Trainer Todd Pletcher's strong hand on the road to the 2017 Kentucky Derby suddenly got a lot stronger on April 1 at Gulfstream Park after Always Dreaming powered to a convincing five-length victory over State of Honor in the Grade 1, \$1 million Florida Derby. Gunnevera, the even-money favorite in a field of 10 3-year-olds coming off his convincing win in the Grade 2 Fountain of Youth here four weeks earlier, finished third after dropping well back during the early stages of the race.

Always Dreaming's final time of 1:47.47 was the fastest in the Florida Derby since Alydar completed 1 1/8 miles in 1:47.00 in 1978. The victory was the fourth in the Florida Derby for both Pletcher and John Velazquez, the most for either a trainer or



jockey in the storied history of the event.

Pletcher entered the day with three horses – Tapwrit, Malagacy, and Battalion Runner – amongst the top 12 on Daily Racing Form's Derby Watch list. He exited with two more probable Kentucky Derby starters, both Always Dreaming and Patch, who finished second just 30 minutes earlier in the Grade 2 Louisiana Derby. Pletcher had also entered Battalion Runner in the Florida Derby as an insurance policy should Always Dreaming not be able to start but scratched him, as expected, on Saturday morning to run next in either the Wood or Arkansas Derby.

Always Dreaming, a son of Bodemeister, has been a work in progress since joining Pletcher's stable for his 3-year-old campaign. Winless in two starts at 2, Always Dreaming went to Tampa Bay Downs to win his maiden by 11 1/2 lengths on Jan. 25, after which Pletcher opted to bypass the Fountain of Youth to send out Always Dreaming to beat a weak entry-

level allowance field going nine furlongs here on March 4. And Pletcher was supremely confident his relatively inexperienced colt would turn in a big effort in his stakes debut following a pair of extremely impressive works at Palm Beach Downs subsequent to that outing.

Always Dreaming steadied briefly into the clubhouse turn and was a bit keen early while put in perfect striking position by Velazquez to stalk the pace of Three Rules, who set fractions of 23.28 seconds, 47.08, and 1:10.75 for the opening six furlongs. Always Dreaming engaged the leader turning into the stretch, edged clear nearing the furlong marker, and then steadily increased his advantage under strong handling before galloping out with excellent energy into the clubhouse turn.

State of Honor, racing with blinkers off following his second- and third-place finishes in the Sam F. Davis and Tampa Bay Derby, respectively, was taken back off Three Rules and got very rank under

jockey Julien Leparoux around the clubhouse turn and entering the backstretch. He settled into a bit better rhythm while still under a hold for the next half-mile, found room inside the tiring Three Rules when asked for his run near midstretch and proved second-best while never threatening the winner.

Gunnevera broke slowest after ducking out a bit leaving the gate and was immediately angled over to the rail by jockey Javier Castellano to race at the rear of the 10-horse field. Gunnevera lagged a dozen lengths behind the leader for more than six furlongs, commenced a rally while wide around the second bend, making up some ground down the center of the course without ever menacing the top two.

Impressive Edge was forwardly placed outside horses into the stretch but failed to respond to heavy urging through the final quarter, finishing a tiring fourth in his two-turn debut.

Always Dreaming is owned in partner-



ship by St. Elias, Teresa Viola Racing Stables, Brooklyn Boyz Stables, West Point Thoroughbreds, and Siena Farm. A \$350,000 yearling purchase at Keeneland September 2015, he went off the second choice in the wagering and paid \$7.40.

"We talked a lot about the next step after he broke his maiden at Tampa and thought the correct move was to try the allowance race on Fountain of Youth Day, even though we felt the Fountain of Youth was a race he fit in," Pletcher said. "We felt he needed a little more foundation, a little more education. Unfortunately, the way that race unfolded, he found himself on the lead. Johnny just waited and asked him to finish up the last eighth of a mile, and to be honest, we didn't learn a whole lot that day."

Pletcher said Always Dreaming came out of that race exceptionally well, trained as well as any horse he had at Palm Beach Downs this winter, and after his performance in the Florida Derby still believes his horse has ample room for improvement.

"I loved the way he finished the race, galloped out and came back to the winner's circle pretty composed and not blowing too hard," Pletcher said. "So I do think there is room for improvement."

Trainer Antonio Sano took Gunnevera's setback in stride and said his horse will definitely move forward to the Kentucky Derby.

"Javier [Castellano] told me the post position was a little problem, that the horse wasn't comfortable from the beginning," Sano said. "I'm happy. He finished strong. This is an important race to win, but it was a good race to set him up for the next one."

Brian Hernandez Jr. stood off to the side of a crowded winner's circle, cradling a giant, glass trophy. It was minutes after the Grade 2, \$1 million Louisiana Derby had been run, and, as last month in the Grade 2 Risen Star here at Fair Grounds, it was Hernandez and Girvin who had won it, continuing a terrific run of success this Kentucky Derby season for the jockey.

Part of being a jockey is maintaining your cool when others lose theirs, and in a chaotic winner's circle, the thoughtful rider pondered his good fortune this spring: He has been riding Girvin. He also

has been riding McCraken, currently the ante-post favorite for the Kentucky Derby on May 6. Girvin's prep season is over, McCraken still has to run in the Blue Grass Stakes.

Now that the Road to the Derby season had finished here in the Crescent City, it was time to head, literally and figuratively, to Kentucky. Hernandez was going to be in a car all night heading to Lexington to work McCraken the following morning. He certainly was looking forward; he might have to pick between two top Derby horses. But he also wanted to cherish what has transpired so far.

"Right now we're just going to enjoy this and worry about everything else tomorrow," Hernandez said.

"This is the reason you get up at 5 in the morning, to ride two of the best Kentucky Derby contenders. It's a great situation to be in."

Girvin did his part in the Louisiana Derby. He rallied from midpack to prevail by 1 1/4 lengths over Patch. Local Hero was another 1 3/4 lengths back in third, and nosed out Hollywood Handsome. Sorry Erik was fifth and was followed, in order, by Senior Investment, Guest Suite, Hotfoot, and Monaco.

Over a fast main track, Girvin covered 1 1/8 miles in 1:49.77. He earned \$600,000 to bring his career earnings to \$874,400 for owner Brad Grady, who acquired the Tale of Ekati colt as a yearling for \$130,000.

Girvin (\$4.60) was favored off his win in the Risen Star in March. He had to work harder this time, but the result was the same. He has now won three times in four starts, is unbeaten on dirt, is unbeaten going two turns on dirt. Not that he needed the points, but he got 100 for this win on top of the 50 he earned in the Risen Star, putting him atop the points list for the Derby.

His trainer, Joe Sharp, was so overcome with emotion in the aftermath of the race – crediting his wife, the former jockey Rosie Napravnik, and Grady – that he lost his voice. But he answered questions as gamely as Girvin was in the stretch.

"It doesn't feel bad," he said of having his first Kentucky Derby starter. Sharp said Napravnik, with whom he has two young sons and who gallops horses for him every morning, "has been a big part" of his success.

Girvin is "the best horse I've had," Sharp said.

Girvin has made just four starts, but he's come a long ways since his debut win here Dec. 16. His wins in the Risen Star and



Louisiana Derby emulated Gun Runner last year. Gun Runner went on to finish third in the Kentucky Derby.

In the Louisiana Derby, Girvin settled into fifth place early as the longshot Hotfoot, also owned by Grady and trained by Sharp, set a quick pace that Sharp wanted to give Girvin his best chance.

Hotfoot went along through fractions of 23.46 seconds for the opening quarter and 47 seconds for a half-mile. Monaco was second, with Local Hero, who has excellent natural speed, rated in third, a tactic that put him in an ideal striking position.

Local Hero surged to the front after six furlongs in 1:11.15, but Girvin was hot on his heels, and by the furlong pole Girvin had reeled in Local Hero. Patch rallied up the rail, but he was not a serious threat to Girvin in the late going.

"He's such a talented horse. He puts a lot of confidence in me," Hernandez said. "He put me in a good spot. When I saw that Local Hero settled better than he did last time, I gave myself a target."

Hernandez said Girvin switched leads late, calling it "messing around."

"He ran his race, perfect trip," Hernandez said. "I called on him, and he ran on."

Tyler Gaffalione, who rode Patch, thought his colt performed well considering it was only his third start, first in a stakes, and first around two turns.

"I think the horse will improve major off this race," Gaffalione said. "He got behind another horse in the stretch and didn't want to run into the dirt, but when I cut to the inside he cut."

Florent Geroux, who rode Local Hero, said he had "no excuse," that Local Hero relaxed but could not stave off the top two.

"Steve," he said, referring to trainer Steve Asmussen, "and his team did a good job. Last time he was pretty aggressive."

When the field reached the far turn, "I thought I was going to win," Geroux said.

But Local Hero couldn't stay the trip. Hernandez, by contrast, has been driving with a full tank.

Tasked with running down a loose leader on a racing surface that had been carrying speed, the response from Honorable Duty came with no hesitation: "Aye-aye, sir!"

The only horse closing from off the pace in the Grade 2, \$400,000 New Orleans Handicap was closing just well enough, as Honorable Duty caught a game pacesetting Breaking Lucky in the final yards to win by a neck. It was another five lengths back to Iron Fist in third, as favored Noble Bird could do nothing with a perfect trip.

"When I squeezed on him to go, down the lane he laid his neck down and he's jumping from here to the end of the paddock," said James Graham, who won his second New Orleans Handicap in three years, having captured the 2015 edition with Call Me George.

Honorable Duty, a 5-year-old gelding by Distorted Humor out of the A.P. Indy mare Mesmeric, was bred and first campaigned by Juddmonte Farms, which sold him in 2015 after three modest starts. He was purchased by David Ross's DARRs Inc. and turned over to trainer Brendan Walsh, who, after six starts and some progress, decided last fall that Honorable Duty needed to be gelded. The horse was acting up badly at times and wasn't focused on racing.

"We decided we had to do this or he wasn't going to be anything," Walsh said.

Honorable Duty won the Tenacious Stakes here in January in his first start as a gelding, had to miss the Louisiana Stakes in January with a minor issue, and won the Grade 3 Mineshaft here last month by a half-length. All good performances, but Honorable Duty hit his peak April 1.

Breaking Lucky had the rail, and Luis Contreras, having watched speed holding very well on the main track in the day's first dirt races, sent his horse to the lead.

"I see all the races today were speed," Contreras said. "He broke good, and I gave him a little more chance to get in front of horses, and once I was on the lead he settled easy and relaxed for me the whole way, even with a horse pressuring me to the outside."

That horse was Iron Fist, and the pair zoomed through a half-mile in a testing 46.63 seconds and six furlongs in 1:10.35. Honorable Duty was fifth early but far, far behind the lead pack of three, and the gap still was wide three furlongs out. Honorable Duty had closed some ground at the quarter pole, but still had much work to do when Graham steered him to the outside three-sixteenths of a mile from the finish. Breaking Lucky remained clear to the sixteenth pole, even changing back to



his proper lead, but Honorable Duty was relentless and got up by a neck.

"The last sixteenth of a mile he was really digging in," Contreras said. "It's just too bad he got me."

Honorable Duty has six wins from 12 starts and is perfect since being gelded. He was timed in 1:48.35 for $1\,1/8$ miles on a fast track and paid \$18.80.

Walsh said the logical spot for his next start is the Alysheba Stakes in May at Churchill Downs.

"He had to run to get that horse; he sprinted all the way to the wire," Graham said. "He's getting better, too. I think he's going to be a nicer horse in the summer and even in a fall campaign."

At Churchill Downs in the Kentucky Oaks, one presumes, Farrell will find some competition. Here at Fair Grounds this winter and spring, little has stood in her way.

In January, Farrell won the Silverbulletday Stakes by 2 3/4 lengths. In February, she captured the Rachel Alexandra by 3 1/2 lengths. And on April 1, it was no contest in the Grade 2, \$400,000 Fair Grounds Oaks, in which Farrell was 3 1/4 lengths the best.

The margin might have been greater had Farrell had to, you know, really try.

Stalking three wide from third as Daria's Angel led Vexatious through fractions of 24.09 seconds for the quarter, 47.55 to the half, and 1:12.09 for six furlongs, Farrell and jockey Channing Hill swooped to the

lead before the quarter-pole with the greatest of ease.

Farrell had opened a three-length lead at the stretch call without really being asked, at which point she jumped tracks left on the surface by the starting gate (she did the same thing in the Rachel Alexandra) and goofed her way to the finish line.

"She almost kind of put me off a little bit, she settled so nice today," Hill said. "I was like, 'Please let me have a little horse'. Once I picked her up from the three-eighths pole, though, I knew it was over.

"This is a filly that when she gets by herself, she doesn't shut down completely, but she does idle. You hear all around that she can't finish – take it from me, I got a lot of horse left. I really think if she has a target she'll run it down, no problem."

Farrell ran one mile in 1:36.98 and stopped the timer in 1:43.67 for 1 1/16 miles on a fast track. She paid \$2.80 as the favorite. Wicked Lick ground her way to a second-place finish, a nose in front of Vexatious. Daria's Angel faded badly and was more than seven lengths farther back in fourth.

Brendan Walsh, Wicked Lick's trainer, said he thought his filly also would go on to the Kentucky Oaks. "The nice thing with her is she's so consistent," Walsh said.

Farrell, a homebred, is trained by Wayne Catalano for the Coffeepot Stables of Bob Cummings and Annette Bacola. The filly is by Malibu Moon and out of the Unbridled's Song mare Rebridled Dreams, making her a sister to the Grade 1 winner Carpe Diem. Catalano was talking Farrell up as early as last August, and Farrell ended her 2-year-old season by winning the Grade 2 Golden Rod at Churchill by six lengths.

Farrell is looking stronger than ever. She has gained weight through her Fair Grounds campaign, and has grown more comfortable with the mental aspect of being a racehorse.

"Calming her down was a big thing," Catalano said. "She was a very hyper filly. She's come around a long ways."

Catalano will shift his Fair Ground string north in coming days. Farrell could either fly or travel by van, but soon enough she will wind up back at Churchill Downs.

"It looks like she could be the favorite for the Oaks. It's a great feeling to be going there," Catalano said.

Enterprising is 6 years old and has raced nearly 30 times, but his career may just be hitting its stride, for trainer Mike Maker has found his niche, and is exploiting it.

Maker theorized that Enterprising would be best served by races at 1 1/8 miles or farther, and Enterprising scored his second straight stakes win over that distance at Fair Grounds by taking the Grade 2, \$300,000 Mervin Muniz Handicap for older grass runners on April 1.

Enterprising (\$14.20), ridden by Tyler Gaffalione, charged up the rail and held off favored Kasaqui to win by a neck, with Kasaqui nosing out Oscar Nominated – also trained by Maker – for third.

Enterprising has won three of his last five starts, but this was the most significant of that trio. He won the Grade 3 Fair Grounds Handicap five weeks earlier.

"This validates that," said Maker, who trains Enterprising for the Maxis Stable of Sidney Karmia. "We'll try to keep him at longer distances. He's on top of his game."

Enterprising used his rail draw to get a sweet, ground-saving trip under Gaffalione. He benefited from an honest pace initially set by longshot Sky Flight, with One Mean Man and Roman Approval in closest pursuit.

"I had a perfect trip. Saved all the ground, and when we came into the stretch there was a good opening," Gaffalione said.

Enterprising was stretched to the limit, as Kasaqui came roaring down the center of the course with Oscar Nominated right there, too.

Enterprising completed about 1 1/8 miles on the firm turf course in 1:48.41. He has now won nine times in 29 starts, and the \$180,000 first prize increased his career earnings to more than \$770,000.

Maker said the Grade 1 Woodford Reserve Turf Classic at Churchill Downs on Kentucky Derby Day likely would be next for Enterprising.

Celestine won Gulfstream Park's Grade 2 Honey Fox Stakes for the second straight year and did so impressively on April 1, leading nearly every step of the way en route to a 1 1/4-length decision over Mississippi Delta in the one-mile turf fixture for older fillies and mares.

Celestine, who was purchased by Moyglare Stud Farm at the Keeneland November sale and turned over to trainer Christophe Clement for her 5-year-old campaign, launched the season with a two-length victory in the Sand Springs on March 4. Clement said he felt Celestine would be even better with that race under her belt.

With Jose Ortiz aboard, Celestine took control of the race approaching the first turn and was able to slow the pace, posting leisurely splits of 24.45 and 49.01 seconds for the opening quarter-mile and half-mile. Celestine repulsed bids from both Josdesanimaux and Linda entering the stretch, surged well clear, and was not seriously menaced thereafter.

Mississippi Delta took back off Celestine after showing in front following the break before rallying belatedly along the inside to prove second-best. Linda, making her first start since winning the Grade 2 Mrs. Revere on Nov. 25, took a run at the winner while three wide on the final bend but could not sustain her bid.

Celestine, a daughter of Scat Daddy, won for the eighth time in 16 starts and fifth in eight outings at Gulfstream Park. She completed the distance over a firm course in 1:35.19 and paid \$2.60.

"She was the best filly and he rode a great race." Clement said. "He slowed her down

after making the lead, and you're not going to beat that filly if she's the first one to dictate. I thought she was fitter today and had trained better going into this race than the last one."

Clement said he would follow the same path with Celestine as her former trainer, Bill Mott, took last year, pointing her for a repeat in the Grade 1 Just a Game on the Belmont Stakes undercard.

With an impressive four-wide move around the far turn, Salty went from maiden winner to Kentucky Oaks contender with an emphatic 4 1/4-length victory in the Grade 2, \$250,000 Gulfstream Park Oaks on April 1.

Making her first start against winners and first around two turns, Salty, under Joel Rosario, was second-to-last down the backstretch. She began moving at the six-furlong pole, made a four-wide bid for the lead at the five-sixteenths pole and kept on going through the lane to win going away as the even-money favorite.

Tequilita, the Grade 2 Forward Gal winner on Feb. 4, rallied for second, 1 1/2 lengths in front of Jordan's Henny.

The win was worth 100 qualifying points toward the Kentucky Oaks for Salty, a daughter of Quality Road. The \$1 million Oaks, on May 5 at Churchill Downs, is limited to 14 starters. Points may come into play after it was revealed this week the division-leading Unique Bella would miss the Oaks due to injury.

Owner Gary Barber purchased a majority interest in Salty following a second-place finish in the filly's debut here on Feb. 4. In her first start for trainer Mark Casse and Barber, Salty won a seven-furlong maiden race by $2\,1/2$ lengths.

Casse was confident that Salty would be able to get two turns in the Gulfstream Oaks. He just was a bit surprised to see Salty so far back in the early stages.

"We were back a little farther than I thought we would be," Casse said.

Rosario said he may have moved a little early, but said he was cognizant of the fact the Oaks ends at the first finish line.

"She broke nice, there was a good pace in front of her, I got her going in the middle



of the race because I'm always thinking about the first wire," Rosario said. "I felt very confident. I was in a good spot. It was time to get her up there. They were coming back to me at that point. When I got there, it looked like it was only her. She made a nice move."

Salty covered the 1 1/16 miles in 1:42.91 and returned \$4.

"I was a little nervous about it," Casse said. "Even afterward, Joel said, 'Maybe I moved a little early.' But she's extremely talented as everyone saw today. We're excited just to have her."

While Salty will move on to the Kentucky Oaks, a decision will be made later regarding Tequilita. Tequilita, ridden by Luis Saez, had a three-race winning streak snapped in the Gulfstream Oaks, her first try around two turns.

Trainer Michael Matz said that Saez told him Salty "went by him too fast" around the turn. "He said he wanted to wait a little longer to move," Matz added. "He said he didn't think there was a problem with distance."

Matz said he would wait a little while before making a decision regarding the Oaks with Tequilita, owned and bred by his wife, Dorothy.

Trainer Tom Albertrani thought Sadler's Joy would be his next graded stakes-winning turf marathoner, someday replacing the multiple graded stakes winner Twilight Eclipse.

He just didn't know that day would come as soon as it did.

Two weeks ago, Twilight Eclipse was moved from his barn by the owners, West Point Thoroughbreds, and transferred to Graham Motion. In 2013, when trained by Albertrani, Twilight Eclipse won the Pan American in a world record time of 2:22.63 for 1 1/2 miles.

On April 1, Albertrani was in the Gulfstream Park winner's circle again following the Grade 2, \$200,000 Pan American, as Sadler's Joy rallied down the center of the Gulfstream turf course to get up in the final jump to win by a head over Designed for War. It was a neck back to Patterson Cross in third.

"I always thought that this horse would

eventually replace Twilight when the day came but I didn't know it would happen the way it did," Albertrani said. "I always thought this horse would be my next big turf horse in the longer races."

Sadler's Joy reeled off three consecutive victories to end his 3-year-old season. He kicked off his 4-year-old season with head loss in the William McKnight Stakes on Jan. 28.

In the Pan American, the bob went Sadler's Joy's way as he rallied from nextto-last to nip a hard-luck Designed for War, who had taken the lead from Reporting Star midway on the far turn.

"He broke a little slower than I expected," Albertrani said. "I was hoping that he might be a little more forwardly placed but this horse has got a tremendous kick and he used it every step of the way just to get there."

Leparoux knew the Gulfstream Park course was rather speed favoring, and he wanted to be closer, but Sadler's Joy wasn't cooperative.

"He doesn't break very sharp. It's not like you don't want to put him closer, but he broke a little bit slow then after that he just cruised along and had a nice kick at the end," Leparoux said.

Sadler's Joy, a son of Kitten's Joy owned by Woodslane Farm, covered the 1 1/2 miles in 2:26.89 and returned \$9.40 to win.

Albertrani said Sadler's Joy would be pointed to the Grade 1 Man o' War at Belmont Park on May 13.

Javier Castellano has learned over time how All Included prefers to be ridden, and on April 1 he gave the 6-year-old the exact trip he wanted, rallying from last to win the Grade 2, \$200,000 Appleton Stakes by a half-length at Gulfstream Park.

Castellano kept All Included in reserve and in behind horses early, guided him five wide turning for home, and the pair outfinished Delta Prince to win by a half-length. It was another length back to Our Way in third.

The win was the fifth in 17 starts for All Included, and his first in a stakes race. He had previously been 0 for 9 in stakes.

Castellano felt he had made some mistakes on All Included in the past, having been more aggressive earlier in a race and trying to split horses. Saturday, he kept All Included in last as Siding Spring ran an opening half-mile in 46.29 seconds and six furlongs in 1:09.73 while being prompted by Diamond Bachelor.

Delta Prince, the half-brother to Royal Delta who was making his stakes debut, received a beautiful trip under Jose Ortiz and struck the front in midstretch.

All Included, owned by brothers Alain and Gerard Wertheimer, covered the mile in 1:33.12 and returned \$4.20 as the evenmoney favorite.

"He's a better horse if you take your time and make him go around horses," Castellano said. "He gives you a good kick the last part. I made a couple of mistakes in the past. I was too close to the pace, tried to split horses and be aggressive. He's the kind of horse, let him settle and find the best route for him."

Trainer Todd Pletcher said the trip went pretty much how he and Castellano mapped it out.

"We didn't necessarily want to be last, it was more about trying to save some ground on the first turn and try to give him plenty of time on the far turn," Pletcher said. "I said if you have to lose a little ground to get his momentum going, go ahead."

Pletcher said All Included would likely remain in Florida and point to the Grade 3 Miami Mile at Gulfstream on April 29.

Firm ground and a fast pace enabled Summersault to complete a perfect Gulf-stream Park winter meet as she outfinished odds-on favorite Olorda in the stretch to win the Grade 3, \$200,000 Orchid Stakes by three-quarters of a length on April 1.

Olorda, the 3-5 favorite who took over the lead in upper stretch, finished second by three lengths over Quiet Kitten. Temple Fur and the pace-setting Maquette completed the order of finish.

Summersault, a 5-year-old New York-bred daughter of Rock Hard Ten, won for the third time in as many tries this Gulf-stream meet; she is 6 for 22 overall. This was the first stakes victory for Summersault, owned by William Parsons Jr. and David Howe and trained by Mark Hennig.

Under Paco Lopez, Summersault was in the rear of the compact field as a rank Maquette, making her first start in the U.S., ran off to an open-length advantage through a quarter in 23.47 seconds, a halfmile in 46.12 and six furlongs in 1:10.54.

Midway down the backstretch, Summersault moved in tandem with Temple Fur into contention. Nearing the top of the stretch, Olorda took over from Maquette, but Summersault collared Olorda in midstretch and was able to outfinish her to the wire.

Summersault covered the 1 3/8 miles in 2:12.24 and returned \$20 as the longest shot in the five-horse field.

"When she can hear her feet rattle over it she does well," Hennig said. "She also likes to get down inside and get into trouble. I was a little concerned when the field spread out that much because sometimes when she finds daylight and is by herself a little bit she'll kind of lose focus. I thought Paco was good and patient with her, it looked like they were running on up front. Once he got up in behind them I got a lot more confident."

Grade 3 dirt marathons have become a steady source of success for Hard Aces.

Last July at Del Mar, Hard Aces won his first attempt at 1 1/2 miles on dirt in the Grade 3 Cougar II Handicap. On April 2 at Santa Anita, Hard Aces was back at the same distance, and won the Grade 3 Tokyo City Cup by a neck over 3-2 favorite Big John B.

Hard Aces (\$10) was within a length of the lead with a quarter-mile remaining and fought past Hi Happy for a narrow win over a determined Big John B. Ridden by Santiago Gonzalez, Hard Aces was timed in 2:31.99.

"He's a grinder," co-owner Kosta Hronis said. "He doesn't quit."

Gonzalez gave Hard Aces a patient ride in the field of six. The 7-year-old Hard Aces was four wide on the backstretch and three-wide on the turn while reaching contention in the stretch.

Big John B finished a nose in front of 2-1 Hi Happy, who was followed by Beach View, Infobedad, and Irish Surf.

Hard Aces was acquired privately by Pete and Kosta Hronis in early 2015 and transferred from Larry Jones to John Sadler. For his current owners and trainer, Hard Aces has won three stakes, including the Grade 1 Gold Cup at Santa Anita at 1 1/4 miles in June 2015.

Hard Aces has run in 21 consecutive graded stakes since being acquired. He was second in the Grade 1 Santa Anita Handicap in 2016, and second in the Grade 2 Las Vegas Marathon at 1 3/4 miles on dirt on the undercard of the first day of the Breeders' Cup races here last November.

The win in the \$100,345 Tokyo City Cup ended a six-race losing streak since the Cougar II Handicap. Hard Aces was sixth as a 22-1 outsider in the Grade 1 Santa Anita Handicap on March 11.

"He didn't get the trip we wanted in the Big Cap," Sadler said. "But he's been a wonderful horse for us."

Hard Aces has won 8 of 40 starts and earned \$1,147,990. Hard Aces will be considered for the Grade 2 Brooklyn Invitational, a \$400,000 race at 1 1/2 miles at Belmont Park on June 10.
