FIRENZE FIRE away without apparent mishap, moved into the two path proceeding along the backstretch, sat reserved until the final stages of the run around the bend, picked up interest swinging to the outside stepping into the stretch, completed the maneuver four to five wide before straightened away, kicked into his best when put to a drive, closed in to become fully latched up to GOOD MAGIC by the eighth pole, fought his way to the top and mustering up good determination, preserved the decision. GOOD MAGIC took up position in midpack, stalked the three-way pace tussle towards the three path, was set down leaving the five-sixteenths pole and tipped out in preparation for the stretch drive, challenged as the widest of four front runners spinning into the lane, out-fought them all to lead by a slim margin, saw the eventual winner loom boldly in short order, had the lead snatched away, but put up a good fight to the wire. ENTICED sat within range of a contested pace from the two path, got let out a notch after more than halfway around the turn, angled out into path six from upper to midlane, rallied well enough to secure the show. KOWBOY KARMA four wide departing the backstretch, went seven wide down the lane, lacked the needed late response. HAZIT came away forwardly placed, was three to four wide disputing the pace, was between rivals heading into the stretch, remained a prominent factor for about another sixteenth before giving way. HONORABLE TREASURE two to three wide, vied for command from between rivals from midpoint on the backstretch to upper stretch, backed away. AVEENU MALCAINU broke on top, cut over to the inside route, contended as the innermost of a threesome beginning right after the initial fraction had been finalized, saw the second place finisher add itself to the pace picture stepping into the stretch, gave in to the heavy pressure after a few more strides and faltered. FULL OF RUN worked out a tuck into path two nearing the end of the backstretch, got placed three wide at the head of the stretch, made no impact. BAHAMIAN stumbled awkwardly as the field was sent off and running, spotting the penultimate break more than five lengths in no time, shifted about on the backstretch before choosing the three path as the route to take on the turn, fanned six to seven wide to the three-sixteenths marker, had no offering. STRONGER got set up in the two path soon after the start, failed to respond when put to a drive approaching the five-sixteenths pole. MASTER MANIPULATOR hung out three wide at the three-eighths pole, gave way. BLAME IT ON HONEY tracked the front runners from the inside and faltered.
