CATHOLIC BOY took closer order between horses heading into the far turn, was asked for his best in the three-path approaching the top of the stretch, could not quicken with the leaders and kept on evenly. MILLIONAIRE RUNNER saved ground trailing for six furlongs, came wide off the far turn and passed tired horses. TIP SHEET saved ground to the far turn, had no response when put to the whip, then drifted wide to the lane remaining outrun.
