SWEET LORETTA lost her footing and broke awkwardly while brushing the near-side stall, established position in the early going while moving towards the outside, was well spotted behind the leading trio, passed the half-mile pole under coaxing, stalked a duo in the fourth path on the turn, was asked near the quarter-pole, took the lead on the outside in upper stretch then inched clear, came under a right-handed whip after beginning to drift out in the vicinity of the furlong marker, was straightened by the rider with a few tugs of the left rein, clung to her advantage into the final sixteenth, bumped soundly with PRETTY CITY DANCER nearing the wire and shared the victory. PRETTY CITY DANCER lost her footing at the start and was last away, settled on the outside, went three then four wide on the turn, was roused late on that bend, spun five wide into the stretch, leaned in a bit while chasing under a left-handed whip, swapped to her inside lead when switched to a right-handed whip outside the sixteenth-pole, drew alongside SWEET LORETTA late, bumped soundly with that opponent nearing the wire, held a narrow lead one stride before the wire but lost the bob and shared the victory. CHERRY LODGE bobbled awkwardly at the start, pulled her way up on the outside while tugging at the bit then contested the pace, vied in the three path on the turn, was asked at the quarter-pole, came under a strong hand ride in upper stretch, was put to a right-handed whip while dropping back outside the furlong marker and weakened but safely secured the show. FUN settled between horses, was urged along in the two then three path early on the turn, moved to the fourth path late on that bend, came six wide into the stretch under a left-handed whip, switched to a right-handed whip inside the three-sixteenths and failed to threaten. YOU KNOW TOO showed good speed, disputed the pace between horses, dropped back at the half-mile pole, went around the turn in the two path, was roused at the three-eighths, chased into upper stretch, ducked out near the three-sixteenths and had nothing left. RUNWAY DOLL was away alertly, contested the pace on the inside of two opponents while off the rail, vied in the two path on the turn, was asked at the quarter-pole, dropped back under the whip in upper stretch and tired. SPECIAL RISK was stirred up in the warm-up, settled on the inside of two foes, dropped well behind while inside on the turn, spun off the rail into the stretch and faltered. Following a stewards' inquiry into the stretch run, no change was made to the order of finish.
