Chad Brown grew up wanting to be a horse trainer; Seth Klarman always has been into finance. Both have reached the top of their professions by focusing more

on long-term profit than short-term gain, and their approach was rewarded gloriously on May 20 at Pimlico Race Course when the lightly raced Cloud Computing won the 142nd Preakness Stakes, a race in which Kentucky Derby winner Always Dreaming faded to eighth.

Brown, last year's Eclipse Award-winning trainer, never has won the Derby, so the temptation had to be strong to run both Practical Joke and Cloud Computing – both owned by Klarman and William Lawrence – both of whom had enough points to run in the Derby two weeks ago. But since Cloud Computing had only raced three times since his debut on Feb. 11, Brown thought it smarter to give Cloud Computing more time and await the Preakness. Practical Joke was their sole representative in the Derby, and he finished fifth.

Klarman, one of the world's most respected value investors whose success-

ful hedge fund, Baupost Group, has made him a billionaire, never has won the Derby, but he also never had won the Preakness, a race close to his heart, as he grew up only blocks from Pimlico. He agreed with Brown to run Practical Joke in the Derby and hold Cloud Computing for the Preakness.

The final piece of their winning team was jockey Javier Castellano, who was committed to Gunnevera for the Derby but jumped off that colt for the opportunity to ride Cloud Computing for the first time in the Preakness.

And then Cloud Computing stepped up, as they hoped. Though he was the least-experienced horse in the field, he ran like a seasoned veteran from the start. An alert beginning enabled Castellano to get an ideal stalking trip behind Always Dreaming and Classic Empire, who took it to Always Dreaming as soon as the gates opened.

Classic Empire got the best of that duel

and kicked clear in upper stretch, but Cloud Computing ran him down in the final furlong to win by a head before an announced crowd of 140,327. It was another 4 3/4 lengths back to Senior Investment, then came Lookin At Lee, Gunnevera, Multiplier, Conquest Mo Money, Always Dreaming, Hence, and Term of Art.

Cloud Computing, sent off at 13-1, paid \$28.80 to win. He covered 1 3/16 miles on a track rated fast in 1:55.98 and earned \$900,000 from a gross purse of \$1.5 million.

Bringing in a fresh horse, Brown said, was “part of our strategy.”

“Classic Empire and Always Dreaming are two outstanding horses, and our strategy was, if we are ever going to beat them, let’s take them on on two weeks’ rest when we have six, and it worked,” Brown said.

Always Dreaming and Classic Empire were two of five horses in this Preakness who had run in the Derby 14 days earlier. Classic Empire was fourth in the Derby after being mugged at the start, but he was

into the race immediately in the Preakness, going right with Always Dreaming.

Always Dreaming, the 6-5 favorite, led narrowly through fractions of 23.16 seconds for the quarter, 46.81 seconds for the half, and 1:11 for the first six furlongs, a sharp pace. Too sharp, it turned out, for Always Dreaming, who was starting to struggle under jockey John Velazquez on the final turn.

Classic Empire was sent along at that point by jockey Julien Leparoux, and when the field turned into the stretch after a mile in 1:36.63, it looked like last year’s champion 2-year-old male was headed for victory. But Cloud Computing angled out and made up a three-length deficit in the final furlong.

“He rode an excellent race,” Brown said of Castellano.

Classic Empire likely deserved a better fate, for he had to run hard every step of the way. His journey this spring has not been ideal, with interrupted training and

hoof and back injuries, but this was by far his best race since his victory in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile 28 weeks ago. His trainer, Mark Casse, said he thought Classic Empire might have lasted if Always Dreaming hadn't faded so soon.

"I thought if that horse had carried us a little bit further, we could have been all right," Casse said.

Always Dreaming, who had won four straight races, was returning on two weeks' rest for the first time in his career and could not handle that nor the early pressure from a top-class rival.

"When he hooked us and the horse didn't respond the way you'd want, I knew then we didn't have it today," said his trainer, Todd Pletcher.

"He showed in the Derby he's capable of handling pace pressure," said Pletcher, adding that "maybe the quick turnaround, maybe a different surface" were reasons for the subpar effort.

His defeat ends any hope of a Triple Crown bid in the Belmont Stakes in three weeks, and considering how Always Dreaming ran, and how Cloud Computing ran his best race with plenty of time between starts, it's quite likely that this Belmont will not have the Derby nor Preakness winner.

While this was the first win in a Triple Crown race of any kind for Brown, it was the second Preakness win for Castellano, whose only prior Preakness win, with Bernardini in 2006, also came with a horse who skipped the Derby.

Klarman had attended many a Preakness before, starting as a youth gambling from the infield. He plays at a different level now, and this win was satisfying not only because of the location but also because he turned 60 the day after the Preakness.

"I grew up three blocks from here," Klarman said. "I came to the Preakness many, many times."

"I'm so happy for him because he grew up in this town, Baltimore, and I know it's huge for him," Castellano said.

Cloud Computing, a son of Maclean's Music, was purchased for Klarman — who races as Klaravich Stables — and Lawrence as a yearling by Brown and bloodstock agent Mike Ryan for \$200,000, reflecting Klarman's value approach to acquiring horses, as he'd rather have 10 at that price that one at \$2 million. Cloud Computing was close to racing last summer at Saratoga before an ankle chip sidelined him for the rest of the year.

He did not make his first start until Feb. 11, when he defeated maidens going six furlongs at Aqueduct. He was immediately

stepped up to stakes company and finished second in the Grade 3 Gotham on March 4. He came back on April 8 in the Grade 2 Wood Memorial and finished third.

"We just ran out of time" to make the Derby, Brown said.

For the Preakness, though, time was on their side. Their investment paid off.

The heat broke and the rains came in the hour before the Grade 2 Black-Eyed Susan at Pimlico on May 19, turning the fast track sloppy. And when the 11-horse field hit the wire, Actress had gone from a maiden to a graded stakes winner.

Actress, a Tapit filly bred and owned by Gary and Mary West, came from far back in the 1 1/8-mile race for 3-year-old fillies. She saved ground early under jockey Nik Juarez and then began to advance nearing the far turn. Juarez checked her off heels nearing the stretch of the \$250,000 race and then took her to the outside. She took the lead nearing the furlong pole and then outbattled Lights of Medina to win by a head.

Trainer Jason Servis had run Actress twice at Gulfstream Park. In her March debut, she closed from far back to finish second of 11 fillies going six furlongs.

Servis stretched her out to seven furlongs and put her in against winners in the restricted Game Face Stakes in April, and she finished second to My Miss Tapit, who is trained by Todd Pletcher and is 2 for 2.

"She came running first time out but just didn't get there," Servis said. "I think this win flatters Pletcher's filly."

The Black-Eyed Susan was a big jump in class for Actress, and she was going a quarter-mile farther than in her prior start.

"I really didn't know who was coming, and it really didn't matter," Servis said. "I thought she deserved the chance."

Actress paid \$27.60 as the eighth betting choice. She was timed in 1:51.87.

Tapa Tapa Tapa set the early pace on a short lead inside Full House and then drew clear on the backstretch. Shimmering Aspen stalked the leaders from third, and Summer Luck also was forwardly placed.

Shimmering Aspen moved up on the far turn and took a short leading entering the stretch. Nearing the furlong pole, five fillies were fighting it out for the lead

across the track before the top pair separated themselves from the others.

Corporate Queen rallied from last to get up for third, two lengths behind Lights of Medina and 1 1/2 lengths clear of fourth-place Torrent, who made a determined move along the rail in midstretch.

Tapa Tapa Tapa, Shimmering Aspen, and Summer Luck finished sixth through eighth.

The Black-Eyed Susan was the first Grade 2 victory for Juarez, who began riding in 2013 and has won four Grade 3 stakes. Juarez finished fourth in the jockey standings at the Gulfstream Park championship meet this winter.

Juarez and Servis are 30 for 92 when they team up together.

"We clicked all winter in Florida, and we're continuing to do well up north," Juarez said.

Servis has trained for the Wests, who were not in attendance, for about a year and a half and was very happy for them after the Black-Eyed Susan.

"It's not just about the money," he said. "The Wests are passionate about the game, and they bred this filly. I'm sure they are ecstatic about this."

The winter malaise that plagued World Approval earlier this year is officially behind him. The 5-year-old gelding confirmed that he's back to top form with a solid 2 1/4-length victory in the Grade 2, \$250,000 Dixie Stakes at Pimlico on May 20.

The win was the second straight this year for World Approval and his eighth from 20 career starts. The \$150,000 first-place purse pushed his career earnings to \$1,103,763.

"He's really good right now, this horse," trainer Mark Casse said. "His last couple of works were crazy. It's funny, this winter he struggled along, but then he really came around."

World Approval, who won the Grade 1 United Nations at Monmouth Park last year, made a successful seasonal debut at Tampa Bay Downs in April, winning the Turf Classic by 2 1/4 lengths. His connections loved the way he trained subsequently and were looking forward to running him in the Grade 1 Woodford Reserve Turf Classic at Churchill Downs on Kentucky Derby Day. But the turf course came up soft that afternoon, and World Approval was scratched to await the Dixie.

The Dixie developed liked it looked on paper. Security Risk, breaking from the rail under Florent Geroux, set the pace, with World Approval stalking through fractions of 24.12 seconds for the quarter, 49.43 for the half-mile, and 1:13.94 for six furlongs on a course rated as good.

World Approval drew alongside Security Risk turning for home, took the lead just before the eighth pole, and kicked clear for the victory. Projected, who was getting an inside stalking trip under Joel Rosario, had to settle for second, 2 1/4 lengths ahead of Blacktype. It was another 1 1/4 lengths back to fourth-placed Catapult, who was followed by Talk Show Man, One Mean Man, Security Risk, Conquest Typhoon, Top of Mind, and Ring Weekend.

World Approval, a gelding by Northern Afleet owned by Charlotte Weber's Live Oak Plantation, covered the 1 1/16 miles in 1:43.15 and returned \$7 as the favorite.

"I was very comfortable, very relaxed laying second," winning jockey Julien Leparoux said. "He's a nice horse. We went slow to the half, he was doing it very easy, and he kicked very nice at the end."

Leparoux believes World Approval "is the same or better [than last year]. Hopefully, we have a good year with him."

Ransom the Moon has found a new career path as a California sprinter.

After modest form in optional claimers and allowance races around two turns on turf and the all-weather surface at Woodbine in recent years, Ransom the Moon won his stakes debut in the Grade 2 Kona Gold Stakes at Santa Anita on May 20.

Ridden by leading rider Flavien Prat, Ransom the Moon (\$9.80) closed from sixth in the field of eight to win the \$201,035 race at 6 1/2 furlongs by a convincing 2 1/4 lengths. Prat guided Ransom the Move five-wide on the turn and in early stretch to reach the front before the eighth pole.

"He couldn't have had it any better," trainer Phil D'Amato said. "Flavien said he had so much horse."

Ransom the Moon was timed in 1:15.12.

Moe Candy finished second after disputing the early pace of 22.34 seconds for the opening quarter-mile and 44.90 for a half-mile. Lord Simba, the 8-5 favorite, was third, followed by Kobe's Back, Calculator, Eastwood, Kentuckian, and Touched by Autism.

Lord Simba won the Grade 3 Los Angeles Stakes in his stakes debut on April 15. He was as close as second on the turn, but could not keep pace in the final furlong and was beaten 2 3/4 lengths.

Ransom the Moon, a 5-year-old horse by Malibu Moon, has won 4 of 17 starts and earned \$290,829. He was bought privately over the winter by Agave Racing Stable and Jeffrey Wilke, and is unbeaten in two starts in California.

Ransom the Moon won his debut in Cali-

fornia, and first start for D'Amato, in an optional claimer at 6 1/2 furlongs on April 30. Ransom the Moon will be considered for stakes in July — the Grade 2 San Carlos Stakes at seven furlongs here on July 1 or the Grade 1 Bing Crosby Stakes at six furlongs at Del Mar on July 29.

At the eighth pole of the \$300,000 Pimlico Special on May 19, it was pretty evident trainer Jimmy Jerkens was going to win the Grade 3 race. What was less apparent was whether it would be with 2-5 favorite Shaman Ghost or upstart second-choice Dolphus.

Inside the sixteenth pole, it was the class of Shaman Ghost that carried him past his stablemate to win the 47th Pimlico Special by a neck. Dolphus, a half-brother to champion filly Rachel Alexandra, who beat the boys in the Preakness here in 2009, finished second by 7 1/4 lengths over Conquest Windycity, who got third by a nose over Name Changer.

Watershed was fifth, followed by Discreet Lover, Fellowship, Eagle, and Bodhisatva. Noble Bird, last year's Pimlico Special winner, was scratched and will give given a freshening, according to trainer Mark Casse.

Shaman Ghost, a 5-year-old son of Ghostzapper owned by Frank Stronach (who also owns Pimlico), added the Pimlico Special to a victory in March in the Grade 1 Santa Anita Handicap. Last year, Shaman Ghost won the Grade 1 Woodward and Grade 2 Brooklyn at Belmont Park.

For Jerkens, it was a victory made even more special because his father, the late, legendary Hall of Fame trainer Allen Jerkens, won this race in 1993 with Devil His Due.

"I always loved this little place," Jerkens said of Pimlico. "I came here a lot when I was working for my dad; we always ran something in all the stakes here. Loved it."

Jerkens was also loving how the race was shaping up at the eighth pole. Dolphus, the 6-1 second choice under Rajiv Maragh, had set an uncontested pace of 23.84 seconds for the quarter, 47.92 for the half-mile, and 1:12.41 for six furlongs.

Shaman Ghost, meanwhile, was in sixth

and kept four wide down the backstretch by Javier Castellano.

"I think that was best for the horse," Castellano said. "He likes to run free; he doesn't like to be in trouble. I had the best horse and I rode him like the best horse in the race."

In midstretch, Shaman Ghost moved into second and seemed like he was going to easily go by Dolphus. Dolphus fought back when Shaman Ghost first came to him, but Shaman Ghost edged away in the final 70 yards.

"I was feeling pretty good, I knew one of them was going to win," Jerkens said. "I thought [Shaman Ghost] was going to eventually wear [Dolphus] down, but he came back on him and then galloped out past him."

Shaman Ghost covered the 1 3/16 miles in 1:54.55 and paid \$2.80 to win.

Maragh was very happy with the effort put in by Dolphus, who was coming in off a second-level allowance win at Aqueduct.

"That's as good as a horse can run without winning, right?" Maragh said. "He ran a winning race, he just got beat at the end by Shaman Ghost. But he put in everything, he kept fighting."

Jerkens said Shaman Ghost would be pointed to the Grade 2, \$750,000 Suburban at Belmont Park on July 8.

Vertical Oak, benefiting from a track that carried speed all afternoon, pressed a contested pace but then pulled clear through the lane to score a 3 3/4-length victory in the Grade 3, \$150,000 Miss Preakness Stakes for 3-year-old fillies on May 19 at Pimlico.

Vertical Oak (\$15.60) was part of a three-way battle for the lead in the 13-horse field, but then put away pace rivals Our Majesty, the favorite, and My Miss Cliff and drew away. Her early rivals took the second and third spots, in that order, underscoring how important it was to be forwardly placed.

"She needs things to go her way to show her best," said her trainer, Steve Asmus-

sen, who said Vertical Oak's quick start put her in position to be effective.

This was her second straight win, following the Purple Mountain at Oaklawn, in which she encountered early trouble and was defeated.

To prep for the Miss Preakness, Asmussen ran Vertical Oak at Prairie Meadows, where she cruised home on a sloppy track in the Goldfinch Stakes.

"The key was finding that race at Prairie Meadows, so she could remember what she's good at," Asmussen said.

Jose Ortiz rode Vertical Oak, teaming with Asmussen for their second stakes win on the card, following Terra Promessa in the DuPont for older females.

Vertical Oak completed six furlongs on the fast main track in 1:10.06, following fractions of 22.61 seconds for the opening quarter and 45.54 seconds for a half.

Vertical Oak, by Giant Oak, has now won four times in eight starts. This was her graded stakes debut. She has now earned more than \$200,000 for owners Kirk and Judy Robison.

With a quarter-mile to run in the Allaire duPont Distaff, the race was effectively over.

Terra Promessa, the heavy favorite in the field of seven fillies and mares, was lengthening her lead under Jose Ortiz after setting easy fractions – and yet her Hall of Fame trainer, Steve Asmussen, began whistling and cheering as if a torrid stretch duel was about to unfold.

"Aw, if you can't root, don't come to the races," a smiling Asmussen said after kiss-

ing his mother, Marilyn, and hugging his father, Keith. "I just love this filly."

He should. Bred and owned by the Stonestreet Stables of Barbara Banke, who also was on hand with her family, Terra Promessa has won 7 of 12 career starts and \$836,100 after her 7 1/2-length triumph in the Grade 3, \$150,000 DuPont Distaff, the first of seven stakes on the Friday card at Pimlico.

Always in control after breaking sharply, Terra Promessa went in splits of 23.80, 47.13, and 1:10.91 before finishing 1 1/8 miles in 1:49.12 on a fast track. She paid \$4.20.

Carrumba was second, another 2 1/4 lengths ahead of Mo' Green, who outlasted Power of Snunner for third by a neck.

Terra Promessa is a 4-year-old Kentucky-bred filly by Curlin, who 10 years ago captured the Preakness at Pimlico for Asmussen and a partnership that included Stonestreet, then overseen by Banke's husband, the late Jess Jackson. That was one reason Asmussen was so pumped.

"She's a Curlin, and the Curlins get better with age," Asmussen said.

Terra Promessa is now a four-time Grade 3 winner, having previously accounted for the Honeybee, Fantasy, and Bayakoa, all at Oaklawn Park. She was the runner-up behind Stellar Wind in her most recent start, the Grade 1 Apple Blossom last month.

In a race named for a Maryland-bred legend on the state's biggest weekend of racing, Cambodia continued a solid run for the home team, getting a perfect ride from Florent Geroux to win the Grade 3, \$150,000 Gallorette Stakes by two lengths on May 20 on the Preakness undercard.

Cambodia was bred in Kentucky but is based at the Fair Hill Training Center in Elkton, Md., about an hour from Pimlico, for trainer Tom Proctor. She followed Maryland-bred Everything Lovely's victory in the The Very One Stakes and Laurel Park-based Recruiting Ready's win in the Chick Lang Stakes for Maryland's Sagamore Farm.

On May 19, Fair Hill-based Happy Mesa won the Hilltop Stakes for trainer Graham Motion, and Shaman Ghost, owned by Pimlico owner Frank Stronach, won the Grade 3 Pimlico Special.

The Gallorette was Cambodia's first stakes victory after three consecutive placings. The mare finished third in the Marie G. Krantz Memorial and the Daisy Devine Stakes over the winter at Fair Grounds and third in the Dahlia Stakes last month at Laurel Park, beaten less than three lengths in all three races combined.

Geroux settled Cambodia (\$11.20) in second to stalk the pace early as longshot Come to Mischief took the field through moderate early fractions of 24.63 seconds, 49.78, and 1:14.31. Geroux gave Cambodia her cue straightening away into the stretch, and she assumed command willingly, kicking on well for the win.

"When I asked her turning for home, she responded with a quick turn of foot," Geroux said.

The final time for the 1 1/16 miles was 1:44.36 on a drying-out turf course officially rated as good.

Whitmore won his fifth consecutive race in the Grade 3 Maryland Sprint at Pimlico on May 20, using a strong finishing kick to catch the front-running A. P. Indian in deep stretch and prevail by a half-length.

A. P. Indian, the 8-5 second betting choice in the nine-horse field, ran lights-out in the six-furlong Maryland Sprint, but 6-5 favorite Whitmore proved just a little bit better. The surprise in the race was 30-1 Awesome Banner, who chased A. P. Indian the length of the stretch and finished third, beaten only a half-length by Whitmore and a head by A. P. Indian.

Whitmore, who is based in Kentucky with trainer Ron Moquett, was timed in a rapid 1:09.90 over a track that had started the day as muddy but had been upgraded to good for the Chick Lang, the race that directly preceded the Maryland Sprint. The track record at Pimlico is held by Northern Wolf, who covered the distance in 1:09 in August 1990.

A. P. Indian went to the lead from post 4 and was pressed early by Whitmore from post 5 and Holy Boss from post 6. Whitmore and jockey Ricardo Santana Jr. dropped

off the pace nearing the half-mile pole and raced a bit wide on the turn.

"I have a lot of confidence in this horse," Santana said. "When he wanted to sit back off the pace, I let him, and then he got out a little bit on the turn because he was getting hit with dirt in the face. I knew he'd come running for me late."

A. P. Indian, trained by Arnaud Delacour, set fractions of 22.97 seconds and 45.67. He disposed of Holy Boss entering the stretch and held a one-length advantage entering the final furlong. While he was able to hold off Awesome Banner, he could not contain Whitmore's late run.

"I'm not sure he wanted to be in front like that," Delacour said. "Obviously, the winner is a nice horse, and he came with a huge run at the end."

Moquett called an audible earlier in the week. He had been pointing Whitmore to the Grade 2 True North at Belmont Park on June 9, but the horse seemed ready to run, and he decided to send him to Pimlico instead.

Whitmore carried 124 pounds in the Maryland Sprint, six more than A. P. Indian.

"The change in plans worked out well," Moquett said. "I guess we can't use mud or weight as an excuse anymore."

Whitmore, a 4-year-old gelded son of Pleasantly Perfect, is now 7 for 12 in his career with earnings of \$967,000.

A change in trainers from Paulo Lobo to trainer Kenny McPeck and a move from California to Kentucky has apparently rejuvenated former Brazilian runner Some in Tieme. He showed as much May 20 in the Grade 3, \$100,000 Louisville Handicap at Churchill Downs, blowing open what

seemed a competitive race to score by three lengths and notch his first victory since October 2015 in his native Brazil.

Although Some in Tieme enjoyed a favorable trip, saving ground and staying clear of heavy traffic for much of the race while rated in the rear half of the field, there was no disputing who was best in the race. Besides the clear margin of victory, he seemed to be running in another gear than the rest of the opposition in the stretch, inhaling the leaders once angled to the outside by jockey Manny Cruz.

Front-running Reporting Star, who carved out moderate splits with fractions of 50.11 seconds, 1:15, and 1:39.89 in the 1 1/2-mile Louisville Handicap, held second, finishing 2 1/4 lengths clear of third-place Bullards Alley.

The winner, a 5-year-old son of Shirocco owned by Some in Time Inc., completed the distance on firm turf in 2:27.25. He paid \$26.20 to win.

The race marked the second consecutive encouraging performance from Some in Tieme, who had been a fast-closing second in a third-level allowance race at Keeneland on April 19 when racing 1 1/16 miles on grass.

Though the public may have been somewhat surprised by Some in Tieme's victory, Cruz wasn't. He noted he came away impressed after breezing him at Keeneland before the race. That led him to ride him with confidence, he said.

Walkabout has mostly been known as the little half-sister to 2012 Breeders' Cup Classic winner Fort Larned. But after the \$100,000 Matron Stakes at Churchill Downs on May 20, she can now be regarded as a graded stakes winner.

Unleashing a furious rally down the center of the track under Brian Hernandez Jr., Walkabout got up in the closing strikes to catch Improv by a neck in the Grade 3 Matron, a race that had formerly been run as the Arlington Matron before it was moved from Arlington to Churchill Downs this year.

Other than in pedigree, late-running Walkabout is a different horse than Fort Larned, who preferred to be prominently placed in his races. She rated 17 lengths off the leaders in the Matron, as Improv set lively splits of 47.03 seconds and 1:11.57 in the 1 1/16-mile race.

Even at the six-furlong stage Walkabout seemed to have too much left to do to win, still in ninth with nearly eight lengths to make up, but Improv began to grow fatigued, and none of the others in the field, including favored Curlin's Approval, were doing much to threaten.

Walkabout, a 4-year-old daughter of Stroll bred and owned by Whitham Thoroughbreds, raced 1 1/16 miles on a fast track in 1:44.06, paying \$12 as the third favorite in the field of 11.

Divine Elegance, shuffled back down the backstretch, rallied to be third, 2 1/4 lengths behind the runner up, while Florida invader and 4-5 favorite Curlin's Approval ran seventh in a dull effort.

Winning trainer Ian Wilkes said the key to Walkabout has been learning how she prefers to race. For much of last year she was being placed only a few lengths off the leaders.

"She didn't want any part of that," he said. "She made us understand how she wanted to run. She wanted to be patient and finish off a race."
