Grade 1 Test at Saratoga on Aug. 4.

Trainer Ignacio Correas and jockey Joe Bravo won the second race on July 7 at Arlington with a horse named Question de Tiempo, who led wire to wire. "Just run it back, Joe," might as well have been Correas's instructions before the Grade 3, \$100,000 American Derby, where Real

Story shot straight to the front under Bravo and never was threatened, winning by 1 3/4 lengths over favored Captivating Moon.

And this was no case of a front-runner taking advantage of a false pace. Real Story set splits of 23.25, 47.45, and 1:11.45, all very legitimate for 1 1/8 miles on the Arlington turf course. He went one mile in 1:35.43 and stopped the timer in 1:47.61. Real Story cut the last corner with verve, pushed his margin to an apparently insurmountable advantage at the eighth pole, and cruised impressively under the wire.

"I didn't think it was that easy," said Correas. I was scared of the stretch."

Real Story ran the best race of his life in his stakes debut. A debut winner at Tampa on Dec. 17, he flopped on dirt at Gulfstream second out, was a solid pace-setting third in a Keeneland allowance race in April, and ran the only poor turf race of his career at Churchill Downs when Correas said he instructed the rider to try and take a hold of Real Story and relax him off the pace. Back to front-running tactics, Real Story easily won an Arlington allowance race June 15 before running even better Saturday.

"Relax on the lead is the only way he knows how to relax," Correas said.

Captivating Moon, who came down the center of the course, appeared to be all out to finish second over rail-rallying Dubby Dubbie. Correas's second entrant, Pont Du Gard, finished fourth.

Real Story paid \$16.80 to win as he was winning for the third time in six starts. A gelding by Fast Bullet out of My Own Story, by Lasting Approval, Real Story was bred and is owned by Jeffrey Amling and Merriebelle Stable.

Divisidero finally won a graded stakes race away from Churchill Downs, and his victory in the Grade 3, \$100,000 Arlington Handicap on July 7 gave trainer Kelly Rubley her first graded stakes win anywhere.

Closing from ninth under Jevian Toledo, Divisidero followed favored Synchrony's bid past the three-furlong pole, came abreast Synchrony and Revved Up at the quarter-pole, and put the Arlington Handicap to bed with his slingshot move into the homestretch.

Divisidero had a half-length lead at the stretch call and, despite Revved Up's efforts to get back on terms, held the same advantage at the wire. Synchrony, plugging away between horses, was another half-length back in third, Tizzarunner fourth by the same margin.

Six-year-old Divisidero was making his third start since Thomas Keithley, who races as Gunpowder Farms, moved the horse to Rubley at the Fair Hill training center from longtime trainer Buff Bradley. Divisidero was second by three-quarters of a length in the Monmouth Stakes his first start this year and a tough-luck fourth last out in the Wise Dan at Churchill, a race in which he got shuffled back to last at the three-furlong pole.

"I think the last two times he just needed the races after the layoff," said Toledo. "Last time he still ran huge. Today, he was going to be ready to go."

Roman Approval crossed over from the outside post to lead, setting moderate splits of 23.99 and 48.83 seconds while chased by Just Howard and Compass Zone. Revved Up was fourth on the outside with Synchrony midpack and between horses as Divisidero, caught a few paths wide, ran along farther behind. It was Synchrony upon whom Toledo kept his eye, shadowing the moves of jockey Joe Bravo on the even-money favorite.

"I read the program and that was the horse to beat. I just tried to follow him the entire way," Toledo said. "When he made his move at the quarter pole, I knew I had to go before he opened up."

Divisidero, racing under 121 pounds and getting one pound from Synchrony, was timed in 1:54.03 for the 1 3/16 miles over firm turf and paid \$7 to win.

Divisidero has won three graded stakes at Churchill, including the Grade 1 Turf Classic twice, but had lost his 10 stakes starts

away from his favorite course. He finished seventh in the 2017 Arlington Million but, Rubley said, could return for another try in the race next month.

"All things being well, I think we'd be headed in that direction if it all works out that way," said Rubley.

Divisidero also won for the first time beyond 1 1/8 miles; he would have to negotiate another half-furlong if he comes to the Million.

Just getting to the race would be another milestone for Rubley, who has about 50 horses in training at Fair Hill after going out on her own in 2014. The former assistant to trainers Barclay Tagg and Jimmy Toner had gone 0-1-2 with her first 25 graded-stakes starters, but the first 23 of those came with horses not named Divisidero.

"He's the friskiest horse at home; the happiest horse," Rubley said.

Daddys Lil Darling flicked away the impediments of a poor post and the top weight of 124 pounds and won the Modesty Handicap at Arlington on July 7 in a romp.

Her manner of victory seemed especially notable. Daddys Lil Darling often has fallen well behind the leaders, leaving her dependent on pace and luck, in the Modesty, breaking from post 12 under Brian Hernandez Jr., she tracked posted splits that were fast for a 1 3/16-mile race.

"She showed a new dimension," said Hernandez, who was aboard the filly for the first time.

Sully's Dream and Go Baby Go set off for the lead and went a quarter-mile with a tailwind in a posted 22.71 seconds, and there was Daddys Lil Darling, right behind them, outside in the clear, racing third.

"She has that kind of pace — she just hasn't shown it," said trainer Ken McPeck. "Maybe Brian made a difference."

The half-mile went in a snappy 47.06, six furlongs in 1:11.16, and Daddys Lil Darling still was doing it easily. Hernandez let her out a notch turning for home, and Daddys Lil Darling switched leads like a champ, opening a four-length lead at the stretch call and coasting home 2 1/4 lengths in front of Prado's Sweet Ride.

"She's already a Grade 1 winner," Hernandez said. "Maybe this helps her get even better."

Daddys Lil Darling was timed in 1:53.80 over a firm, fast-playing turf course and paid \$5.80 to win as the favorite.

Sully's Dream was vanned off the course and taken to the backstretch for further evaluation, Arlington officials said.

Daddys Lil Darling, owned by Normandy Farm, is by Scat Daddy and out of the Houston mare Miss Hot Salsa, and she has long been near the top of her class in route races on both dirt and turf. Second in the Kentucky Oaks last year, she also was second in the Queen Elizabeth II Challenge Cup on Keeneland grass before winning the Grade 1 American Oaks at Santa Anita.

This was her first win from four starts this year.

Jockey Jose Valdivia Jr. averages close to two wins a day here at Arlington. New York-based trainer Naipul Chatterpaul was looking for his second win in 2018. Jockey and trainer came together with an Argentine import named Catcho En Die, who led all 1 1/2-miles of the Grade 3, \$100,000 Stars and Stripes Stakes at Arlington on July 7.

It was just the second graded stakes win for Chatterpaul, whose first such victory came when Mission Approved, claimed for \$35,000, won the Grade 1 Manhattan in 2011. Chatterpaul and Sotirios Sakatis claimed Catcho En Die for \$40,000 on April 21. Catcho En Die finished fifth in the Grade 1 Man o' War and a close 10th in the Manhattan before being stretched to 1 1/2 miles for the first time and capturing the Stars and Stripes.

"I've been known as a claiming trainer," Chatterpaul said. "I've been looking at the horse for quite some time, but that's my job — looking at horses to claim. Both those last

two races, he had problems. I expected him to win or place in one of those."

Catcho En Die, a Group 1 winner over 1 1/4 miles on turf in Argentina, broke from post 2 Saturday, and with an inside draw, Valdivia saw an opportunity.

"There was no pace today and for whatever reason the course is a little speed biased, which it never is," Valdivia said. "I just took advantage of a pacesetter race and a good post. If I had a different post, I don't think I'd have done it."

Catcho En Die (\$19,20), mildly prompted by Harlan Strong, set splits of 24.72 seconds, 49.72, 1:13.34, 1:40.26, and 2:04.68. His last quarter-mile was easily his fastest, a wind-aided 22.68 seconds, according to official timing, for a final clocking of 2:27.51. Canessar, coming hard up the rail under Feargal Lynch, was gaining through the final furlong, but Catcho En Die just held him off to win by a neck. Soglio had aim on the winner the entire homestretch but settled for third, beaten a neck by Canessar.

"He's trying to get out, but I'm talking to him, guiding him around," said Valdivia. "When they came to him, he kept finding."

Arklow finished another 2 1/2 lengths back in fourth after racing wide without cover around the third turn and getting fanned even farther out into the course turning for home.

Catcho En Die is a 6-year-old gelding by Catcher in the Rye and the Engrillado mare, Lola Grill. He raced three times in Argentina during 2016 then didn't start for the better part of two years, returning to the races at Gulfstream for trainer Bill Mott. This was his fifth win from eight starts, and Chatterpaul said he plans to point Catcho En Die for the Arlington Million in August.
