CATHOLIC BOY two to three wide through the first turn, settled four wide in mid pack, remained patiently handled advancing four wide through the far turn into contention with five-sixteenths to go, spun three wide into upper stretch outside a pair roused for the stretch drive, took over command straightened away, drew clear under a drive kept busy to the finish. AVERY ISLAND two to three wide just off the pace, came under coaxing midway on the far turn, angled three to four wide at the head of the stretch, proved no match for the top one while offering up a mild kick to run on and secure the place honors safely. VOUCH broke in at the start bumping ALKHAATAAM and pinching that rival back in tandem with MILLIONAIRE RUNNER, raced four then three wide through the opening bend before settling four wide in aim of the front, advanced to latch on the leader through the far turn put to coaxing three wide between foes at the three-eighths, took over command nearing the quarter pole, spun just off the inside for home between rivals and drifted in a bit green straightened away when headed for command, kept on through the stretch to be along for the show honors clear of the rest. ALKHAATAM got bumped between foes who each broke his way and was pinched back at the start conceding two to three lengths to the front, settled three wide at the tail of the field, got tipped out four wide placed to coaxing with seven-sixteenths remaining, advanced mildly through the turn, angled five wide at the quarter pole, improved position for the last major share. TAP RAP STRIKE stumbled badly at the start pecking the ground and conceding two to three lengths to the front, raced two to three wide through the first turn before settling four wide down the backstretch near the rear of the field, went five wide through the far turn advancing to mid pack put to coaxing with three furlongs to go, continued four to five wide into upper stretch, gained mildly to the furlong grounds, couldn't sustain the move and weakened in the late stages. BIBLICAL brushed the near side stall at the start, saved ground near the rear, came under coaxing just off the inside between rivals at the seven-sixteenths, swung three wide into upper stretch and weakened. MILLIONAIRE RUNNER broke out at the start bumping ALKHAATAM and pinching that rival back in tandem with VOUCH, raced forwardly placed three wide through the first turn before prompting the leader down the backstretch from the outside, took over command tucked to the two path with seven-sixteenths to run and came under challenge to the outside getting put to coaxing nearing the five-sixteenths, yielded the front nearing the quarter pole, cut the corner into upper stretch and faltered. TRIPLE DOG DARE tracked the pace along the inside from mid pack and came under coaxing with six furlongs to run, didn't seem to make any ground and came under the whip half a mile from home, swung three to four wide into upper stretch and tired. V. I. P. CODE brushed the off side stall at the start, raced three wide through the first turn before settling three wide in mid pack, came under coaxing at the seven-sixteenths, swung four to five wide into upper stretch and gave way. BANDITO cut the pace from the two path under pressure from MILLIONAIRE RUNNER to the outside, tucked inside half a mile from home, got headed for command seven-sixteenths out, chased inside in retreat through the far turn, spun just off the inside for home and folded.
