NOBLE INDY hit the outside of the gate at the start then bumped with a rival, showed speed on the inside of MARMELLO, was wrestled back behind the foe nearing the first turn then moved out, rounded that bend in the two path, stalked the pace on the outside, took the lead at the half-mile pole then moved clear, went around the far turn in the two path, was asked inside the five-sixteenths, lost the lead just after turning into the stretch, came under a right-handed whip, switched to a left-handed whip near the eighth-pole, fought back in the final furlong and narrowly prevailed under strong handling. LONE SAILOR was hustled leaving the gate then angled in towards the rear, saved ground on the first turn, settled off the pace, moved closer with a half-mile to run, rallied in the two path on the far turn, closed strongly to make a three wide bid into the stretch then took the lead, led under a drive into the final sixteenth but was denied while able to get the place. MY BOY JACK dropped well behind early, went two to three wide on the first turn, drifted well out in the track early on the backstretch, angled in near the seven-sixteenths, started the far turn in about the two path, angled seven wide while gaining late on that bend, came eight wide into the stretch, closed strongly to make a bid near the eighth-pole, battled with the top two in the final furlong and hung then missed while well clear for the show. GIVEMEAMINIT was hustled from the start, rounded the first turn in the two path, settled towards the front, came under urging late on the backstretch, chased three wide on the far turn, made a four wide bid into the stretch, dropped back into the final furlong and weakened. SNAPPER SINCLAIR was hustled from the start, went five wide early on the first turn then tucked into the four path, settled on the outside, was ridden along in the four path on the far turn, passed the five-sixteenths under the whip, spun five wide into the stretch and came up empty. HYNDFORD went three wide on the first turn, settled in the back half of the field, was urged along passing the half-mile pole, went four then three wide on the far turn and failed to threaten. RETIREMENT FUND went four then three wide on the first turn, was coaxed along on the backstretch, went three then two wide under urging on the far turn and failed to respond. BRAVAZO was asked leaving the gate, lugged out into the first turn, went three then four wide on that bend, raced up close on the outside, lugged out in the six path on the far turn, drifted inward in upper stretch and faltered. DARK TEMPLAR was taken in hand early, went four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along passing the half-mile pole, went five then four wide on the far turn and also faltered. MARMELLO bumped with a rival at the start, went to the front, set the pace on the inside, lost the lead at the half-mile pole, dropped back along the rail on the far turn and stopped. MILE FRACTION WAS HAND-TIMED DUE TO A PERSON ON THE TRACK TRIPPING THE TIMING BEAM EARLY
