### Relief

That's the emotion that first rushed over trainer Mark Casse when champion Clas-

sic Empire crossed the wire first in the Grade 1, \$1 million Arkansas Derby on April 15 at Oaklawn.

Classic Empire and Casse had been through a range of developments this season, as the horse who closed out his 2-year-old season with a win in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile could manage just a distant third in his first start of the year in the Grade 2 Holy Bull at Gulfstream.

The battle back to the winner's circle included a fight with a foot abscess, and a back issue, plus an interrupted work schedule in the prime prep season for the Kentucky Derby. But those issues were erased in 1:48.93, the winning time of the Arkansas Derby that Classic Empire won by a half-length over Conquest Mo Money.

"Finally," Casse said. "It's relief, I guess, and maybe disbelief, that we were able to, after all the obstacles that were thrown our way, to achieve it. There's so many people that helped with this at our farm, every-



where. It's been tense."

But now, the Kentucky Derby is a reality for last year's 2-year-old champion male. Casse said Classic Empire will head next to Churchill Downs, where he will begin preparations for the Kentucky Derby.

"He doesn't have to do a whole lot," Casse said. "He'll probably have one breeze. If all goes well, the first Saturday in May."

Classic Empire (\$5.80) broke with the field in the Arkansas Derby and settled off the pace of Grandpa's Dream and Conquest Mo Money, who raced through an opening quarter in 22.75 seconds and an opening half-mile in 46.92. Conquest Mo Money continued on in front through six furlongs in 1:11.16, as Classic Empire advanced under regular rider Julien Leparoux, while traveling wide around the final turn and into the stretch. He then put in a diligent rally to catch Conquest Mo Money.

"He was an entirely different horse from when he ran bad down at Gulfstream," Casse said of the Holy Bull. "Julien said

he walked right into the gate. He was good. And he said down the backside - at Gulfstream he was never into the race - that he was pulling him. He was wanting to do something. He was hoping he would find somewhere to go."

Casse said in the days following the Holy Bull, the horse was found to have a right front foot abscess that did not reveal itself for days after the race.

"He had some legitimate excuses," Casse said. "I mean, his foot abscess was very bad, and maybe getting off that foot he hurt his back."

The back healed, the foot has returned to health, and Classic Empire is back in the game for owner John Oxley. The horse earned \$600,000 for his win in the Arkansas Derby, as well as 100 eligibility points for the Kentucky Derby.

The race also offered points to the second-, third- and fourth-place finishers - Conquest Mo Money, Lookin At Lee, and Sonneteer – on a scale of 40-20-10.

Classic Empire, who was the favorite, is a son of Pioneeerof the Nile, sire of Triple Crown winner American Pharoah.

The champion Stellar Wind started her 5-year-old season in stirring fashion on April 14, taking the Grade 1, \$600,000 Apple Blossom Handicap at Oaklawn after working past stubborn pacesetter Terra Promessa. Stellar Wind won by 1 1/4 lengths over that one, and it was another 3 1/4 lengths back to Streamline in third.

Stellar Wind (\$2.80) settled along the rail in third in the Apple Blossom as Terra Promessa jumped out to the lead and was clear through fractions of 23.88 seconds for the opening quarter, 48.22 for the halfmile, and 1:12.59 for six furlongs. Stellar Wind went after the leader into the final turn, was angled out by jockey Victor Espinoza, and moved past that rival near the sixteenth pole. She went on to cover the distance on a fast track in 1:42.75.

"I think she's better than before," said Espinoza, who rode for trainer John Sadler. "As she's gotten older, she's more mature, more professional. But it seems like this year, she's coming back great, and maybe even a little better than last year."

Stellar Wind was making her first start since the Breeders' Cup Distaff at Santa Anita in November, when she finished fourth behind the now-retired champion Beholder. Stellar Wind was freshened following the start, said Sadler, and was intended to launch her season at home in the Santa Margarita on March 18 at Santa Anita. However, high levels of rain in January and February pushed back her schedule, and she targeted the Apple Blossom.

"I thought I had her good and prepped for this race," Sadler said. "I knew I had to do more than the previous year because of shipping and running on a new surface."

Stellar Wind gave Sadler his second Grade 1 win at Oaklawn. He won the Arkansas Derby in 2010 with Line of David.

Stellar Wind, who was the champion 3-year-old filly of 2015, earned \$360,000 for the victory, improving her totals to eight wins in 13 starts for earnings of \$1,813,200.

Stellar Wind is a daughter of Curlin owned by Hronis Racing.

Sadler said Stellar Wind probably will make her next start in the Grade 1, \$400,000 Beholder Mile on June 3 at Santa Anita.

"We'll get her back on the stakes circuit at Santa Anita, although we'll look at other stakes around the country," Sadler said.

Overcoming a spot of trouble in midstretch, Dickinson was up in the final strides to defeat the mighty Lady Eli in the Grade 1 Jenny Wiley at Keeneland, capping a surreal day for her connections.

The victory ended a 4-for-4 afternoon on April 15 for Godolphin Racing and



its primary trainer in the United States, Kiaran McLaughlin.

"We're going to enjoy this, for sure," said Jimmy Bell, president of the American division of Godolphin, the worldly powerhouse stable owned by Sheikh Mohammed al Maktoum. "These days don't come along very often."

Nor does Lady Eli go down to defeat very often. Sent away the 1-2 favorite in the field of eight fillies and mares in the Grade 1, \$350,000 Jenny Wiley, Lady Eli and jockey Irad Ortiz Jr. appeared to have the 1 1/16-mile turf race won with about 100 yards to go, having surged to the lead in midpack. But then Dickinson, always just a few lengths off the pace, launched a final rally after angling off the rail and away from traffic to prevail by a head.

Dickinson, a 5-year-old homebred mare by Medablia d'Oro, returned \$14.20 as second choice after finishing in 1:41.98 over a firm turf. Quidura was another 1 1/4 lengths back in third.

Amid warm and breezy weather, and before an ontrack throng of 30,782, Catch a Glimpse set the pace in the 29th Jenny Wiley, going in 23.74, 48.05, and 1:12.63 before the pack began to engulf her. Lady Eli swept to the lead inside the furlong pole, only to yield late to Dickinson.

Dickinson is "just a nice filly," said McLaughlin, whose four-win day equals the Keeneland record for most wins on a single card, also held by Todd Pletcher (2008) and Bill Mott (1995). "We had trouble and it still worked out. Just unbelievable to win four at Keeneland, especially ending on a Grade 1."

Dickinson began her career with eight starts on dirt, winning twice, before a move to the turf sparked dramatic improvement. She now has won 5 of 6 on grass, with victories in the Grade 3 Suwanee River at Gulfstream and the Grade 2 Hillsborough at Tampa Bay Downs directly preceding the Jenny Wiley. The \$210,000 winner's share lifts her bankroll to \$604,316 from 14 starts.

Dickinson could run next in the Grade 1 Just a Game on the June 10 Belmont Stakes undercard, said McLaughlin, whose earlier winners Saturday included Watershed in the Grade 3 Ben Ali.

For Lady Eli, it was just her third defeat in 10 career starts, all by narrow margins. The 5-year-old mare was making her first start since finishing second by a nose in the Breeders' Cup Filly and Mare Turf in November.

"It was a perfect trip," Ortiz said. "I just got beat."

"Hats off to the winner," said her trainer,

Chad Brown. "Both ran well, but we just got beat right on the wire just like we did in the Breeders' Cup. It's tough, but it was her first start of the year, so hopefully she will move forward off of it. We'll get her back to Belmont Park and then pick out a race up there. She is a neck and two noses from being undefeated. She is a great horse and I am really proud of her effort today."

American Patriot and jockey Javier Castellano win the Grade 1 Maker's 46 Mile at Keeneland by a neck April 14.

American Patriot, skillfully ridden by Javier Castellano under the white WinStar silks, was along in the desperate final yards to nail Heart to Heart in a hotly contested 29th running of the race.

"He finished tremendous," Castellano said after American Patriot completed the two-turn mile in 1:34.70 over a firm course. "It was a good setup, a lot of speed in the race."

American Patriot returned \$23 when coming off a Feb. 17 allowance victory over the Gulfstream Park turf. The 4-year-old WinStar homebred prevailed in what surely was the best lineup of turf milers assembled in North America since the BC Mile last November.

Heart to Heart and jockey Julien Leparoux tracked closely in splits of 23.25 and 47.18 seconds, then put away the frontrunning What a View approaching the quarter pole to quickly open up on his 10 rivals. Even with 100 yards to go, Heart to Heart, an eight-time graded-stakes winner, appeared destined for his first Grade 1 score, but American Patriot gobbled up ground late to win by a neck.

"He ran a great race," Leparoux said. "I wish he'd won a Grade 1 because he deserves it."

"You can't ask for any more than he gave us today," said Brian Lynch, who trains the 6-year-old Heart to Heart for Terry Hamilton.

Only a half-length separated the top four finishers. Heart to Heart, the 4-1 second choice, held second by a nose over 27-1 shot Conquest Panthera, with Ballagh Rocks (19-1) just another neck back in fourth. Bolo, the lukewarm 7-2 favorite in from Southern California, faded to ninth after stalking the pace.

As a notable aside, the victory was the



51st in a Keeneland stakes for trainer Todd Pletcher, making him the track's career leader over his former boss, D. Wayne Lukas.

American Patriot, a dark bay colt by War Front, now has won five of 11 career starts. His lone prior stakes triumph came last summer in the Grade 3 Kent at Delaware Park

"We always felt like he had a lot of potential," Pletcher said afterward by phone from Arkansas. "He was unlucky to not win a Grade 1 last year [the Secretariat at Arlington Park].

"He's trained exceptionally well all winter [at Palm Beach Downs in Florida]. He has run well at Keeneland before, so we knew he would like the turf course."

WinStar president Elliott Walden said the Grade 1 Woodford Reserve Turf Classic on May 6 at Churchill Downs on the Kentucky Derby undercard will be considered for the next start for American Patriot.

Asked whether the colt might be in a position to assume the mantle assumed late last year by Tourist, Walden exclaimed: "We hope so!"

Owner Randy Howg bought the horse Inside Straight in late spring 2016 to try and win the Manitoba Derby. He succeeded, too, but there was more to come – much more.

Hot on the heels of heavily favored Midnight Storm for much of the Grade 2, \$750,000 Oaklawn Handicap on April 15, Inside Straight came off the fence at the top of the stretch, came abreast Midnight Storm at the furlong grounds, and pushed past to win by two lengths.

Howg drove himself in his semi-trailer last summer to see Inside Straight earn the \$46,000 winner's share of the Manitoba Derby purse. Winner's share of the Oaklawn Handicap was a cool \$450,000.

Robertino Diodoro trains the winner, and Geovanni Franco's flawless ride gave him his first graded-stakes win. Inside Straight, off Midnight Storm's quick splits of 22.96, 46.99, and 1:10.60, ran 1 1/8 miles on a fast track in 1:48.40. The 9-year-old warrior Domain's Rap untangled himself from a spot of traffic at the top of the homestretch and was up by a neck over Midnight Storm to get second.

Then came Madefromlucky, Goats Town, Texas Chrome, and Cutacorner. The winner, who got an eight-pound break in the handicap weights (122-114) from Midnight Storm, paid \$41.40.

Inside Straight, a New York-bred 4-year-old gelding by Super Saver and out of the Southern Halo mare Dance Alexa, won two of his first nine starts before romping in a \$40,000 claimer last May at Belmont Park for trainer Todd Pletcher and WinStar Farm. It was after that race that Howg, who had been partners on a previous Manitoba Derby winner, purchased Inside Straight, who surely earned back his owner's investment several times over.

Midnight Storm, racing outside California for the first time since he finished seventh last May in the Turf Classic at Churchill Downs, made the lead under Mike Smith from post 3, but was pushed into a quick first quarter-mile by Cutacorner. The pace moderated somewhat down the backstretch, but Goats Town made a wide middle move to contend that forced Midnight Storm to keep working around the far turn. Having shrugged off that challenge, Midnight Storm quickly faced a fresh one from Inside Storm, who always seemed to be going the better of the pair once he tipped two wide to challenge.

"My horse broke very sharp. He was alert, feeling good, nice and relaxed," Franco said. "I just tried to follow [Midnight



Storm]. My horse was just full of run and full of strength today."

After his Manitoba Derby win, Inside Straight went into a slight form trough, but he ended his wide-ranging 2016 campaign with a good closing third in the \$200,000 Zia Park Derby. He ran three solid races this winter and spring at Oaklawn – and picked a perfect time to deliver the performance of his life.

Whitmore continued his ascent up the class ladder as a sprinter on April 15, dispatching of a strong field of one-turn specialists in the Grade 3, \$400,000 Count Fleet Sprint Handicap at Oaklawn. The race was the first graded stakes victory for the horse and his fourth consecutive win at one turn. Whitmore has never been beaten at a sprint distance, with a career one-turn record of 6 for 6.

"I think this is the best race he's ever run," said co-owner and winning trainer Ron Moquett. "I think he's figured out that he likes his job. I was telling my son, I think he's learning the craft of sprinting."

Whitmore (\$3) was content to settle off a pressured pace set by Chief Cicatriz, who put up fractions of 21.26 seconds for the opening quarter and 43.91 for the half-mile. Whitmore advanced on the turn, moved to the lead in the stretch, then separated himself from his rivals for a 3 3/4-length win over Apprehender.

"He's a really nice horse," said winning jockey Ricardo Santana Jr. "He was in the position I wanted, from the outside, out of trouble. Turning for home, [he showed] his class."

Whitmore covered six furlongs on a fast track in 1:08.35. It was his third win at the meet, a streak that started with an optional \$62,500 claiming sprint Jan. 15, and the third time he has won over the local strip in 1:08 and change. Whitmore's other win at the meet came in the \$125,000 Hot Springs on March 11.

Moquett said Whitmore will now ship to Churchill Downs. He said the horse will be considered for the Grade 2, \$500,000 Churchill Downs Stakes. The seveneighths race is part of the Kentucky Derby card May 6.

"We'll play with him and let him tell us what to do," Moquett said. "We're going to Churchill, so we'll look there, I would say, and then this summer we'll look on the East Coast."

Whitmore was part of the Kentucky Derby trail last year. He finished second in the Southwest and Rebel Stakes at Oaklawn before finishing 19th in the Kentucky Derby. Moquett said before the start of the Oaklawn season that the horse could focus on sprinting this year, in part because of a smart allowance sprint win in December at Aqueduct. Whitmore has not lost since that time, picking up his fourth straight victory.

Whitmore earned \$240,000 for his Count Fleet win, improving his record to six wins from 11 starts for earnings of \$877,000. Whitmore races for Southern Springs Stables, Bob LaPenta, and Head of Plains Partners, the latter of which bought out Harry Rosenblum prior to the Count Fleet, according to Moquett.

Whitmore is a 4-year-old gelding by Pleasantly Perfect.

Ever So Clever has run some of the best races of her career at Churchill Downs, and on April 14 she secured a spot in the starting gate for next month's Kentucky Oaks when she picked up 100 eligibility points for her 1 3/4-length win over Chanel's Legacy in the Grade 3, \$400,000 Fantasy at Oaklawn.

The Fantasy carried 170 eligibility points for the Kentucky Oaks, with Chanel's Legacy earning 40 for her runner-up finish. In addition, third-place finisher Vexatious picked up 20 and fourth-place finisher Torrent, 10.

Ever So Clever (\$33.60) won her career debut last July at Churchill, shuttling to a 7 1/4-length win in a maiden special weight sprint. She also ran second there in the Grade 2 Pocahontas in September and was third in the Grade 2 Golden Rod in November.

The Fantasy was the first stakes win of her career, and after breaking out of the 12 hole, she was guided to the rail by Luis Contreras and had just a few horses beat early as Chanel's Legacy moved to the lead and put up fractions of 23.37 seconds for the opening quarter, 47.03 for the half-mile, and 1:11.18 for six furlongs. Ever So Clever advanced down the backside between horses, began to roll around the final turn, entered the stretch six wide, and ran down the leader. She covered the 1 1/16 miles on a track rated fast in 1:43.40.

"She's a very nice filly," said Steve Asmussen, who trains the winner for Clearsky Farms. "Luis did a tremendous job from the 12 hole, saved all the ground on the first turn."

Asmussen was winning the Fantasy for the second straight year, following Terra Promessa's victory last year.

Ever So Clever earned \$240,000 for the win, which was her third from eight career starts. She has banked \$377,850. She is a daughter of Medaglia d'Oro and was bred in Kentucky by Clearsky Farms.

Watershed was part of a big day at Keeneland on April 15 for Godolphin Racing and trainer Kiaran McLaughlin.

The owner-trainer team won with all four of their starters on the card, including a 2 3/4-length triumph by Watershed in the



87th running of the Grade 3, \$200,000 Ben Ali.

Watershed rallied from midpack to win the 1 1/8-mile Ben Ali under Paco Lopez, giving Godolphin and McLaughlin yet another winner with a homebred. Their earlier winners were Tasteful in a maiden race, Zennor in a turf allowance, and Dickinson in the Grade 1 Jenny Wiley.

Watershed paid \$12.20 after finishing 1 1/8 miles in 1:50.92 over a fast track.

Watershed, a 5-year-old horse by Bernardini, maneuvered his way through rivals to be second at the top of the stretch, with only Bird Song to catch. He did so in quick order, surging away for his first stakes victory. In all, Watershed is 5 for 14, with the \$120,000 winner's share lifting his bankroll to \$402,550.

Eagle was up in the final jump to nail Bird Song by a nose for second, with Blofeld another neck back in fourth.

Although horses who rally from far back often are at a disadvantage on dirt, Senior Investment's closing style may have aided him in catching West Coast and No Dozing in a thrilling three-horse photo finish in the Grade 3, \$200,000 Lexington Stakes on April 15s at Keeneland.

With at least several rivals having difficult trips either by racing wide or getting jostled about during a congested running, Senior Investment found himself racing clear of traffic and saving ground for most of the race. That left him in a position to outkick No Dozing through the lane and catch midstretch leader West Coast by a head on the wire.

Senior Investment did manage the victory despite the Lexington being just 11/16 miles, a distance trainer Ken McPeek feels is less than his best, and with the short stretch that comes into play in 11/16-mile races at Keeneland, which begin and end at the sixteenth pole.

He finished like a horse who would appreciate the 11/4-mile distance of the Kentucky Derby, but barring a slew of defections, his Derby participation would be highly improbable with the race expected to overfill beyond the limit of 20 horses. He has 10 Kentucky Derby qualifying points, all earned in winning the Lexington, well below the customary threshold to gain entry when the race is oversubscribed.

"I think Churchill should add more points to this race immediately," McPeek quipped in the winner's circle.

The Lexington could more realistically serve as a prep for the Preakness or Belmont stakes, though McPeek didn't commit to either immediately following the Lexington.

The winner raced 1 1/16 miles on a fast track under Channing Hill in a slow 1:45.05, paying \$24.20. He notched his third victory and his first stakes win in eight starts for owner Fern Circle Stables.

Both runner-up West Coast and thirdplace No Dozing, the 9-5 favorite, ran gamely to just miss, with West Coast having to circle wide after breaking from the outside post in a field of 10 and No Dozing encountering traffic and getting steadied when a rank Souper Tapit impeded him into the first turn.

On paper, it wasn't supposed to be this lopsided. What was supposed to be a contentious renewal of the Appalachian Stakes turned into a one-filly parade April 13 at Keeneland when La Coronel glided home a 3 1/4-length winner in the Grade 3 turf race for 3-year-old fillies.

Kept close to the pace by jockey Florent Geroux, La Coronel took the lead near the furlong pole and sailed home. Doing so eased some of the disappointment owner John Oxley and trainer Mark Casse felt when the filly ran sixth as a lukewarm favorite last fall in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies Turf, with several of her Appalachian rivals finishing ahead of her.

"That's the trip we needed in the Breeders' Cup," Casse said.

La Coronel, a Kentucky-bred daughter of Colonel John, returned \$9.20 as second choice in the field of 11 after finishing a mile in 1:37.12 over firm turf.

The victory in the \$125,000 Appalachian was so impressive that Casse said he will consider running La Coronel back against males in the Grade 2 American Turf on the May 6 Kentucky Derby undercard at Churchill Downs.

La Coronel had finished second in her 3-year-old debut, the March 11 Florida Oaks at Tampa Bay Downs. Casse revealed after the Appalachian that the filly underwent minor surgery on both knees shortly after the Breeders' Cup.

"She's an amazing horse," he said.

Before a sun-splashed crowd of 10,981, La Coronel rated behind front-runners Like a Hurricane and Morticia through the opening six furlongs of the 29th Appalachian. Geroux had to wait several strides in the upper stretch before his mount had room between that pair, but as Like a Hurricane began to fade, La Coronel shot through, quickly putting the race away.

Morticia, a 34-1 shot, held second by a head over Proctor's Ledge, with Dream Dancing, another Casse trainee, finishing fourth.

New Money Honey, the 2-1 favorite making her first start since winning the BC Juvenile Turf Fillies last November at Santa Anita, was never a factor and finished sixth.

Casse said running La Coronel against boys would permit him to run Dream Dancing, also owned by Oxley, in the fillyonly Edgewood Stakes on May 5 at Churchill, thereby keeping them separated.

A month ago, Lord Simba was winless after three career starts. On April 15, he won his second consecutive race, and his stakes debut, in the Grade 3 Los Angeles Stakes at Santa Anita.

Ridden by Martin Garcia, Lord Simba (\$3) disputed the pace throughout the \$100,000 race and won by 2 1/4 lengths over Eastwood, who had not started in 22 months. Lord Simba ran six furlongs in 1:08.74.

Trained by Bob Baffert, Lord Simba was nominated to the Los Angeles Stakes after an eight-length maiden win at six furlongs on March 19. "When you win a maiden race by [eight] lengths, you have something special," Baffert said. "I knew the race was light. The way he was training, he was training well, and it looked like the right chance."

The race drew a field of five that was reduced to four after the withdrawal of Ike Walker earlier in the day.

Lord Simba broke well and was always within a half-length of early leader Kentuckian, who set fractions of 21.86 seconds for the opening quarter-mile and 44.73 for a half-mile. Lord Simba took the lead in early stretch and led by a length with a furlong remaining.

"I could tell Martin was confident the whole way," Baffert said.

Lord Simba pulled away in the final furlong to easily beat Eastwood, who was fourth in the Grade 2 True North at Belmont Park in June 2015 in his preceding start. Eastwood joined trainer Richard Mandella's stable last year but did not have his California debut until the Los Angeles.

Grazen Sky finished third, followed by Kentuckian.

Lord Simba races for Susan Chu's Baoma Corp. and has won 2 of 5 starts and earned \$121,200. A 4-year-old colt by Discreet Cat, Lord Simba was purchased for \$300,000 as a 2-year-old in training.
