As the Fair Grounds assistant to trainer Mike Maker, Joe Sharp went down the Kentucky Derby trail in 2014 with Louisiana Derby winner Vicar's In Trouble. Later that year, Sharp went out on his own, and now, as a head trainer, Sharp has a Triple Crown prospect in his own stable, Girvin, who was a two-length winner of the Grade 2, \$400,000 Risen Star Stakes on Feb. 25 at Fair Grounds.

Girvin earned 50 qualifying points – plenty to get into the Derby field – by winning the Risen Star, an 85-point race on Churchill Downs's Road to the Kentucky Derby program. Second-place Untrapped got 20 points and, since he was second in

the Lecomte here last month, now has 24 points. Local Hero, who set the pace and held third, got 10 points, while fourth-place Guest Suite got five points after earning 10 for his Lecomte win.

Girvin got a great trip under Brian Hernandez Jr., who is the regular rider for leading Derby prospect McCraken, a Florida-based colt.

Brad Grady owns Girvin, a son of Tale of Ekati who has won two of his three starts. He's a brother to Cocked and Loaded, who won the Grade 3 Iroquois Stakes as a 2-year-old.

Girvin, away decently from post 1, was fifth around the first turn and down the backstretch while hugging the rail as Local Hero, who was sent to the lead by Florent Geroux, went his first quarter-mile into the wind in 23.70 seconds and a half-mile in a robust 47.02. Mo Town, the 3-2 favorite, chased in second, with Untrapped on the rail in third and Cool Arrow outside



in fourth.

Around the far turn, Local Hero held his advantage, and when Mo Town failed to go on, jockey Ricardo Santana guided Untrapped off the rail and into the No. 2 path to take aim on his stablemate, Local Hero. Hernandez, asking his mount for some run, moved Girvin up into the spot vacated by Untrapped, and when Mo Town came off the fence before the quarter pole, Girvin shot through a hole along the rail. He and Hernandez had plenty of room to maneuver outside Local Hero, and Girvin mowed down that rival and comfortably outfinished Untrapped, going past the wire clearly the best, and galloping out with good energy.

Girvin ran  $1\,1/16$  miles on a fast track in 1:43.08, good for a Beyer Speed Figure of 93, and paid \$18.20 to win.

"The good thing about this horse is his mentality," Hernandez said. "For him to do what he did today first time going two turns on dirt, that says a lot. The way he settled and found a nice rhythm, he was always there for me. Every time I needed to hit a spot, boom, and then he turns off again."

Girvin, who gave Sharp the most important win of his training career, has had a roller-coaster of a winter. He debuted here Dec. 16 in a six-furlong sprint and scored an eye-catching, hard-fought win over the talented Al Stall-trained colt Excitations, running a fast six furlongs. Sharp and Grady decided to point Girvin for the Jan. 21 Lecomte, but Sharp sent Girvin to his string at the Evangeline Downs Training Center just before an outbreak of equine herpesvirus put the Fair Grounds backstretch under quarantine, preventing Girvin from being entered in his intended spot.

At Evangeline, Girvin also had a minor foot problem and missed a work, but that issue resolved, and the quarantine lifted, Sharp ran Girvin here Feb. 4 in the Keith Gee Memorial Stakes, a turf mile, as a prep for the Risen Star. Girvin, who had shown sprint speed in his debut, settled behind a slow pace in the Keith Gee, finishing second, and Sharp had seen enough to move forward.

"It all worked out, but everybody thought it was crazy putting him on the turf," Sharp said. "I had to get two turns into him before I did this. This was a huge race. When Brian took him inside, you saw his ears go back. The horse likes a dog fight. It engages him."

Sharp said that if all goes well Girvin will make his next start April 1 in the \$1 million Louisiana Derby.

Plans were not as firm just after the Risen Star for the Steve Asmussentrained second- and third-place finishers, Untrapped and Local Hero.

Untrapped appeared to move forward from his Lecomte, and ran his second solid race at two turns.

"We're in agreement that he stays, and that was kind of the question with him,"



Asmussen said.

Guest Suite raced in ninth place around the first turn and down the backstretch, farther from the lead than he had been winning the Lecomte.

"He was a little further back than he wanted to be," said trainer Neil Howard, who said it was likely Guest Suite would return for the Louisiana Derby. "It was a good race, though; a tough race. You're not going to win every one of these things along the way."

Farrell won the Silverbulletday Stakes last month at Fair Grounds in decidedly ho-hum fashion, but she looked much more like a real Kentucky Oaks contender on Feb. 25 when capturing the Grade 2, \$200,000 Rachel Alexandra Stakes at Fair Grounds by 3 1/2 lengths over Majestic Quality.

Farrell went straight to the front from post 2 under Channing Hill and set a solid pace, going 23.92 seconds for the first quarter-mile and racing unopposed through a half-mile in 47.32. Her pursuers, Valadorna in particular, closed in a quarter-mile out, but Hill and his filly were sandbagging, drawing clear again by midstretch and winning comfortably. Farrell jumped marks on the track left by the starting gate and got onto her wrong lead in the final yards, making her finish look more awkward than it was.

"She galloped out really well, too," Hill said.

For New Orleans native Wayne Catalano, who trains Farrell for the Coffeepot Stables, Farrell's performance lifted some weight from his shoulders. Farrell is the only horse who has won here from Catalano's Fair Grounds string, and last Monday at Oaklawn, his favorite in the Southwest Stakes, Uncontested, turned in a disappointing effort.

But Catalano was confident Farrell would run better this time than she had last month making her 3-year-old debut. Catalano thought Farrell had struggled over a muddy, sealed surface in the Silverbulletday and would prefer a fast track, and indeed, Farrell traveled more comfortably the entire trip.

"I thought she would make the lead," Catalano said. "If someone else wanted it, I told Channing it was fine to lay second. I just didn't want her getting caught between horses."

Farrell ran 1 1/16 miles in a good 1:44.09 and paid \$9.60 to win. Majestic Quality, who shipped from California for trainer Keith Desormeaux, still is a maiden after eight starts, but earned a graded stakes placing and edged favored Valadorna for second in the final strides.

"I thought we were going to be third," said jockey Kent Desormeaux. "She has a big heart."

Valadorna broke sharply and showed more positional speed than she had in a first-level allowance win here last month that started her season. She loomed behind the leader at the quarter pole but failed to sustain her run.

"I had a good feeling turning for home, but she just couldn't go on with it," said trainer Mark Casse. "She flattened out on us a little late."

Wicked Lick was fourth, Shane's Girlfriend fifth, Untapped sixth, and Gris Gris seventh. Shane's Girlfriend, another California shipper who was the strong second choice, failed to show her customary speed and never really got involved in the running.

Kentucky Oaks qualifying points were awarded 50-20-10-5 to the race's first four finishers. Farrell, by Malibu Moon, won the Golden Rod before taking the Silverbulletday, and now has 70 Oaks points. She obviously will get into the Oaks, but now Catalano must determine the best way to get her there. He said the Fair Grounds Oaks would be considered, but stopped short of committing his filly to the race.

"We'll sit down and talk about it, but first



of all we'll let her tell us," he said.

Valadorna, meanwhile, is likely to skip the Fair Grounds Oaks and make her next start in the Ashland Stakes at Keeneland, Casse said. "She did so well when she was at Keeneland last year," he said.

Trainer Mike Maker seems to have a bottomless supply of turf stakes horses. On Feb. 25, it was Enterprising's turn to step forward as he won the Grade 3, \$125,000 Fair Grounds Handicap by three-quarters of a length over the Maker-trained favorite, Oscar Nominated.

One Mean Man was third and was followed by Bullard's Alley, Granny's Kitten (another Maker horse), Golden Soul, and Blame Angel. Maker scratched Greengrassofyoming from the race, and Western Reserve, who might have been favored, also was withdrawn Saturday.

Enterprising was bred by Glen Hill Farm and campaigned by that operation and trainer Tom Proctor through last July, when he was purchased by the Maxis Stable and turned over to Maker, who settled him into his south Florida string. Enterprising, who had bounced among high-end claimers, allowance races, and stakes for his original connections, won a \$100,000 stakes in November at Gulfstream Park West and was beaten a neck Jan. 21 in the Sunshine Millions Turf, his previous start.

The Fair Grounds Handicap had a Grade 3 in front of it, but with the two scratches the race lacked depth for the class level, and in the end, all Enterprising had to do was outrun Oscar Nominated.

Oscar Nominated and Florent Geroux made the lead, and after a decent opening quarter-mile in 23.98 seconds really slowed the pace on the backstretch, going a half-mile on a fast-playing course in a 49.83. Julien Leparoux settled Enterprising in second, never falling more than a length or so behind the leader before playing his hand at the top of the stretch. Oscar Nominated, coming off a second-place finish

in the 1 1/2-mile John Connally at Sam Houston, might have been caught slightly flat-footed as Enterprising let fly a superior turn of foot to take a half-length lead to the stretch call, and with Enterprising laying down an 11.44-second closing furlong, Oscar Nominated could never get back on terms.

Enterprising, who carried 118 pounds, two fewer than Oscar Nominated, stopped the timer in 1:48.80 for 1 1/8 miles on a firm course. He paid \$8 to win.

With 45 winners during 2016, including eight stakes races, Brendan Walsh's fifth full year training was his best yet. Two months into this year, and 2017 is looking at least as good. On Feb. 25, Walsh sent out Honorable Duty to beat International Star by a half-length to win the Grade 3, \$125,000 Mineshaft Handicap at Fair Grounds.

Julien Leparoux, in from Florida, rode the winner for Walsh and David Ross's DARR's Inc. Dazzling Gem finished a nose behind International Star in third, and was followed by Eagle, December Seven, Mo Tom, and Rise Up. The four starting high weights at 118 pounds swept the top placings. Honorable Duty ran 1 1/16 miles on a fast track in 1:43.03 and paid \$12.40 to win.

Honorable Duty, a 5-year-old gelding by Distorted Humor, won for the fifth time in 10 career starts, but on fast dirt tracks he has four wins from five races. Honorable Duty was bred by Juddmonte Farms and started his career for Juddmonte in 2015 racing on turf in the Bill Mott barn. He was sold after three starts, and really turned a corner after being gelded last fall, according to his trainer.

"He's always had a ton of talent, and I think he's just starting to put it all together," said Walsh.

Honorable Duty won the Tenacious Stakes here in December but missed the Louisiana Stakes last month after a slight hiccup.

"He had a few days where he wasn't eating well, and we just weren't happy with him. It's a long year," Walsh said.

Rise Up was sent from post 1 and made a clear lead, going his first quarter-mile

in 23.69 seconds and then flying down the backstretch through a second quarter-mile in 23.10. The half-mile was a fast 46.79, and Rise Up was bound to stop at some point, but December Seven and Dazzling Gem rushed early to attack the leader before the three-furlong pole as Honorable Duty and Leparoux ranged up just behind them and on the outside. Honorable Duty made the lead the top of the homestretch, briefly looking like he would draw off, but Dazzling Gem battled on as International Star, who appeared to be going nowhere much of the race, launched a bid.

"I didn't think I was going to get anything, and then all of a sudden he just took off," said Miguel Mena, International Star's jockey.

International Star split Dazzling Gem and Honorable Duty and lunged for the wire, but his rally fell short, and the winner might have been idling in any case.

"It's the first time he's been left alone near the end of a race," Walsh said.

Eagle, who was last early, made a bid into the homestretch but flattened out late making his first start since July.

"He was a little rusty today," said jockey Brian Hernandez Jr.

Mo Tom loomed up at the quarter pole in his 4-year-old debut, but his run soon waned and he beat only Rise Up.

"I think he got tired," jockey Florent Geroux said.

Unified put his abundant speed on display again on Feb. 25, taking control of the \$100,000 Gulfstream Park Sprint from the outset and never looking back to post a neck victory over the odds-on Mind Your Biscuits for his third graded stakes win in just five career starts.

Making his first start since finishing far back in the Grade 3 Pegasus eight months earlier at Monmouth Park, Unified broke alertly from his inside post and was quickly urged clear by jockey Jose Ortiz Jr. Unified rated kindly on the front end, setting opening splits of 22.37 seconds and 44.71 while stalked by Early Entry. Unified shook well clear when roused at the top of the stretch, then was able to hold safe the belated bid



from Mind Your Biscuits despite never switching off his left lead.

Mind Your Biscuits, racing for the first time since capturing the Grade 1 Malibu in his 3-year-old finale, was reserved well off the early leader in the run down the backstretch. He advanced five wide while still in hand turning for home, before finishing willingly once finally set down near the three-sixteenths pole, only to fall just short with his final surge. Squadron A rallied from last to finish third without menacing the top two.

Unified, a son of <u>Candy Ride</u>, won the Grade 3 Bay Shore and Grade 2 Peter Pan during the spring 2016 campaign, after having broken his maiden in sensational fashion making his career debut here last winter.

Owned by Centennial Farms and trained by Jimmy Jerkens, Unified completed 6 1/2 furlongs in 1:15.30 and paid \$6.60.

"He's a fast horse, he proved that last year, and he trained really super the last three weeks," Jerkens said. "He didn't really like breaking from the [post position] 1, but when you're fresh like this and come popping out of there, you end up being the best speed. I know he's not going to like someone crossing over in front of him, throwing dirt in his face, so I said [to Ortiz)] as long as he breaks, go on with it."

Jerkens said he was not concerned by the fact Unified remained on his left lead through the stretch.

"He's a little stubborn about it in the morning, but sometimes you can get horses

too riled up and rank if you worry about it too much," Jerkens said. "Jose said he didn't make a big deal of it because he was running, and free-running horses, you've got to leave them alone."

Jerkens said he really didn't have anything picked out for Unified's next start, but said the Met Mile could be a goal down the road.

Mind Your Biscuits trainer Chad Summers was gracious in defeat.

"Unified is a really nice horse," Summers said. "Let's take nothing away from him. He got away on an early lead and ran a great race. But I thought our horse also ran great. Like I've said, our end goal is Dubai [Golden Shaheen] a month from today."
