By subscription of \$150 each which should accompany the nomination; \$750 to pass the entry box and an additional \$750 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental payment of \$1,500 along with the entry and starting fees may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. 122 lbs. Non-winners of a race other than maiden or claiming allowed 2 lbs.; all maidens allowed 4 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, July 8, 2017 with 23 Nominations.

FIRENZE FIRE came away without apparent mishap, raced from off the inside throughout, quickened after stepping onto the turn, cruised up towards the leader with a three wide run, rider holding something in reserve, turned for home looking BAFFIN in the eye, edged to the front soon afterwards, was deep into the furlong grounds before having the rider go to work, dug in determinedly in the final stages to fend off the second place finisher. FREE DROP BILLY brushed with ADMIRAL JIMMY right after the field had been sent on its way, got guided over towards the inside route, slipped off it approaching the five-sixteenths pole, was under a drive spinning four wide into the stretch, straightened away and took off after the winner, closed in well, but got denied. PSYCHOANALYZE hustled from the starting gate, had the rider change tactics and grab hold after being outsprinted by BAFFIN, went on to track that opponent from the pocket, got cued up and angled into the two path spinning into the stretch, was outfinished and had to settle for the show. BAFFIN broke on top and retained the advantage, cut over to the inside, felt the winner's presence by the final stages of the run around the bend, got put to the test by that foe as they headed home, was the first of the twosome to have its pilot commit to a drive, relinquished but hung around as a forward factor a little longer before backing away. BAL HARBOUR lost his footing springing from the gate, took up the chase positioned at a slight distance from off the rail, cut the corner into the lane and lacked the needed response. ADMIRAL JIMMY made light contact with the runner up, travelled in the two path on the turn, shifted wider and wider down the lane until about seven wide when done, made no headway. DIRECT DIAL worked out a tuck into the two path at the half mile pole, stayed within range of the pacesetter for an additional furlong, swung four wide into the lane, wasn't making any headway prior to bumping with NAUTI BOY right around midlane. NAUTI BUOY underwent a four wide pursuit on the turn, came one path wider into the stretch, began to lug in soon afterwards while not making up any ground, bumped with DIRECT DIAL at the eighth pole and continued tiring.
