1 1/8 MILES. (1.401) 57TH RUNNING OF THE REBEL. Grade II. Purse \$900,000 THREE YEAR OLDS. By subscription of \$500 which shall accompany the nomination, original nominators paying \$4,500 to pass the entry box and \$4,500 additional to start. Supplementary nominations may be made by the closing time of entries at a fee of \$12,500 which qualifies to start with \$900,000 Guaranteed of which 60% to the Owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% to be divided equally among all other starters. WEIGHTS: 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$60,000 at a mile or over in 2017 allowed 3 lbs.; \$50,000 at a mile or over anytime allowed 5 lbs.; \$35,000 at any distance allowed 7 lbs. (Maiden and Claiming races not considered.) In Allowance Stakes starting preference will be given to horses that have accumulated the highest earnings. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. The Owner of the winner to receive a trophy. Early Bird closing Friday, February 10, 2017 at \$750 for The Southwest, The Rebel and The Arkansas Derby. Certain finishing positions in this race will earn points to qualify for the 2016 Kentucky Derby, pursuant to the official rules for the Road to the Kentucky Derby published by Churchill Downs Incorporated. Closed Friday, March 10, 2017 with 56 nominees.

MALAGACY closest to the leader off the inside, asked along late in the final turn, took over soon after, kicked clear the final furlong under firm right handed urging and while drifting in a bit late. SONNETEER shuffled back at the start, raced well back early as a result, began a steady advance after five furlongs off the inside, dropped to the rail late in the final turn and rallied up the inside to gain the nod for the place, no real threat to the winner. UNTRAPPED in some early traffic off the inside, settled the middle half, three out to four wide into the lane, slight drift, missed the place. PETROV back off the pace toward the inside, asked along in the two path turning for home behind horses, showed some interest to narrowly miss the place. SILVER DUST last away, raced back and in the three path, bit rank, steadied onto the backstretch, evenly paced up the backstretch, improved slightly into the lane, finished up in even fashion in lacking a closing kick. LOOKIN AT LEE void of speed, improved position into the lane in some traffic, shifted out inside the furlong marker, some late interest. APPALACHIAN GEM well back while racing outside, slight steady into the lane while four wide, improved only slightly midtrack. UNCONTESTED broke out, set the pace toward the inside, gave way when confronted turning into the lane. ROYAL MO within striking distance while racing outside, three wide into the far turn, had nothing for drive. AMERICAN ANTHEM five down to four wide in the first turn, mid pack, faded down the lane in a dull effort. SILVER BULLION steadily faded inside.
