SOUPER TAPIT was slow into stride, raced in the three path on the first turn, was unhurried near the back, rallied four wide on the far turn, made a five wide bid at the quarter-pole, inched away under a drive in upper stretch, responded well to the challenge of the runner-up in the final furlong and held under strong urging. MULTIPLIER bumped with a rival at the start, saved ground on the first turn, settled off the pace, was urged along while three then four wide on the far turn, shifted six wide into the stretch under a left-handed whip, chased the winner, switched to a right-handed whip near the furlong marker, loomed boldly on the outside into the final sixteenth, went back to a left-handed whip late and just missed. COMBAT CONTROLLER went two to three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, moved closer in the two path on the far turn, waited while blocked from the quarter-pole to the three-sixteenths, altered out from behind rivals at that point and secured the show. OFF ROAD went five then four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, advanced four then three wide on the far turn, made a bid at the five-sixteenths, vied into upper stretch then weakened. BROOKLINE broke a step slow, raced inside on the first turn, settled towards the rear, steadied along the rail at the seven-sixteenths, angled four wide near the three-eighths and was no factor. GRAND MARAIS rounded the first turn in the two path, settled in the front half of the field, chased in the two path on the far turn, made a bid between horses at the five-sixteenths, dropped back into upper stretch and tired. SIR BALLANTINE went four then three wide on the first turn, set the clear pace, was urged along in the two path early on the far turn then dropped to the rail, lost the advantage inside the five-sixteenths pole and gave way. DIAMONDMAZE bumped with a rival at the start, went four then three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, dropped back at the half-mile pole, was urged along while three wide on the far turn and failed to respond. MANNING was sent hard from the start, raced inside on the first turn, followed the leader down the backstretch and stopped after a half-mile then was eased in the stretch but walked off.
