After seven frustrating attempts that included several heartbreaking near-misses, Heart to Heart finally got his first career Grade 1 victory after holding off a late bid from Kurilov to register a neck decision in the \$300,000 Gulfstream Park Turf on Feb. 10.

With his regular rider Julien Leparoux back in the saddle following a disastrous trip as the odds-on favorite here last month in the Grade 2 Ft. Lauderdale, Heart to Heart went right to the lead, as expected,

from his inside post. Heart to Heart was allowed to set a moderate pace, posting splits of :24.15 seconds, 48.74, and 1:12.08 for the opening six furlongs. He shook loose from his early pursuer One Go All Go on settling into the stretch, then held off Kurilov under vigorous handling.

Kurilov, making just his third start in this country and first on turf, raced within easy striking distance of the leader while saving ground to the stretch, tipped out for the final run, finished with good energy but was not quite good enough. Hi Happy rallied mildly to finish third, another three parts of a length behind Kurilov.

Heart to Heart, who finished second in both the Grade 1 Maker's Mark Mile and Shadwell Turf Mile as well as third in the Grade 1 Shoemaker Mile last year, is a son of English Channel owned by Terry Hamilton and trained by Brian Lynch. He completed the 1 1/8 miles in 1:47.64 and paid \$7.20 to win as the favorite in the field of eight older turf specialists.

"Watching him come back in (to the winner's circle) and blow as hard as he did, you know he gave it his all today," Lynch said. "To be so close so many times in Grade 1 races and then to have him get it here today was great. It's great for the morale of the barn and great for the morale of the Hamiltons as well."

Lynch said he was obviously a bit concerned after Heart to Heart hopped at the start and ran so poorly four weeks earlier in the Ft. Lauderdale.

"When they throw craps at you like that, it's always in the back of your mind it could happen again or that maybe he's not trying to go in the right direction, although everything since the race indicated to just put a pencil through it, load him up again, and let him do his thing," Lynch said.

"We'll give him a rest now and go to the Maker's Mile, although as I've been saying, I think I'm going to try to stretch him out a little bit farther this year. I think he might be a little vulnerable at a mile, they all get

to take a little shot at him at a mile. But at a mile and one eighth and farther, if they do give him a breather, like they did today, that's when he's really dangerous."

Trainer Jerry Hollendorfer teamed up with Flavien Prat to win the Grade 2, \$200,345 San Vicente Stakes for 3-year-olds with 11-1 shot Kanthaka.

Kanthaka benefitted from a torrid early pace that sapped odds-on favorite Ax Man and set it up for a horse with Kanthaka's late-running style. Kanthaka was fifth of six early, closed sharply as the leaders began to wilt, then kicked clear for a 3 1/4-length victory over Nero, who was the only other horse without the staggers at the end of seven furlongs.

It was another 12 lengths back to All Out Blitz in third, then came an exhausted Ax Man, Kris' Rocket Kat, and Mr. Jagermeister, who dueled with Ax Man early.

Mr. Jagermeister and Ax Man went 22 seconds flat for the opening quarter

and 44.25 seconds for a half-mile, this over a track that was a bit dull early and at a distance where the run-up is minimal. Kanthaka was timed in 1:22.62 on the fast main track.

"We thought we had a good chance. It looked like there was a lot of speed," Hollendorfer said, "so we thought we had a chance to run them down, especially the way he broke his maiden."

Kanthaka won a seven-furlong race on opening-day Dec. 26. Hollendorfer was desirous of running him in a first-level allowance going two turns, but when that race did not fill, the San Vicente became the best remaining option. He'll run in a two-turn stakes race next time, Hollendorfer said.

Drayden Van Dyke, who rode Ax Man, said his colt "never got a breather" after breaking from the rail.

Kanthaka, a son of Jimmy Creed, has now won twice in three starts. He earned \$120,000 to bring his career total to \$153,440. He was purchased as a 2-year-old in training in March 2017 at Barretts by the West Point Thoroughbreds partnership, which sent him to Hollendorfer.

Jerry Hollendorfer and his staff have gotten Unique Bella to slow down in the morning, and that has made the champion filly even more dangerous than she already was in the afternoon.

In her first start since being named the Eclipse Award-winning female sprinter of 2017, Unique Bella had an easy time of it on Feb. 10 at Santa Anita in her 4-year-old debut, coasting home against four over-matched rivals for a nine-length victory in the Grade 2, \$200,000 Santa Maria Stakes as she returned to two-turn racing.

As good as she was sprinting – good enough to be the best of her division – she's now 3 for 3 around two turns, and 7 for 9 overall. What will serve her well as the

year progresses is if she retains the demeanor she displayed in the Santa Maria, when she set an easy lead without getting aggressive and went about her business as if out for a morning workout under jockey Mike Smith.

"She's not quite as anxious as she used to be in the morning or the afternoon," Hollendorfer said. "She's settled down in the morning, and she has a lot left for the afternoon. I'll keep training her the same way."

Unique Bella doesn't blast off in her workouts anymore, and she gets extensive paddock schooling.

The fruits of that labor are evident in the afternoons. Unique Bella made the top in 23.54 seconds for the opening quarter, went the half in 46.80 and three-quarters in 1:10.95 while loping along, then drew away through the lane while covering 1 1/16 miles on the fast main track in 1:43.45.

As the heavy favorite, Unique Bella paid \$2.20 to win.

No one else mattered. Mopotism finished second, 1 1/4 lengths in front of Majestic Heat. Shenandoah Queen was fourth, and Kathy's Song was last after breaking poorly.

Unique Bella, 4, a daughter of Tapit, picked up \$120,000 for the victory and now has career earnings of \$712,400 for owner Don Alberto Stable, which purchased her as a yearling for \$400,000.

Hollendorfer said Unique Bella would make her next start in the Grade 1, \$400,000 Santa Margarita Stakes here on March 17 and then could be pointed to the Grade 1, \$700,000 Apple Blossom at Oaklawn on April 13.

Trainer Mark Casse wasn't sure whether Flameaway was good enough to outrun Catholic Boy and a couple others Feb. 10 in the Grade 3, \$200,000 Sam F. Davis Stakes at Tampa Bay Downs, but he was very confident of one thing.

"He's a fighter, this one," Casse said. "And I knew if there was a fight, he'd win it."

Always on the lead in a field of six, Flameaway and jockey Jose Lezcano briefly surrendered the lead to Catholic

Boy after turning for home in the 1 1/16-mile Davis. But at the furlong pole there was little between the top two, and Flameaway roared back when racing closest to the rail to win by a half-length. He paid \$22.60 as fourth choice after finishing in a stakes-record 1:42.44 over a fast track.

Flameaway, an Ontario-bred son of the late Scat Daddy, has won five of seven career starts for Casse and owner John Oxley. The Grade 3 Davis marks his fourth stakes win, and his second in a graded event. This victory was worth 10 Kentucky Derby qualifying points to Flameaway on a weekend with no other designated preps for the May 5 Derby.

Flameaway was not an early nominee to the Triple Crown, but Casse said that most likely will be taken care of in the next round of payments.

Catholic Boy, making his first start since winning the Dec. 2 Remsen by nearly five lengths, ran creditably in defeat as the 7-10 choice.

"You always want to win, but I'm happy with him," trainer Jonathan Thomas said. "He came with his run, and for being off 10 weeks it was a solid race. I'll need to watch it again and digest it all, but my initial reaction is to say this will move us forward."

Thomas said before the race he was inclined to run Catholic Boy next in the March 31 Florida Derby as the only interim prep for the Kentucky Derby.

Vino Rosso, the 2-1 second choice, was just another three-quarters of a length behind Catholic Boy in third. It was another 8 1/2 lengths back to Hollywood Star in fourth, with Navy Armed Guard and Septimius Severus completing the order.

The Davis record of 1:42.45 was set last year by McCracken. The track record of 1:41.75 was set last year on Tampa Bay Derby Day by Stanford.

Dona Bruja gave every indication that this could be her year when the Argentine-bred mare was an easy winner of the 19th running of the Grade 3, \$150,000 Endeavour Stakes at Tampa Bay Downs on Feb. 10.

Always on the lead under Jose Ortiz, Dona Bruja won the 1 1/16-mile turf race by four lengths over the even-money favorite, La Coronel, who broke a bit tardily when altering how many handicappers thought the race would unfold. The winner returned \$4.80 as second choice after finishing in 1:40.92 over firm going.

Ignacio Correas, who trains Dona Bruja for Dom Felipe, was elated with the outcome.

“That’s her,” Correas said. “She makes me look good, but really, that’s her.”

Dona Bruja won eight of 10 starts in her native country before making an immediate impact on being sent last year to the U.S., winning back-to-back Grade 3 turf stakes before finishing in a dead heat for second in the Grade 1 Beverly D. and fourth in the Grade 1 First Lady.

“We were not very lucky in her last two races,” Correas said. “Maybe this will be our year.”

Correas said his plan as 2018 unfolds will be to work backward from the Beverly D. in early August. He also said the mare could also be nominated to the Breeders’ Cup, with the intent of shooting for the BC Filly and Mare Turf at Churchill Downs on Nov. 3.

Both Dona Bruja and La Coronel were making their first starts since the Keenel-and fall meet in October. La Coronel, who led virtually from the start in winning the Grade 1 Queen Elizabeth II Challenge Cup, did not have such a quick beginning this time.

“That’s okay,” trainer Mark Casse said of La Coronel. “She ran well and showed something of a new dimension. We’ve got a long year ahead and I’m happy with how she ran.”

Truly Together was along late to be third, another length behind La Coronel.

World Approval began the defense of his championship as the top turf horse in North America by holding off Forge and winning the Grade 3, \$175,000 Tampa Bay Stakes.

World Approval, the 1-5 favorite, lagged about six lengths off the pace down the backstretch of the 1 1/16-mile turf race, then made his usual menacing move with about a half-mile to go before surging to the lead in the upper stretch. From there, he was kept to his business with several right-handed whacks from jockey John Velazquez before prevailing by a half-length over Forge, a 12-1 shot, with Fire Away another four lengths back in third in a field of nine older horses.

World Approval, a Live Oak Plantation homebred trained by Mark Casse, is expected to run next in the \$6 million Dubai Turf on March 31 at Meydan. The

Tampa Bay marks his fourth straight victory, and sixth from his last seven dating to last April, when he commenced a 2017 campaign that was worthy of a divisional Eclipse Award.

The 32nd Tampa Bay was marred by a spill in which jockey Antonio Gallardo came off Doctor Mounty after his mount appeared to clip heels near the quarterpole. A trailing horse, Cheyenne's Colonel, could not avoid Gallardo and also threw his jockey, Manny Cruz.

Tampa officials reported both jockeys escaped serious injury, with only Cruz being transported to a nearby hospital for further observation. Both horses also appeared to escape serious injury.

World Approval, a gray 6-year-old gelding by Northern Afleet, tipped past the \$3 million earnings mark with his 12th victory from 25 career starts. The Florida-bred completed the distance in 1:40.66 over firm going.

Thirty minutes after watching his Kuri-lov fall a neck short of winning the Grade 1 Gulfstream Park Turf, trainer Chad Brown rebounded in a big way by sending out Elysea's World and Dream Awhile to finish first and second, respectively, in the \$150,000 Suwannee River Stakes at Gulfstream Park on Feb.10.

Elysea's World rallied from midpack to run down her uncoupled stablemate Dream Awhile in deep stretch to register a neck decision under jockey Javier Castellano. The win was the first in 10 starts for Elysea's World dating back to her second-place finish in the 2017 Suwannee, a streak

during which she was graded stakes-placed on six occasions.

Dream Awhile stalked the early pace of Midnight Crossing, edged to command leaving the final turn, was clear through midstretch but could not quite contain the winner while finishing a half-length in front of the rail-skimming Ultra Brat to be second. Kitten's Roar, the 8-5 favorite, broke a bit awkwardly, recovered to force the early running, but could not muster a closing rally after racing wide throughout.

"But Elysea's World being the older horse and being the bridesmaid so many times, it's a real breakthrough for her in her last year of racing to win that graded stakes."

An old race strategy employed by a new jockey gave Om his first stakes win since late 2015 in the Grade 3 Thunder Road Stakes at Santa Anita on Feb. 10.

Om led throughout the Thunder Road Stakes for turf milers, a tactic similar to his wins in three Grade 2 races in 2015—the Del Mar Derby, Twilight Derby, and Mathis Brothers Mile. Saturday's win pushed Om's career earnings past the seven-figure mark.

Flavien Prat rode Om for the first time in the \$100,345 Thunder Road Stakes. Om took the lead shortly after the start, and was in front by as many as seven lengths on the backstretch.

Om (\$11.40) was challenged in the stretch by 2-1 Bowies Hero and prevailed by a half-length in 1:33.54.

"Before the half-mile pole, he gave me a nice breather," Prat said. "I looked back. I knew I was rolling. That's the way he wants to run."

Bowies Hero finished a head in front of 5-1 Next Shares, who was followed by Tequila Joe, Blackjackcat, and Ohio.

Blackjackcat, who was third in the Breeders' Cup Mile at Del Mar on Nov. 4, was second on the turn, but faded to finish five lengths behind Om as the even-money favorite. Trainer Mark Glatt said jockey Kent Desormeaux was unsure why Blackjackcat ran such a quiet race in his first start since the BC Mile.

"He said he felt a little flat," Glatt said. "I don't have any good answers right now."

Om won for the first time since the Mathis Brothers Mile on Dec. 26, 2015. Prat worked Om in the buildup to the Thunder Road and had raced against the 6-year-old horse numerous times.

"I kind of know the horse," he said.

Om set solid fractions of 22.58 seconds for the opening quarter-mile and 45.75 for a half-mile. Prat said he wanted Om in front of Blackjackcat.

"I didn't want to sit behind him," Prat said.

Om, who races for K.B. Sareen and trainer Dan Hendricks, has won 6 of 23 starts and earned \$1,001,645. Om had his best season as a 3-year-old in 2015, winning four races, including three stakes for 3-year-olds. In 2016 and 2017, Om was winless in 11 starts, including a nose loss in the Breeders' Cup Turf Sprint here in November, 2016.

In his only previous start this year, Om was fourth in the Joe Hernandez Stakes on the hillside turf course on Jan. 1.
