HAVRE DE GRACE contently stalked the pacesetter from off the inside down the backstretch, ranged up towards the pacesetter near the three path on the turn, confronted the leader and took charge in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, built up a comfortable margin under some encouragement from upper stretch until the eighth pole, completed the final furlong under a confident hand ride. ROYAL DELTA rushed up with a brief burst of speed leaving the chute, was momentarily alongside the leader before being shaken off, remained within striking distance from off the inside, got set down late on the turn and rallied willingly enough to secure second. SATANS QUICK CHICK saved ground during the initial stages, took up the chase while roused from two path on the turn, proved no match en route for show honors. BANKER'S BUY a forward factor for the opening three-quarters, gave way. LIFE AT TEN showed the way on an open lead, felt the top one's presence coming to the five-sixteenths pole and got called upon in response, offered brief resistance before yielding and faltered.
