MULTIPLIER, reserved just out of striking distance saving ground in the opening half, steadily gathered momentum along the rail on the far turn, switched off the inside racing into upper stretch, angled to the three path while coming under firm left handed pressure and produced a solid closing response to close the gap, then just edge HEDGE FUND in time under strong handling. The latterswitched outside the pacesetter in the opening stages while shifting into thepath of IT'S YOUR NICKEL to gain a stalking position while under light reserve, continued within easy striking distance for five furlongs, moved to wrest command nearing upper stretch, gained a clear advantage entering the lane, extended the advantage between calls in late stages resisting the winner's bid but just failed to contain that rival. IT'S YOUR NICKEL, held up avoiding close quarters in the opening stages while momentarily shifting into the path of MR. MISUNDERSTOOD, tracked the leaders between foes from out of striking distance to the far turn, steadily gained position between foes while exchanging contact with ST. LOUIS GUY near the three sixteenths marker but improved his position to the end while no match for the top pair. STAND AND CHEER sped to the fore soon after the break while angling nearer to the inside, dictated the pace on a narrow margin racing a bit off the rail in the opening half, continued to dispute the issue inside a rival racing into upper stretch but gave way in the drive. HOLLYWOOD HANDSOME, reserved last early while angling to the inside, switched outside foes racing through the far turn, swung five wide racing into upper stretch but lacked the needed closing response. ST. LOUIE GUY tracked just off the first flight three deep racing to the backstretch, advanced in that path to lodge a brief bid nearing upper stretch, exchanged some contact racing into upper stretch and quickly emptied out. MR. MISUNDERSTOOD, shuffled a bit to the outside avoiding close quarters in the opening stages, tracked the leaders outside foes
