It helps to be lucky – but it doesn't hurt to be good, either.

Trainer Rusty Arnold readily acknowledged April 28 after Quiet Business won the final stakes of the Keeneland spring meet, the Grade 3 Bewitch, that fate played a role in victory.

"It was one of those lucky things," Arnold said.

Quiet Business, at 16-1 the longest shot in a cast of five fillies and mares, got a perfectly timed ride from Brian Hernandez Jr. in putting forth the best effort of her career in collaring Daring Duchess for

a one-length victory in the 1 1/2-mile turf race.

Arnold explained that after a second-level allowance failed to fill earlier in the week for Quiet Business, a 4-year-old Calumet Farm homebred, he was asked by the Keeneland racing office to supplement the filly to the \$150,000 Bewitch, which was shaping up with a short lineup for its 56th running.

"We did, and this is what happened," Arnold said. "And we're really happy about it."

Quiet Business settled in the back early in the race as Daring Duchess loped along in splits of 25.64, 50.16, and 1:15.10. Earring, the 4-5 favorite, was always in attendance while closely tracking Daring Duchess, but she was out of gas at the quarter-pole. As the field wheeled home, Daring Duchess found herself on an open lead under Julien Leparoux – but then here came Quiet Business to run her down in 2:31.50 over the

firm course.

Dyna's Recoleta was along to be third, another 6 3/4 lengths back, and was followed in order by Inchargeoftime and Earring.

Quiet Business, a dark bay filly by Quiet American, has won 3 of 11 career starts. She returned \$34.20 to win.

"The thing was to get her into a nice rhythm and have her run the last three-eighths of a mile," Hernandez said. "It worked out for us."

Fittingly, Calumet was the owner of the race namesake, Bewitch, a star filly whose brilliant career ended in 1951. Located adjacent to the Keeneland property, Calumet has endured difficult times since its glory days, but has been enjoying a resurgence in recent times under the direction of Brad Kelley, the reclusive southern Kentucky businessman who purchased the historic farm in 2012.

Many Roses and G.G. Ryder didn't make it easy for odds-on favorite Alert Bay in the Grade 3 San Francisco Mile at Golden Gate Fields on April 29, but the millionaire brought his 'A' game and scored a victory in the \$100,225 turf race.

Alert Bay's 1 1/4-length victory was accomplished with relative ease despite Many Roses's gallant effort on the lead and G.G. Ryder's strong effort, nipping Many Roses by a nose at the wire.

As expected, Many Roses took the lead, setting solid fractions of 23.81 seconds, 47.71, and 1:10.70. But he was never able to shake clear of Alert Bay, who sat just off him to his outside.

It was Plan 'A' for Alert Bay's connections of trainer Blaine Wright and jockey Juan Hernandez.

"I just wanted to see what G.G. Ryder was going to do," said Wright, whose star runner broke from the No. 6 post while Many Roses broke from post 4 and G.G. Ryder had the rail.

G.G. Ryder has flashed speed in the past, but when he didn't, Hernandez had Alert Bay sitting just behind Many Roses.

"It was the plan," said Hernandez. "If nobody would go with him [Many Roses], I had to stay right next to him."

Alert Bay (\$3.20) can stalk, but he doesn't mind sitting back a bit early. Wright, though, wasn't worried about having to put some pressure on Many Roses.

"I didn't think that horse could get away from us," he said. "Fractions on this course are usually 47 [seconds] so I knew he'd be right there."

Even though Many Roses quickened during the third quarter, Hernandez stuck right with him even without asking the 6-year-old gelding to run.

"He's a real nice horse," Hernandez said of Alert Bay. "He broke fast, and ran along without me doing anything. He was sitting behind the other horse, and when I asked him, he went by him."

Alert Bay was beginning to edge away at the eighth pole, but Many Roses dug in and even seemed to narrow the margin momentarily before Alert Bay began extending his lead.

G.G. Ryder was rallying inside and just did get his nose in front at the right time.

Star Student was fourth, another 5 3/4 lengths back. The victory was worth \$60,000 for Alert Bay, a son of City Zip, who has 12 career victories and \$1,228,555 in earnings for owner Peter Redekop.

Alert Bay was the first horse since Battle Dance in 1957-58 to win back-to-back runnings of the race. Native Diver was a two-time winner in the 1960s.

"When I read it hadn't been done in 59 years, I got nervous," said Wright. But once the gate opened, he said, "I felt pretty good the whole way."

Wright's 2017 goal for Alert Bay is to win the Longacres Mile at Emerald Downs.

War Correspondent returned to the winner's circle for the first time in more than two years after rallying to a one-length victory over the pacesetter Applicator in the Grade 3 Miami Mile at Gulf-

stream Park on April 29.

Only four horses contested the Miami Mile after Diamond Bachelor and likely favorite All Included were scratched, the latter due to a foot bruise.

War Correspondent, whose last victory came in the Grade 3 Appleton here in March 2015, briefly dueled Applicator for the lead into the first turn before being eased back off that rival by jockey Tyler Gaffalione.

War Correspondent bided his time for six furlongs while attending the leader, moved readily when asked to take control in early stretch before gradually edging clear at the end.

Applicator, the longest price on the board at 14-1, held on gamely along the inside to outlast the 11-year-old veteran Lubash by a nose to be second. Our Way rounded out the complete order of finish with only two lengths separating all four starters at the wire.

War Correspondent, a 7-year-old son of War Front, was placed third via disqualification in his previous start in the Grade 1 Gulfstream Park Turf Handicap.

Trained by Christophe Clement, War Correspondent completed the distance in 1:34.19 over a firm course and paid \$3.20 to win.

“My horse broke out there running and the other horse [Applicator] was intent on going, so we just sat off of him,” Gaffalione said. “He [War Correspondent] relaxed beautifully. When I asked him to run, he just exploded. He was just out there cruising and when I pushed the button, he was going.”

**Evo Campo and jockey Rafael Bejarano had been a perfect team in the last year.**

Last spring, Bejarano guided Evo Campo

to consecutive wins in an optional claimer and the minor Possibly Perfect Stakes, both on turf at Santa Anita. They were reunited in the Grade 3 Santa Barbara Stakes on April 30 and benefited from a perfect trip to win the \$101,035 race.

Evo Campo (\$8.60) stalked pacesetter Responsibleforlove for the first mile of the race at 1 1/2 miles on turf and won comfortably by 2 1/4 lengths.

Evo Campo was timed in 2:27.70.

“She had a good trip,” trainer Paddy Gallagher said. “She settled. Everything went her way, which doesn’t always happen.”

Responsibleforlove, a stakes winner in Italy last year, finished second, a nose in front of Estrechada, who was second in the Astra Stakes at 1 1/2 miles on turf in February.

Place des Vosges, the 9-5 favorite, finished fourth.

Evo Campo, a 5-year-old mare by Approve, races for David and Michael Day and Mary DiPietro. A maiden race winner in England in 2014, Evo Campo has won 6 of 13 starts and earned \$234,121. The Santa Barbara was her first graded stakes win.

The former Saratoga claimer Farhaan is a graded stakes winner in California.

On April 29 at Santa Anita, Farhaan won the Grade 3 Thunder Road Stakes at a mile on turf in an 8-1 upset. Ridden by Tyler Baze, his third win of the day, Farhaan closed from sixth to take the lead in the last sixteenth and win by three-quarters of a length over a game Perfectly Majestic.

Bolo, the 6-5 favorite, finished a quiet third in the \$100,690 race. Bolo led with a furlong remaining, but could not sustain the effort and was beaten two lengths.

Farhaan (\$18.80) was timed in 1:33.18. Last after the opening quarter-mile,

Farhaan was sixth midway through the race, about 4 1/2 lengths behind pacesetter Sawyer's Hill, who set a half-mile fraction of 46.61 seconds.

Through a wide rally in early stretch, Farhaan trailed by more than two lengths with a furlong remaining and closed well to reach the front.

"I had all the confidence in this horse," Baze said. "I thought we'd be closer to the front."

Trained by Phil D'Amato for Matthew Schera, Farhaan was claimed for \$40,000 at Saratoga last summer. An 8-year-old, Farhaan was unsuccessful in three graded stakes in New York and Maryland last fall before joining D'Amato's stable.

Farhaan was second to Prospect Park in an optional claimer at 1 1/8 miles on turf on March 9 in his California debut.

"First time, I got boxed in behind a good horse in Prospect Park," Baze said.

By Jazil, Farhaan has won 9 of 31 starts and \$482,929. The Thunder Road was Farhaan's first win in a graded stakes and the fourth stakes win of his career. He won the Lord of the Night Stakes at Aqueduct in 2013 and two stakes in 2014 – the Stymie Stakes at Aqueduct and the Alydar Stakes at Saratoga.
