In the cathedral of horse racing, Catholic Boy emerged as a patriarch among active 3-year-olds.

Receiving a textbook ride from Javier Castellano, Catholic Boy stalked Mendelssohn from second, took over turning for home, and cruised to a four-length victory in the Grade 1, \$1.25 million Travers Stakes, the biggest prize offered at historic Saratoga, on Aug. 25.

Mendelssohn, the Irish import who set the pace under Ryan Moore, finished second by a length over Bravazo. King Zachary was fourth, followed by Vino Rosso Trigger Warning, Tenfold, Gronkowski, Good Magic, the 7-5 favorite, and Wonder Gadot, the first filly in 39 years to try the Travers.

The victory justified the decision by the connections of Catholic Boy – specifically trainer Jonathan Thomas – to transfer Catholic Boy back to the dirt after he won the Grade 1 Belmont Derby on turf.

Robert LaPenta, part-owner of Catholic Boy who said it was his dream to win the Travers since he was a teenager, said, “We knew he’d run well on dirt. We didn’t know he’d run this well.”

Said Thomas: “He proved today that he’s better on the dirt.”

Though it doesn’t take away from Catholic Boy’s performance, he likely benefited from a track that was favoring front-runners over two days. Catholic Boy

broke alertly from his outside post in the 10-horse field and was just a half-length off of Mendelssohn through a quarter in 23.30 seconds, a half-mile in 47.81, and six furlongs in 1:11.97.

“I felt so good after seeing them throw up the [23 and 1], the 47 and change, he just looked like he was traveling so easy getting in that big, big rhythm of his,” Thomas said. “Javier gave him an outstanding ride, a Hall of Fame ride. We literally had no instructions, it was all on him.”

Nobody knows how to win the Travers better than Castellano, who improved his record to six Travers wins with this one. Castellano said he was concerned when Catholic Boy drew the outside post, but after the race said it was a blessing.

Castellano said he was able to get a stalking spot easily and said he felt he had Mendelssohn anytime he wanted him.

Castellano confronted Mendelssohn at the five-sixteenths pole, took over straightening away for home.

“The horse was in the bridle the way I wanted him to be,” Castellano said. “The last part of the race I was looking for the closers. I just waited turning for home. When I asked him, he was much the best horse.”

Catholic Boy, by [More Than Ready](#), covered the 1 1/4 miles in 2:01.94 and returned \$16.20 as the third betting choice. In addition to LaPenta, Catholic Boy counts Sol Kumin’s Madaket Stables, Siena Farm, and Twin Creeks Racing Stables among his owners.

Catholic Boy, who won the Grade 2 Remsen on dirt at Aqueduct to close out his juvenile campaign, had been on the Triple Crown trail earlier this year. But he bled when fourth in the Florida Derby in March and was given time to recover. He went back to the turf – a surface on which he had won two of his first three starts – and won the Grade 3 Pennine Ridge and Grade 1 Belmont Derby, both at Belmont Park.

“Winning that Grade 1 allowed us to go ahead and roll the dice for this race,”

Thomas said. “We never felt we were outmatched, but there was a question mark over our head. He trained so well, you just listen to your horse.”

Mendelssohn, who had finished last in the Kentucky Derby and a well-beaten third in the Dwyer, ran his best race since his 18 1/2-length victory in the UAE Derby in March.

Bravazo, the Preakness runner-up who ran in all three Triple Crown races, ran his typical solid race.

The biggest disappointments were Good Magic, Gronkowski, and Wonder Gadot.

Good Magic, the Kentucky Derby runner-up, didn’t break sharply under Jose Ortiz and was farther back than trainer Chad Brown had hoped, especially given how the track was playing.

Beyond that, Brown said that Ortiz told him “around the half-mile pole he started to not feel good under him, he didn’t have that horse power under him, so to speak, so he started to retreat some.”

Gronkowski the Belmont Stakes runner-up, was second-to-last entering the first turn under Joel Rosario and was steadied twice down the backside.

"He had to stop him a couple of times," Brown said. "From there, he couldn't make up any ground on this track."

Mark Casse, the trainer of Wonder Gadot, said his filly had no excuses. She was sitting third along the inside early and simply never fired retreating to last.

"All you ask for is to have a good trip, we had a good trip, we just weren't good enough today," Casse said.

Last month in the Grade 2 Bowling Green, Channel Maker rallied from a few lengths off the pace to get up for a dead-heat victory with front-running Glorious Empire. Things worked out a little differently Aug. 25 in the Grade 1 Sword Dancer at Saratoga, as Glorious Empire and Channel Maker ran first and second the entire 1 1/2-mile race, with Glorious Empire having plenty in reserve to score a 1 3/4-length victory.

Glorious Empire was a little keen during the opening quarter-mile, which went in 23.16 seconds. But jockey Julien Leparoux got him to settle into a smooth, even tempo through splits of 48.18, 1:13.88, and 1:38.82, seemingly lulling his followers to sleep.

Nobody closed any substantial ground during the stretch run, with Spring Quality closing from fifth to finish third, two lengths behind Channel Maker.

Glorious Empire paid \$33.40 as the seventh wagering choice in the 10-horse field. He completed the course in 2:24.41, getting his final quarter-mile in 22.55.

The Sword Dancer is part of the Breeders' Cup Challenge Series, so Glorious Empire earned a guaranteed, fees-paid berth in the \$4 million BC Turf at Churchill Downs.

The Sword Dancer was the first Grade 1 wins for both owner Matthew Schera and trainer James "Chuck" Lawrence II.

Schera claimed Glorious Empire for \$62,500 in May 2017 at Belmont Park. With Carlos Martin as the trainer, they won

a \$50,000 claiming race at Saratoga last summer. In his third start for Schera, Glorious Empire bled in the Grade 2 Baltimore-Washington Turf Cup at Laurel Park and was eased.

"This horse had never had a break," Schera said. "He had won races in Great Britain, in Hong Kong, and here, but he needed a break. When he was ready to come back, I sent him to Chuck."

Lawrence, a former steeplechase rider, is based at the Fair Hill Training Center in Elkton, Md. Before he began training on his own, he worked with the acclaimed jump trainers Burling Cocks and Michael Smithwick.

"[When] he came to me he had a reputation of being bad in the paddock and some other things, and we did everything to just try and quiet him down," Lawrence said. "I work him a lot farther than most people work a horse and do things like turn him out and take him cross-country. He probably sees the racetrack three or four times a week."

Lawrence galloped Glorious Empire a mile the morning of the Sword Dancer.

"We did that so he thought he was done for the day," Lawrence said. "We try to not only educate him but learn how to deal with him, to get into his head."

Another terrific race between Abel Tasman and Elate at Saratoga ended with another Abel Tasman victory – and another controversy.

One year after Abel Tasman defeated Elate by a head in the Grade 1 Coaching Club American Oaks, Abel Tasman defeated Elate by a neck in the Grade 1, \$700,000 Personal Ensign Stakes on Aug. 25.

Last year, Abel Tasman and Mike Smith withstood a stewards' inquiry for tighten-

ing things up late on Elate. In the Personal Ensign, Abel Tasman had to withstand a jockey's objection when the two fillies bumped hard in deep stretch. Elate jockey Jose Ortiz claimed foul on Smith and Abel Tasman, but the stewards let the result stand.

That decision led the fans to boo during the winner's circle presentation, and that frustrated the usually subdued Bill Mott, trainer of Elate.

"The only way he can beat us is if he bothers us," Mott said, referring to trainer Bob Baffert. "Last year, it was questionable. This year, I don't know, it's the wild, wild west, I guess. The rider almost came off."

Mott felt that Smith and Abel Tasman came over several paths and initiated the contact that knocked Elate off stride, costing her a chance to win.

"He rammed us pretty good, we didn't ram him," Mott said. "My filly drifted down a little bit but then she kept on her straight course and then that one came out and got us. ... I try to be objective, and being objective, I don't like the call."

Ortiz was also frustrated.

"You couldn't miss it," Ortiz said. "He clearly came out, knocked my filly off balance, knocked me off balance and beat me by a neck. I think [Abel Tasman] should have come down, 100 percent."

Smith naturally disagreed, saying both were at equal fault.

"We just kind of came together, I didn't herd him at all and she wasn't going to let him by no matter what," Smith said. "And he came back and bumped me. I don't think it bothered either one of us."

The stewards agreed with Smith. In a statement released by the New York State Gaming Commission, the stewards said "the incident did not alter the order of finish."

The controversy clouded a fabulous effort from both fillies.

Abel Tasman, who hadn't run since June 9 when she won the Grade 1 Ogden Phipps at Belmont, took over from pace-setting longshot She Takes Heart right after a half-mile was run in 46.62 seconds.

"She grabs a hold of you early, we've seen her do that before," Smith said. "Sometimes you got to go with it, man."

Going into the far turn Ortiz had Elate following Abel Tasman before guiding her to the outside turning for home. In the stretch, Ortiz kept Elate a few paths away from Abel Tasman before moving her toward Abel Tasman. Smith, using his left-hand whip, had Abel Tasman come out to see Elate and that's when the two bumped.

Elate got turned sideways and Abel Tasman was able to prevail. Abel Tasman covered the 1 1/8 miles in 1:47.19 and returned \$3.50 as the favorite.

Abel Tasman trainer Bob Baffert said he didn't see the bump live and when he saw the replay he felt confident the result would stand.

"I wasn't too worried," Baffert said. "If it would have been a nose or something, but Abel was widening on her at the end. But you don't like to see objections. I told Mike when he came back, 'Mike, you're killing me.' I'm just proud of the fact we had her ready and she ran really well."

The win was the eighth in 14 starts and sixth Grade 1 score for Abel Tasman, last year's champion 3-year-old filly and a daughter of Quality Road owned by China Horse Club and Clearsky Farms.

Elate finished second by 9 3/4 lengths over Wow Cat, who was followed.

Abel Tasman earned a fees-paid berth into the \$2 million Breeders' Cup Distaff at Churchill Downs on Nov. 3 as part of the "Win and You're In" program. No doubt, she will encounter Elate there again.

Seven weeks ago jockey Ricardo Santana Jr. tried to squeeze Whitmore through the narrowest of openings along the rail entering the stretch. He caromed off another runner as well as the inside fence before ultimately dropped a heartbreaking neck decision to Limousine Liberal in the Grade 2 Belmont Sprint.

On Aug. 25 at Saratoga, Santana again kept Whitmore along the rail awaiting his chance to pounce on the leaders. But this time, when he turned into the stretch, Santana found himself with more than ample room to make his decisive move, ultimately guiding Whitmore to a 1 1/2-length victory over the 4-5 City of Light in the Grade 1 Forego, a "Win and You're In" race for the Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile.

"Live by the sword, die by the sword," trainer Ron Moquett said in the winner's circle after the seven-furlong Forego. "Last time, we didn't make it coming through the inside. This time, we look like geniuses."

Whitmore also benefitted from a four-

horse duel for the early lead, with Heartwood setting the pace nearest the rail while prompted from the outset by C Z Rocket, Warrior's Club and City of Light. Whitmore raced in perfect striking position behind the leaders, made his move after Heartwood drifted well out entering the stretch, took command at the top of the stretch and gradually edged away.

City of Light, fanned even farther out entering the stretch, continued on gamely despite not switching off his left lead until midstretch, and ultimately outlasted Limousine Liberal by a nose to finish second. C Z Rocket, No Dozing, Heartwood, Awesome Slew, and Warrior's Club rounded out the order of finish.

Owned in partnership by Robert LaPenta, Head of Plains Partners, and Moquett, Whitmore became a Grade 1 winner for the first time after completing seven furlongs in 1:21.46. That clocking was a couple of ticks slower than the final time for both the Grade 1 Allen Jerkens and the Grade 1 Ballerina, also decided at seven furlongs, earlier on the card.

Whitmore, a 5-year-old son of Pleasantly Perfect, paid \$19.60. The winner's share of \$320,000 put his career earnings at just under \$2 million.

"To run that well here means everything, it's a somewhat temporary validation that he belongs, since he's kind of been labeled an Oaklawn horse," Moquett said.

"He's as consistent as they come and he tries every time. He's fun to be around, but he's a challenge. He's not a kid's pony. And he brings that same tenacity to the track."

Moquett said he'd likely use the Grade 2 Phoenix, a race Whitmore won last year, as his final prep for the Breeders' Cup.

Trainer Dale Romans said all along it would mean a lot to him if he could win the Grade 1 H. Allen Jerkens, a race named in honor of the Hall of Fame horseman and

his longtime close friend. But Romans took his dream one step further on Aug. 25 at Saratoga, not only winning the \$500,000 Allen Jerkens but sweeping the top two spots after Promises Fulfilled beat stablemate Seven Trumpets by 1 1/2 lengths.

"That was very special," Romans said. "Allen and I were very close. He was not only a good friend but a mentor in life. It's an honor to win that race. And to get up for second, we might have had a little divine intervention."

Promises Fulfilled entered the seven-furlong Allen Jerkens off the best race of his career, a 3 1/4 length victory in the Grade 3 Amsterdam here earlier in the session for which he earned a 108 Beyer Speed Figure. And, to nobody's surprise, the speedy son of Shackelford sprinted right to the lead after breaking alertly from the rail under jockey Luis Saez.

Promises Fulfilled got away with a soft opening quarter in 22.66 then picked up the pace around the bend, completing a half in 44.34 while stalked by Gidu during the early going. Promises Fulfilled turned back a serious challenge from Engage after angling wide into the stretch, came back to the rail while edging clear through midstretch, and maintained a safe advantage over Seven Trumpets at the end.

Seven Trumpets recovered from a slow start to race close up along the rail, eased out to go after his stablemate near midstretch, and while not good enough remained second-best, a half-length in front of Firenze Fire. The latter, like Promises Fulfilled, exiting the race of his life in the Grade 3 Dwyer, raced wide while within striking distance throughout but lacked the necessary closing response. Engage finished another neck farther back in fourth after making a big run entering the stretch.

Owned by Robert Baron, Promises Fulfilled covered seven furlongs over a fast track in 1:21.44 and paid \$4.50.

Bob Baffert sent two horses to Saratoga for the Travers card on Aug. 25. He put Mike Smith up on both of them and won back-to-back Grade 1's as Abel Tasman won the Personal Ensign and Marley's Freedom took down the Ballerina.

While the Personal Ensign was a nail-biter and Abel Tasman had to withstand a jockey's objection, Marley's Freedom was a clear-cut winner of the \$700,000 Ballerina, a seven-furlong race for fillies and mares.

Baffert shared a joke with his assistant trainer Jimmy Barnes after the Ballerina.

"I told Jimmy we should have brought more," Baffert said.

Marley's Freedom, a 4-year-old daughter of Blame, was transferred to Baffert's stable after winning a second-level optional-claiming race at Santa Anita in April. She has since won the Grade 3 Desert Stormer by 7 1/4 lengths, the Grade 2 Great Lady M by 1 1/2 lengths, and now the Ballerina by 3 1/4 lengths.

"She was in great shape when I got her, so I can't take a lot of credit for it," Baffert said. "I just kept her in that form. But the way she won those first two races was pretty impressive. It told me the quality was there."

Finley'sluckycharm sprinted clear early in the Ballerina and set a slow pace of 23.11 and 45.44 seconds. She was tracked in the second flight by, from the rail out, Ivy Bell, Still There, and Lewis Bay. Marley's Freedom was a little farther back and outside horses.

Lewis Bay challenged Finley'sluckycharm on the far turn and Marley's Freedom went outside both of them entering the stretch. She quickly opened up and was not seriously challenged by runner-up Still There, who stumbled at the start and had a tricky trip from between horses.

Lewis Bay finished third, 1 1/4 lengths behind Still There and a half-length ahead of fourth-place Union Strike, who rallied belatedly.

Ivy Bell finished fifth, a neck behind Union Strike. Finley'sluckycharm tired to seventh.

Marley's Freedom paid \$5.80 as the favorite in the eight-horse field and was timed in 1:21.39, while getting her final furlong in 12.47 seconds.

The Ballerina is a Win and You're In

for the \$1 million Breeders' Cup Filly and Mare Sprint at Churchill Downs on Nov. 3.

Baffert said he was not sure if Marley's Freedom would race again before the Breeders' Cup.

"This was definitely her toughest field," Baffert said. "I think we found out a lot about her today. She was unbelievable. Usually, she's farther back, but they were going slow. Mike had her in great position."

Thirty minutes after the disappointment of the Travers, trainer Chad Brown was back in familiar territory, the Saratoga winner's circle, following Quidura's wire to wire, 1 3/4-length victory over Hawksmoor in the \$400,000 Ballston Spa Stakes on Aug. 25.

Quidura and jockey Jose Ortiz took advantage of a turf course that favored speed throughout the day, quickly sprinting clear to control the pace while stalked by Hawksmoor throughout. Quidura responded when challenged by Hawksmoor into the stretch, readily dismissed the bid, then held a safe advantage over that rival to the wire with none of the others ever a posing a serious threat through the stretch. Indian Blessing, making her U.S. debut, rallied from last to finish another 1 1/4 lengths back in third.

Quidura, who is owned by Peter Brant, was one of three horses Brown sent out in the Grade 2 Ballston Spa along with the 3-5 favorite A Raving Beauty and Off Limits, who finished noses apart while fourth and fifth, respectively. The outing was just the

second of the year for Quidura, a two-time graded stakes winner earlier in her career with Graham Motion, who was purchased by Brant at the end of her 2017 campaign.

Quidura traveled 1 1/16 miles over the firm course in 1:39.67 and paid \$9.50.

"We bought her at the sale last year and gave her plenty of time off," Brown said. "I think she needed her last start. She ran on really soft turf, which she doesn't like, and she still almost won. She trained strong coming out of that race and today she got the firm ground that she likes."

The margins of victory keep increasing for the undefeated Catalina Cruiser.

After winning his stakes debut in the Grade 2 San Diego Handicap at 1 1/16 miles by 6 3/4 lengths on July 21, Catalina Cruiser won the Grade 2 Pat O'Brien Stakes at seven furlongs by 7 1/4 lengths at Del Mar on Aug. 25.

Catalina Cruiser (\$2.40) was in control on the backstretch. Ridden by Drayden Van Dyke, Catalina Cruiser dueled with early pacesetter Threefiveindia for the first quarter-mile before taking the lead with more than three furlongs remaining.

Catalina Cruiser led by 3 1/2 lengths with a furlong to go and was timed in 1:22.13.

"Once you get him going, it's hard for him to stop," Van Dyke said. "He's very smart, super talented for how big he is."

The win in the \$196,000 Pat O'Brien Stakes had greater significance than the first-place purse of \$120,000 earned by owners Pete and Kosta Hronis. Catalina Cruiser earned a fees-paid berth for the Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile at Churchill Downs on Nov. 3.

In the Pat O'Brien, Catalina Cruiser easily defeated Battle of Midway, the winner of the 2017 BC Dirt Mile here last November. Battle of Midway was sent to stud in Kentucky last winter, but was put back in training in the spring when he was found to be subfertile.

The Pat O'Brien was Battle of Midway's first start since the BC Dirt Mile. Flavien Prat rode Battle of Midway, who was third for the first half-mile before advancing to second.

"We knew we were up against an odds-on favorite and we needed a race," trainer Jerry Hollendorfer said. "Flavien said he got a lot out of it."

Vorticity was third, 5 3/4 lengths ahead of Threefiveindia. The race had a small field due to scratches of Horse Greedy, Ransom the Moon, Roy H, and St. Joe Bay.

Catalina Cruiser, a 4-year-old by Union Rags, has earned \$303,600 from four wins.

Trained by John Sadler, Catalina Cruiser won his debut in a maiden race at six furlongs at Santa Anita last October. Catalina Cruiser did not race last winter or in the early spring, and won an allowance race with a \$40,000 claiming option at six furlongs in his comeback at Santa Anita on May 19.

Axelrod cemented his status as a rising contender in this 3-year-old crop with his second consecutive graded stakes victory, drawing clear late in the Grade 3, \$300,000 Smarty Jones Stakes on Aug. 25 at Parx.

Axelrod (\$10 to win), who was not away alertly, recovered to stalk the pace under Joe Bravo but was still fifth after six furlongs and looking for running room on the far turn. Trainer Robertino Diodoro, who recently won his 2,000th race at Saratoga, was very emotional after seeing his Sky Promise win the Grade 3, \$200,000 Canadian Derby at Northlands Park on Aug. 25. The 1 3/8-mile derby was the final Thoroughbred race at Northlands, which opened for racing in 1900.

"It is very special to win the last race here," Diodoro said. "I won my first race as a trainer here, my mom worked in the mutuels, and my grandfather was the custodian of the jocks room at one time, and he trained here. There is a lot of history. You are going to see a lot of sad faces leaving this track today. To have won my first race here and the last one, well, it is pretty awesome."

Under a confident ride by Rico Walcott, Sky Promise had one horse beat in the nine-horse field while his stablemate, Hyndford, walked through a half-mile in 51.13 seconds. He saved ground going around the first three turns before Walcott eased him outside coming out of third turn. He started to pick up horses just past the three-eighth pole, and it was pretty clear he was going to win when he was in full flight at the quarter-pole. He took over the lead from Shimshine on the final turn, opened up a clear lead turning for home and never looked threatened by Day Raider, who rallied late. Shimshine, who made a strong move to take over the lead at approaching the quarter-pole, held on to finish third.

The winning margin was a length with Day Raider finishing 5 1/2 lengths clear of Shimshine.

Sky Promise paid \$4.10 to win and posted

a final time of 2:20.11.

Jockey Drayden Van Dyke has hooked himself into all the top barns this summer at Del Mar, winning races for Peter Miller, Bob Baffert, and Jerry Hollendorfer, but his greatest stakes successes the first six weeks of the meet have come with trainer John Sadler. They took down another on Aug. 26 when True Royalty scored a 3 1/2-length victory in the Grade 3, \$101,725 Torrey Pines Stakes for 3-year-old fillies.

The win was the fifth stakes Van Dyke has had in concert with Sadler – scoring previously with Catapult and Catalina Cruiser, both of whom won two stakes this summer – and the meet-leading ninth overall for Van Dyke, who will head into the

final six days of the meet atop the jockeys' standings.

If he prevails, it would be his first Del Mar title.

"I don't want to count my eggs before they're hatched," Van Dyke said after True Royalty's win.

If Van Dyke keeps getting put on live horses such as True Royalty, he'll be in good shape. True Royalty (\$19.20 to win) was drawn widest in the 10-horse field in the one-mile Torrey Pines, and though she had to go wide throughout, she was unencumbered by some traffic that developed inside of her on the first turn, and she ended up in an ideal stalking position heading into the far turn.

True Royalty surged to the lead on the far turn, put away Thirteen Squared and then Broome heading to the quarter pole, and was never threatened through the lane.

Just Grazed Me, the 2-1 favorite, ran on for second after getting knocked around in traffic on the first turn before having to rally wide. She finished 2 1/2 lengths in front of third-place Spring Lily.

True Royalty completed one mile on the fast main track in 1:39.07

True Royalty, a daughter of Yes It's True, has now won three times in seven starts. This was her first stakes victory. She earned \$60,000 and now has career earnings of \$154,510 for her owner, Joanne Batchelor.
