BEACH BUM had speed four wide then dueled three deep, took the lead leaving the turn, angled in nearing the stretch and drew clear under left handed urging. ROYAL MO Hesitated to be away behind the field, settled off the rail, moved up inside a rival early on the turn, came out leaving the turn and into the stretch and finished well for the place. FIRST DEGREE BURN chased off the rail then outside on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and just held third. ANTIOCH chased a bit off the rail or outside a rival, came out into the stretch and was edged for the show. SEAU settled outside a rival then chased off the rail, came three wide into the stretch and was outfinished for a minor award. CISTRON had speed between horses then dueled off the rail, angled in approaching the turn, fought back on the bend and weakened in the stretch. MALIBU POWER had speed outside foes then dueled between horses until nearing the stretch and also weakened. SHARP SAMURAI settled off the rail, angled in leaving the backstretch, went outside a rival into the stretch and was not a threat. ELEUTHEROS broke a bit slowly, went up inside to stalk the pace, continued along the rail on the turn and into the stretch and gave way. SERGIO saved ground chasing the pace, cut the corner into the stretch and had little left for the drive. RAINBOW SQUALL allowed to settle off the rail, came a bit wide into the stretch and gave way. BLABIMIR had speed between horses then dropped back on the backstretch and second turn, gave way, was pulled up in the stretch and walked off.
