THE TABULATOR tracked the pace early, took over command in the far turn, shifted into the four path entering the lane, drew clear in the stretch, drifted out down the lane and held sway in the final stages. HOLLYWOOD STAR was well placed early, shifted into the four path in the far turn while making a bid, continued the bid down the lane and was gaining on the winner in the final stages. TEN CITY was unhurried early on while wide, swung into the six path in the far turn, made a bid in the stretch and was slowly gaining in the late stages. EBBEN chased the pace early along the inside, waited a bit nearing the quarter pole, shifted into the three path entering the lane and weakened late in the stretch run. BIG GEMMY was back early on, shifted into the four path in the far turn and moved up in the stretch drive. FLAMEAWAY steadied a bit from between horses into the first turn and was done early. PONT DU GARD broke a bit slow at the start, swung into the six path in the far turn and improved position. SMART REMARK set the pace early, angled off the rail in the far turn and gave way down the lane. TRES EQUIS was never involved. MO DIDDLEY chased the pace early, fanned into the five path in the far turn and was empty late.
