1 1/8 MILES. (1.463) 49TH RUNNING OF THE JIM DANDY. Grade II. Purse \$600,000 FOR THREE YEAR OLDS. No nomination fee. \$6,000 to pass the entry box. A supplemental nomination fee of \$12,000 will be accepted at any time prior to entry. All starters including supplemental nominess will receive a \$3,000 rebate. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. 123 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade 1 in 2012 allowed 2 lbs.; a Grade 2 over a mile in 2012, 4 lbs.; a Graded Sweepstake at a mile or over, 6 lbs. (Maiden, claiming, starter and restricted allowance races not considered). Any horse that competes in both the Jim Dandy and the Travers will have their entry fee waived for the Travers. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, July 14, 2012 with 40 Nominations.

ALPHA came away in good order, easily took the lead, raced inside on the first turn, came off the rail on the backstretch while being guided a bit with the left rein, was well rated into the far turn, came under increasing pressure while remaining off the rail on the far turn, was asked outside the quarter-pole, shook clear at the top of the stretch, was given two cracks of a left-handed whip in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole, switched to a right-handed whip outside the furlong marker, turned back a bid from NECK 'N NECK passing that marker, moved clear once again and proved best under continued right hand urging. NECK 'N NECK moved out leaving the initial straightaway, went three wide on the first turn, settled just off the pace while on the outside, came under urging near the seven-sixteenths pole, chased four wide on the far turn, came under a right-handed whip in upper stretch, loomed up to make a bid entering the final furlong, was switched to a left-handed whip and was outfinished while clear for the place. LIAISON was last away, went four wide on the first turn, settled towards the back while on the outside, was ridden along while three to four wide on the far turn, came under the whip near the five-sixteenths pole, shifted five wide into the stretch and lacked the needed response while able to secure the show. TEETH OF THE DOG tracked the easy leader while on the outside, was asked while three wide on the far turn, drew within a half-length of the lead, lost touch with the winner in upper stretch and weakened. MY ADONIS raced off the rail on the first turn, settled at the back, moved further to the outside on the backstretch, came under urging with a half-mile to run, was ridden along while three wide on the far turn, came under the whip in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, angled out in upper stretch and failed to threaten. ATIGUN was taken in hand early, raced under a snug hold while off the rail on the first turn, continued under a tight hold despite the sensible fractions, waited behind rivals while still under wraps on the far turn, was finally given free rein after straightening for the drive, angled to the outside and failed to rally. FAST FALCON settled on the inside, moved closer outside the half-mile pole, was urged along while inside on the far turn, came under a right-handed whip in upper stretch and tired. PROSPECTIVE went four wide early on the first turn then moved to three wide, settled on the outside, moved a bit closer with a half-mile to run, was urged along while off the rail on the far turn and came up empty.
